3.0 Tenders will be received upto 12:45 PM (IST) on the date as mentioned above and opened on the same day at 01:00 PM (IST) at HEAD-CONTRACTS's office before any attending tenderers.Tender box is placed at the office of Head(Contracts). However, if the above mentioned closing / opening day of the tender happens to be non-working day due to Bundh / Strike or any other reason,the tenders will be received and opened on the

following working day at the same time except on Saturdays.

4.0 The rates shall be quoted per unit as specified in the Schedule of Work (Part II) and shall be in words as well as in figures. No overwriting shall be allowed, but all corrections may be inserted in the blank space above the corrected word / figure and must be initialed. In case of discrepancy the unit rate quoted in words shall be considered to be correct.

5.0 The Company reserves the right to reject any or all the tenders or accept any tender in full or in part, without assigning any reason.

6.0 (a) No Tenderer must withdraw the tender after its public opening. Any such withdrawal will make the tenderer liable of forfeit his/her/their Earnest Money in full and debarred from further tendering at the sole discretion of the company and the period of debarment will not be less than 6 (six) months.

(b) Once a withdrawal letter is received from any bidder, the offer will be treated as withdrawn and no further claim / correspondence will be entertained in this regard.

7.0 The tender must be valid for 180 (One hundred & eighty) days from the date of opening of the tender.

8.0 Conditional tenders are liable to be rejected at the discretion of the Company.

9.0 Tenders can be dropped at the box placed at the office of Contract Department or can be sent by registered post addressed to

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so as to reach his office before scheduled closing date and time. Company will not be responsible for any postal delay or non-receipt of the same.

10.0 The work may be split up amongst more than one contractor at the sole discretion of the Company.

11.0 The bidders are required to furnish the composition and status of ownership of the firm in whose name tender documents have been purchased/issued along with one or more of the following documentary evidences(which are applicable to the bidder) in support of the same.

05. In case of Societies registered under the Societies Registration Act -Copies of Telephone/Electricity/Mobile Bill, PAN, latest Income Tax Return indicating therein the name, residential address, E-mail and telephone numbers of all the Directors or persons who are at the helm of affairs, registration certificate from the Registrar of the state and copies Service Tax and Central Excise Registration Certificate.

06. In case of Joint Stock Companies registered under the Indian Companies Act -Copies of Telephone/Electricity/Mobile Bill, PAN, latest Income Tax Return indicating therein the name, residential address, E-mail and telephone numbers of all the Directors or persons who are at the helm of affairs, Certificate of

Incorporation from the Registrar of Companies, Memorandum and Articles and copies of Service Tax and Central Excise Registration Certificate.

07. In case of Trusts registered under the Indian Trust Act - Copies of Telephone/Electricity/Mobile Bill, PAN, latest Income Tax Return indicating therein the name, residential address, E-mail and telephone numbers of all the Trustee or persons who are at the helm of affairs, registration certificate from the Registrar of the state, Trust Deed and copies Service Tax and Central Excise Registration Certificate.

12.0 The selected tenderer will be required to enter into a formal contract, which will be based on their tender i.e O.I.L's Standard Form of Contract.

13.0 The successful tenderer shall furnish a Security Deposit in the form of Demand Draft / Banker's Cheque / Cash as specified above before signing the formal contract. The Security Deposit will be refunded to the Contractor after satisfactory completion of the work, but a part or whole of which shall be used by the Company in realization of liquidated damages or claims, if any or for adjustment of compensation or loss due to the Company for any reason. This Security Money shall not earn any interest.

14.0 The amount of retention money shall be released after 6 (six) months from the date of completion certificate from the concerned department.

15.0 The work shall have to be started within seven days from the date of work order.

16.0 Time will be regarded as the essence of the Contract and the failure on the part of the Contractor to complete the work within the stipulated time shall entitle the Company to recover liquidate damages and / or penalty from the Contractor as per terms of the tender /contract.

17.0 The contractor will be required to allow OIL officials to inspect the work site and documents in respect of the workers payment.

18.0 DISCOUNTS / REBATES.

1.1 Unconditional Discounts/ Rebates if any given in the bid or along with bid will be considered for evaluation.

1.2 Post bid or conditional discounts / rebates offered by any bidder shall not be considered for evaluation of bids. However, if the lowest bidder happens to be the final acceptable bidder for award of contract and if they have offered any discount/rebate, the contract shall be awarded after taking into consideration such discount / rebate. These provisions shall be incorporated suitably in the Bid Document

19.0 BACKING OUT BY BIDDER

In case any bidder withdraws their bid within the bid validity period, Bid Security will be forfeited and the party will be debarred for a period of 2(two) years from the date of withdrawal of bid.

