

### Implementation of Integrity Pact:

1.0 Integrity Pact have been implemented by Oil India Limited w.e.f. 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2010 for Tenders / Contracts of value Rs. 1.0 crore and above.

2.0 Following Integrity Pact clause has been incorporated in the tenders of value Rs. 1.0 crore and above :

“OIL shall be entering into an Integrity Pact with the bidders as per format enclosed vide Annexure (Integrity Pact) of the tender document. Each page of this Integrity pact proforma has been duly signed by OIL’s competent signatory. The proforma has to be returned by the bidder (along with the technical bid) duly signed by the same signatory who signed the bid, i.e. who is duly authorized to sign the bid. Any bid not accompanied by Integrity Pact Proforma duly signed by the bidder shall be rejected straightway. All pages of the Integrity Pact to be signed by the bidders’ authorized signatory who sign the Bid.”

The following 2 (Two) Independent External Monitors (IEMs) have been appointed by Oil India Limited in terms of Integrity Pact which forms part of OIL’s Tenders / Contracts valuing Rs. 1.00 crore and above.
