Special Notes : A.1 The kelly shall be manufactured from AISI 4145 H API modified alloy steel, full length quenched and tempered. Brinell hardness should be in the range of 285-341. The kelly should be manufactured from special straightened Kelly bars and inspected thoroughly.

A.2 The kelly shall be brand new, unused, free from all defects, of recent manufacture and in full conformance to API Spec 7-1 & API RP7G. Details of the kelly along with a copy of valid API Spec 7-1 certificate must be forwarded along with the quotation.

A.3 Bidders shall indicate the name of manufacturer & country of origin while quoting.

A.4 Marking shall be done as per API Spec 7-1, i.e. kelly shall be die-stamped on the OD of the upper upset with the manufacturer's name or mark, the API monogram and the size & style of the upper connection. The lower pin connection shall be die-stamped on the OD with size and style of the lower connection. Additionally the Purchase Order No. & date is to be paint stenciled on the scabbard. Bidders shall confirm compliance to the same while quoting.

A.5 The exterior of the kelly should be painted as preventive against rust. Threads should be doped with lubricant as per API Spec 7-1.

A.6 Threading & gauging should be done in accordance with API Spec 7-1.

A.7 Standard mill test certificates are to be provided with the shipment of material (if ordered) & the bidder is to confirm the same while quoting.

A.8 Relevant catalogue, literature, drawing etc. having detailed materials composition must be forwarded along with the quotation for the offered kelly.

A.9 Bidders should indicate their best possible delivery schedule.

1.0 Bids are invited under Single (Composite) Bid System.

1.1 Quotation must be submitted in triplicate.

2.0 Validity of the offers should be **4 months** from Bid closing date(Please refer clause 1.2 of Section 'D' of MM/GLOBAL/01/2005). Bids with lesser validity shall be rejected.

3.0 The minimum FOB / FCA charges in case of partial order for reduced quantity / items shall have to be indicated by the bidder. In case this is not indicated specifically, the charges quoted would be prorata calculated and the same will be binding on the bidder.

4.0 **Bid security** - Bid security of US \$ 4,000.00 or Rs. 190,000.00 shall be furnished as a part of the Bid. **Any bid not accompanied by a proper bid security in ORIGINAL will be rejected without any further consideration.** For exemption for submission of Bid Security, please refer Clause No. 9.8(Section A) of General Terms and Conditions for Global Tender vide MM/GLOBAL/01/2005(enclosed). The Bid Security shall be valid for 180 days from the date of bid opening.

5.0 **Performance Bank Guarantee** - Successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bank Guarantee @10% of the order value. The Performance Bank Guarantee must be valid for one year from the date of receipt/acceptance of goods or 18 months from the date of shipment whichever is earlier. Bidder must confirm the same in their Technical Bid. Offers not complying with this clause will be rejected.

6.0 The offered item, in the event of order, shall be new, of recent make, of the best quality & workmanship and shall be guaranteed by the Seller for a period 18 months from the date of despatch/shipment or 12 months from the date of successful commissioning, whichever is earlier against defects arising from faulty materials, workmanship or design. Defective goods / materials or parts notified by OIL to the Seller shall be replaced immediately by the Seller on F.O.R destination basis including payment of all taxes and duties at Seller's expense. This guarantee shall survive and hold good notwithstanding inspection, payment for and acceptance of the

goods. Bidder to confirm the same while quoting.

7.0 The items covered by this tender shall be used by Oil India Limited in the PEL/ML areas which are issued/renewed after 01/04/99 and hence Nil Customs Duty during import will be applicable. Indigenous bidder shall be eligible for Deemed Export Benefit against this purchase. Details of Deemed Export are furnished vide Addendum to MM/GLOBAL/01/2005 enclosed.

7.1 Other terms and conditions of the tender shall be as per General Terms and Conditions for Global Tender (Document MM/GLOBAL/01/2005).