20.0 BACKING OUT BY L-1 BIDDER AFTER ISSUE OF LOA

In case LOA issued is not accepted by the L1 bidder or the Performance Security is not submitted as per the terms of the contract within the time specified in the Bid Document, the Bid Security shall be forfeited and the bidder shall be debarred for 2(two) years from the date of default.

21.0 FURNISHING FRAUDULENT INFORMATION/DOCUMENT:

If it is found that a Bidder/Contractor has furnished fraudulent document/information, the Bid Security/Performance Security shall be forfeited and the party shall be debarred for period of 3(three) years from date of detection of such fraudulent act, besides the legal action.

GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT(GCC)

MEMORANDUM OF AGREEMENT made this _____ day of _____ Between OIL INDIA LIMITED a Company incorporated under the Companies Act 1956 and having its Registered Office at Duliajan in the District of Dibrugarh, Assam (hereinafter called Company) of the one part and Shri/Smti _____ and Shri/Smti _____ carrying on business as partners /proprietor under the firm name and style of M/s. _____ with the main Office at _____ in the District of _____ aforesaid (hereinafter called 'Contractor') on the other part.

WITNESSETH:

1. a) The contractor hereby agrees to carry out the work set down in the Schedule of work which forms part-II of this Contract in accordance with the 1968 General Conditions of Contract of Oil India Limited and General Specifications read in conjunction with any drawings and Particular Specifications & instructions which forms Part-III of the contract utilizing any materials/services as offered by the Company as per Part-IV of the contract at _____ .

b) In this Contract all words and expressions shall have the same meaning as are respectively assigned to them in the 1968 General Conditions of Contract of Oil India Limited which the Contractor has perused and is fully conversant with before entering into this Contract.

c) The clauses of this contract and of the specifications set out hereunder shall be paramount and in the event of anything herein contained being inconsistent with any term or terms of the 1968 General Conditions of Contract of Oil India Limited, the said term or terms of the 1968 General conditions of Contract to the extent of such inconsistency, and no further, shall not be binding on the parties hereto.

2. The contractor shall provide all labour, supervision and transport and such specified materials described in part-II of the Contract including tools and plants as necessary for the work and shall be responsible for all royalties and other levies and his rates shall include for these. The work executed and materials supplied shall be to the satisfaction of the Company's Engineer and Contractor's rates shall include for all incidental and contingent work which although not specifically mentioned in this contract are necessary for its completion in a sound and workman like manner.

3. The Company's Engineer shall have power to:

a) Reduce the rates at which payments shall be made if the quality of work although acceptable is not upto the required standard set forth in the OIL Standard Specifications which have been perused and fully understood by the Contractor.

b) Order the Contractor to remove any inferior material from the site and to demolish or rectify any work

of inferior workmanship, failing which the Company's Engineer may arrange for any such work to be demolished or rectified by any other means at the Contractor's expenses.

c) Order the Contractor to remove or replace any workman who he (The Engineer) considers incompetent or unsuitable; the Engineer's opinion as to the competence and suitability of any workman engaged by the Contractor shall be final and binding on the Contractor.

d) Issue to the Contractor from time to time during the progress of the work such further drawings and instructions as shall be necessary for the purpose of proper and adequate execution and maintenance of the works and the Contractor shall carry out and be bound by the same.

e) Order deviations in Part II and III of this Contract. All such deviation orders shall be in writing and shall show the financial effect, if any, of such deviation and whether any extra time is to be allowed. The rates to be applied for such Deviation Order shall be the same for those appearing in Company's Schedule of Rate in force on the date of issue of such Deviation Order, to which the contractor has no objection.

4. The Contractor shall have no claim against the company in respect of any work which may be withdrawn but only for work actually completed under this contract. The contractor shall have no objection to carry out work in excess of the quantities stipulated in Part-II if so ordered by the company at the same rates, terms and conditions.

5. The Company reserves the right to cancel this Contract at any time upon full payment of work done and the value of the materials collected by the contractor for permanent incorporation in the work under this contract particularly for execution of this contract upto the date of cancellation of the Contract. The valuation of the work done and the materials collected shall be estimated by the company's Engineer in presence of the contractor. The Contractor shall have no claim to any further payment whatsoever. The valuation would be carried out exparte if Contractor fails to turn up despite reasonable notice which will be binding on the Contractor.

