1.0 OIL INDIA LIMITED, a premier Public Sector Undertaking of Govt. of India invites **Expression of Interest** in sealed envelopes from reputed EPC contractors/ parties having requisite expertise, capabilities and experience in the relevant field for carrying out the above-mentioned work on **LSTK** basis.

2.0 Scope of Work

Construction of a heavy duty General Workshop (approx. 80.0m X 15.0m) including preparation of layout drawing, detailed structural analysis and design, preparation & supply of detailed structural drawings (in Auto Cad), designing and providing complete electrical works based on power requirement, supply and erection of one 50/10 Tonne capacity EOT crane, 4 nos. 5 Ton capacity Jib crane including foundation etc. complete with testing (reputed make). Job also includes required modification works in the existing workshop (like segregation of existing crane facility, strengthening of existing steel columns & beams or any other member, unification of new and old roof, electrical cable diversion etc.) for converting the new and old workshop as one unit having capacity of operating 3 EOT cranes at a time (2 nos. 20 Tonne & 1 no. 50 Tonne) or any other work required for successful completion of the whole project.

3.0 Eligibility Criteria: Interested **EPC** contractors/ firms shall have to submit the following documents with their EOI for pre qualification:

(a) Experience of having undertaken construction of similar jobs during the last 7(seven) years as on 31.03.2007 with reputed public sector, private sector or any other State & Central Government Organization of which minimum value of work executed should be as follows:

- (i) One single contract job of value of **Rs.360.00 lakh**
- (ii) Two contract jobs of value of Rs.225.00 lakh each
- (iii) Three contract jobs of value of Rs.180.00 lakh each

The applicant must submit necessary completion certificate in original from competent authority in support of satisfactory completion of the job.

(b) The EPC firms/ contractors should have their own competent engineering design cell or tie-up with reputed civil and electrical design/ consultancy firms having experience in designing of heavy duty workshop (with EOT cranes) during the last five years as on 31.03.2007. Necessary documentary evidences of tie-up **in the form of court affidavit in original** to be submitted along with the application.

(c) The contractor / construction firm must own in his / her / their own name / firm a fabrication factory or yard and minimum nos. of vehicles and equipments required for such jobs under good running condition.

(d) Average financial turnover during the last 3 (three) years ending financial year 2005-06 should be at least Rs.150.00 lakh. The proof of annual turnover should be

either in the form of audited balance sheet or certification from Chartered / Cost Accountant firm indicating the code no.

(e) PF Code No. & PAN issued by the appropriate Govt. authority.

(f) Sound financial standing supported with documentary evidences from any Nationalized Bank.

(g) VAT Registration No. issued by the appropriate Govt. authority.

(h) **All the certificates and documentary evidences submitted in support of para 3.0(a) & 3.0(b) above must be in original and 3.0(c), 3.0(d) 3.0(e), 3.0(f), 3.0(g) above must be duly attested by competent authority.** This will be applicable for all

contractors / construction firms including OIL registered contractors. The applicants selected for issue of tender papers will have to produce the original documents for verification in the office of the HEAD (Contracts), if required in due course of time.

4.0 The EPC firms/ contractors should also submit a brief note on the best available technology (BAT) or methodology or materials, which will be adopted by them to construct the said workshop including required modifications.

5.0 The interested firms/ contractors may visit the site of work between 20th to 24th August, 2007 to gather 1st hand information prior to submitting expression of interest at their own cost. They are advised to contact Chief Engineer (General Workshop) or his authorized representative in this regard.

6.0 The interested firms/ contractors should send the Expression of Interest (EOI) in sealed envelopes super-scribing the Tender No. & applicant's name/address along with the details of information as mentioned above so as to reach HEAD (CONTRACTS), OIL INDIA LTD, Duliajan on or before **10.09.2007**. EOI may be sent by post. However, for the delay in receipt or non-receipt of the same, HEAD (Contracts) will not be responsible.

7.0 Contractors/ parties may note that this is not a request for proposal. After scrutiny of the EOIs, a short-listing of parties will be prepared and those short-listed parties will be invited to submit their technical/ financial proposals as per specified terms of reference. A pre-bid conference will also be arranged at Duliajan or any other suitable place in India for having interaction with short-listed contractors or parties. The interested contractors or parties shall submit the EOI along with the following details in addition to the documents stipulated in para 3.0 above.
