Indigenous bidder shall be eligible for concessional rate of GST (for invoice valuing INR 1.00 Lakh and above) against Essentiality Certificate wherever applicable, as per Notification No.3/2017 - Integrated/ Central Tax (Rate) dated 28th June, 2017. 12.0 All foreign bidder(s) should note that a new clause on shipment of the goods by sea from port of export to the Indian port (i.e. Kolkata port unless otherwise specified) has been included in the tender through an addendum to "General Terms and Conditions for Global Tender" (MM/GLOBAL/01/2005). such fraudulent act, besides the legal action. In case of major and serious fraud, period of debarment may be enhanced.

16.0 The tender will be governed by "General Terms & Conditions" for e-Procurement as per Booklet NO. MM/GLOBAL/E-01/2005-July2012 for E-procurement (ICB Tenders) including Amendment and Addendum.

17.0 Bidders are requested to examine all instructions, forms, terms and specifications in the bid. Failure to furnish all information required as per the bid or submission of offers not substantially responsive to the bid in every respect will be at the bidder's risk and may result in the rejection of its offer without seeking any clarifications.

18.0 OIL INDIA LIMITED (OIL) has upgraded its E-tender Portal. As part of the new system, the intending bidder must have Encryption Certificate along with Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) of Class III [Organization]. - b) Necessary Login ID & Password will be issued by OIL only after submitting the complete online registration by the Bidder. In the event of late registration/incomplete registration by Bidder, OIL INDIA LIMITED shall not be responsible for late allotment of User ID & Password and request for bid closing date extension on that plea shall not be entertained by Company.