6. The Contractor hereby undertakes to indemnify the Company against all claims which may arise under the under noted Acts :-

- i) The Mines Act.
- ii) The Minimum Wages Act, 1948.
- iii) The Workman's Compensation Act, 1923.
- iv) The Payment of wages Act, 1963.
- v) The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965.
- vi) The Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act, 1970 and the rules framed thereunder.
- vii) Employees Pension Scheme, 1995.
- viii) Inter-State Migrant (Regulation of Employment and Condition of Service) Act. 1979.
- ix) The Employees Provident Fund and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952.
- x) AGST Act.
- xi) Service Tax Act.

or any other Acts or Statute not here in above specifically mentioned having bearing over engagement of workers directly or indirectly for execution of work. The Contractor shall not make the Company liable to reimburse the Contractor for the statutory increase in the wage rates of the Contract Labour appointed by the Contractor. Such Statutory increase in the wage rates of Contract Labour shall be borne by the contractor.

7. The Contractor shall clear away all rubbish and surplus material from the site on completion of work and shall leave the site clean and tidy.

8. The Contractor must complete the work within 104 weeks of the written order to commence work. During the currency of the job, the work progress must be commensurate with the time elapsed. In the event of any delay on the contractor's part, he/she will be liable to pay to the company liquidated damages at the rate of 1/2% (Half p.c) per week of the contract price of the item(s) delayed in completion and the maximum value of the liquidated damage will be 7.5% of the contract price of the item(s) delayed provided the item(s) delayed are not critical for commissioning and final utilization of the work. If, however, the item(s) delayed in completion are critical for commissioning and final utilisation of the work then the contractor will be liable to pay liquidated damages by way of penalty at the rate of 1/2% (Half percent) per week of delay of the total contract cost subject to a maximum of 7.5% of total contract cost.

The Chief Engineer's certificate as to the criticality or otherwise of an item shall be final.

The payment of liquidated damages/penalty may be reduced or waived at the sole discretion of the Company whose decision in this regard will be final.

In the event of there being undue delay in execution of the Contract, the Company reserves the right to cancel the Contract and / or levy such additional damages as it deems fit based on the actual loss suffered by the company attributable to such delay. The company's decision in this regard shall be final.

9. In order to promote, safeguard and facilitate the general operational economic in the interest of the Company during the continuance of this contract the Contractor hereby agrees and undertakes not to take any direct or indirect interest and or support, assist, maintain or help any person or persons engaged in antisocial activities, demonstration, riots , or in any agitation prejudicial to the Company's interest and any such event taking shape or form at any place of the Company's works or and its neighbourhood.

10. The tendered all-inclusive Price (i.e. the Contract price) is Rs. _____
(Rupees _____

_____ only.) but the Company shall pay the Contractor only for actual work done at the all inclusive rates set down in the Schedule of work part II of this Contract.

On account payment may be made, not oftener than monthly, upto the amount of 92.5% of the value of work done. Final payment will be made only after satisfactory completion of the work . Such final payment shall be based on the work actually done allowing for deviations and any deductions and the measurement shall be checked and certified correct by the Company's Engineer before any such final payment is made.

11. The contractor employing 20 (twenty) or more workmen on any day preceding 12 months shall be required to obtain requisite licence at his cost from the appropriate Licensing Officer before undertaking any Contract work. The Contractor shall also observe the rules & regulations framed under the Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act.

12. Wages shall be paid by the Contractor to the workmen directly without any intervention of any Jamadars or Thekadars and that the Contractor shall ensure that no amount by way of commission or otherwise be deducted/ recovered by the Jamadar from the wages of the workmen.

13. The Company for any reason whatsoever and of which the company shall be sole judge may terminate this Contract with a 24 hours notice in writing to the Contractor and in the event of Company's so doing the clause 5 here of shall prevail and the accounts between the parties will be in accordance therewith finalised.

14. The Contractor will not be allowed to construct any structure (for storage / housing purpose) with thatch, bamboo or any other inflammable materials within any company's fenced area.

15. The Contractor shall ensure that all men engaged by him/her are provided with appropriate protective clothing and safety wear in accordance with regulation 89(a) and 89(b) in the Oil mines Regulations 1984. The Company's representative shall not allow/accept those men who are not provided with the same.

16. All Statutory taxes levied by the Central and State Government or any other competent authority from time to time will be borne by Contractor and the amount of the contract specified in the contract is inclusive of all tax liabilities.

17. The Contractor shall deploy local persons in all works.

18. The Contractor shall not engage minor labour below 18(eighteen) years of age under any circumstances.

19. The Contractor and his/her workmen shall strictly observe the rules and regulations as per Mines Act. (latest editions).

20. Special Conditions

a) The amount of retention money shall be released after 6(six) months from the date of issue of completion certificate from concerned department.

b) The contractor will be required to allow OIL Officials to inspect the work site and documents in respect of the workers' payment.

c) Contractor(s) whosoever is liable to be covered under the P.F. Act and contract cost is inclusive of P.F., must ensure strict compliance of provisions of Provident Fund and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 in addition to the various Acts mentioned elsewhere in this contract. Any contractor found violating these provisions will render themselves disqualified from any future tendering. As per terms of the contract, if applicable, the Contractor must deposit Provident Fund Contribution (covering Employee's & Employer's share) with the competent authority monthly under their direct code. The Contractor shall be required to submit documentary evidence of deposit of P.F. Contribution to the Company. In case of failure to provide such documentary evidence, the Company reserves the right to withhold the amount equivalent to applicable P.F. Contribution.

21. ARBITRATION :

Any dispute under this contract will be settled through Arbitration as per Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.

Place of Arbitration : DULIAJAN .

22. FORCE MAJEURE :

Force Majeure (exemption) Clause of the International Chamber of Commerce (ICC Publication No. 421) is hereby incorporated in this contract.

23. LB VERIFICATION REPORT AND SECURITY REVIEW :

Contractor will be required to submit the verification report to ascertain character and antecedents from the Civil Administration towards the persons engaged under this contract to the Head of the user Department before engagement.

24. In case of any doubt or dispute as to the interpretation of any clause herein contained, the decision of the Company's Engineer shall be final and binding on the contractor.

25. SET OFF CLAUSE :-

"Any sum of money due and payable to the contractor (including Security Deposit refundable to them) under this or any other contract may be appropriated by Oil India Limited and set off against any claim of Oil India Limited (or such other person or persons contracting through Oil India Limited) for payment of a sum of money arising out of this contract or under any other contract made by the contractor with Oil India Limited (or such other person or persons contracting through Oil India Limited)."

1. Scope of works :

Providing services for obtaining the following :

- i) Obtaining Landing Permit from DGCA for Air freighting of Explosives & Radio-Active items from abroad.
- ii) Obtaining License for import of Explosive from Chief Controller of Explosives, Nagpur including liaisoning with the various agencies such as Director General of Hydrocarbon, Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas, Ministry of Law, Ministry of Industry & Ministry of Commerce etc. as applicable from time to time.
- iii) Obtaining NOC for import of Radio-active items from Atomic Energy Regulatory Board, Mumbai.
- iv) Obtaining Revalidation of DGCA Permit, as and when required.
- v) Obtaining amendment in Landing Permit.
- vi) Obtaining amendment in Explosive License from CCE, Nagpur/NOC from AERB and Ministry of Surface Transport.
- vii) Obtaining NOC from Ministry of Surface Transport.
- viii) Bidder (Service Provider) to perform all the jobs required to be carried out or associated with obtaining Landing Permit from DGCA, Explosive License from CCE, Nagpur & NOC from AERB, Mumbai and Ministry of Surface Transport. Duration of the contract will be initially for a period of two years which may be extended for a further period of another year, with the same rate(s), terms & conditions subject to satisfactory performance of the contractor during initial contractual period.

5. Time Frame to obtain the following :

- i) Landing Permit from DGCA : Within 30 days from the date of receipt of application from the Company (OIL).
- ii) For Explosive License from CCE, Nagpur : Within 60 days from the date of receipt of application from the Company (OIL).
- iii) NOC from AERB and Ministry : Within 30 days from the date of receipt of application from the Company (OIL).
- iv) NOC from Ministry of Surface Transport : Within 15 days from the date of receipt of application from the Company (OIL).

6. Penalty :

Following Penalty will be applicable for the delay beyond the time frame referred above :

- a) In case of delay upto 25% of time frame (i.e., 7 days for Landing Permit from DGCA & NOC from AERB and Ministry of Surface Transport and 15 days for Explosive License, respectively) : Deduction of 10% of the quoted charge.
- b) In case of delay upto 50% of time frame (i.e., 15 days for Landing Permit from DGCA & NOC from AERB and Ministry of Surface Transport and 30 days for Explosive License, respectively) : Deduction of 25% of the quoted charge.
- c) In case of delay more than 50% of time frame : Deduction of 50% of the quoted charge.

Note :

Company will have option to withdraw the assigned job/contract in case of delay by more than 50% of the time frame and no payment will be admissible to the contractor for such withdrawn job(s).

7. Tax liability :

Any tax liability such as Income Tax, Service Tax etc. on the services rendered would be contractor's account.

8. Termination :

Either party can terminate the contract giving one month's prior notice. However, job assigned/commitment made till the date of termination will have to be fulfilled by both the parties.

9.0 Bid Rejection Criteria & Bid Evaluation Criteria for the tender.

AA) BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC):

The bids shall conform generally to the terms and conditions given in the bidding documents. Notwithstanding the general conformity of the bid, the following requirement will have to be particularly met by the bidders without which the same will be considered non-responsive and rejected:

- (i) Bidder(s) must have relevant experience of minimum **three (3) years** on **similar jobs** with PSUs / Central Govt. / State Govt. / Private Sector Organisations and should submit documentary evidence in the form of copy of Contract / Performance Certificate issued by reputed Public Sector Organisations like ONGCL etc. or reputed Private Sector Organisations engaged in Well Logging jobs like M/s. Schlumberger Asia Pacific, M/s. Halliburton etc. However, above experience criteria will not be applicable in case OIL has previous experience with the party

whose service has been offered to the Company and found satisfactory.

ii) Bidder(s) shall offer firm price and not subject to variation on any account. Bids with adjustable price shall be treated as non responsive and rejected.

iii) Any offer containing incorrect statement will be rejected.

iv) Bid(s) received from unsolicited parties shall be rejected.

Note:-

"Similar jobs" mentioned above means obtaining permits from concerned authorities.

I) For proof of Annual turnover, any one of the following document/photocopy must be submitted along with the bid: -

i) A certificate issued by a practicing Chartered/ Cost Accountant's Firm, with membership no. certifying the Annual Turnover and nature of business.

ii) Audited Balance Sheet and Profit and Loss account.

II) For proof of requisite Experience, any one of the following document/photocopy must be submitted along with the bid: -

i) Copy of 'Certificate of Completion (COC)'/ 'Certificate of Payment (COP)'/Contract/Performance Certificate of jobs , showing gross value of job done.

ii) Certificate issued by any other Public Sector Undertaking/ Govt. Department/Private Sector Organisations showing:

(a) Gross value of job done; and

(b) Nature of job done; and

(c) Time period covering the financial year(s) as per the NIT.

iii) Non- submission of the documents as specified in BRC above will result in rejection of bids.

(ii) Bidder(s) shall offer firm price and not subject to variation on any account. Bids with adjustable price shall be treated as non responsive and rejected.

(iii) Validity of the Bids shall be minimum 4 months (120 days). Bids with lesser validity shall be rejected.

(iv) Bid(s) received after bid closing date and time shall be rejected. Also, modification of Bids received after Bid Closing date/time shall not be considered.

(v) Bid(s) received from unsolicited parties shall be rejected.

(vi) Offer(s) received through Telex/Cable/Fax/E-mail/Telephone shall be rejected. Similarly offers received as Xerox/Photocopy which is not on original letter head of the bidder(s) & not duly signed & stamped will be rejected.

(vii) Bid(s) shall contain no interlineations, erasures or overwriting except as necessary to correct errors made by the bidder(s), in which case such corrections shall be initiated by the person(s) signing the bid. Any bid not meeting this requirement shall be liable for rejection.

(viii) Any offer containing incorrect statement will be rejected.

B) BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC):

The bids conforming to the terms and conditions stipulated in the bid documents and considered to be responsive after subjecting to the Bid Rejection Criteria will be considered for further evaluation as per the Bid Evaluation Criteria given below:

1.0 To ascertain the inter-se-ranking, the comparison of the responsive bids will be made on the basis of total amount quoted for the items of Part-II (i.e. schedule of works, units, quantity, rates) of the tender. In the event of computational error between unit price and total price, unit price shall prevail and adopted for evaluation.

2.0 OIL will not be responsible for delay, loss or non receipt of applications (for bidding documents) sent by mail and will not entertain any correspondence in this regard.

3.0 Bids which are found to be responsive and meeting the requirement both specification-wise and terms and conditions in the tender will be considered for evaluation.

c) In case any of the clauses in the BRC contradict with other clauses of Bid Document elsewhere, then the clauses in the BRC shall prevail.
