1.0 OIL INDIA LIMITED, a premier Public Sector Undertaking of Govt. of India invites applications for pre-qualification from established Civil Engineering Firms/ Contractors meeting requisite criteria for the under mentioned works.

Description of Works

- A. Tender No. CCO/CIV/10412/06**
Improvement of existing road by providing granular sub-base, gravelling, WBM course & premix surfacing including supply of all materials except bitumen & supply of all requisite plants & equipments including Road roller from Barekuri approach road junction to Loc. DFU - TU(proposed) approach junction (Approx. length 4.30 km).
- B. Tender No. CCO/CIV/10413/06**
Improvement of existing road by providing granular sub-base, gravelling, WBM course & premix surfacing including supply of all materials except bitumen & supply of all requisite plants & equipments including Road roller from Tinsukia upto Berikuri approach road junction (Approx. length 5.10 km).
- C. Tender No. CCO/CIV10414/06**
Improvement of existing road by providing granular sub-base, gravelling, WBM course & premix surfacing including supply of all materials except bitumen & supply of all requisite plants & equipments including Road roller from existing Makum - Barekuri asphalted road junction to the proposed location DFT (Betjan-Hillikha road, Approx. length 2.60 km).

2.0 **Civil Engineering Firms/ Contractors are eligible to apply against any one tender only. Company reserves the right for issuance of only one tender document to a single eligible party at Company's sole discretion.**

3.0 Applicants must possess the following: -

(a) Experience of having undertaken construction of road/ road over drilling plinth with CPWD, Railways, APWD, MES, NRL, ONGCL, OIL or any other Government Organization / Public Sector Undertaking. The minimum value of contract job / jobs executed successfully during the last 7(seven) years, ending financial year 2004-05 should be as follows:

- (i) One single contract job of value of Rs. 76.00 lakhs for either of the tenders mentioned under Para-1 (A/B) & Rs. 46.00 lakhs for tender mentioned under Para-1 (C), or
- (ii) Two contract jobs of value of Rs. 47.00 lakh each for either of the tenders mentioned under Para-1 (A/B) & Rs. 29.00 lakhs each for tender mentioned under Para-1 (C), or
- (iii) Three contract jobs of value of Rs. 38.00 lakh each against either of the tenders mentioned under Para-1 (A/B) & Rs. 23.00 lakhs each for tender mentioned under Para-1 (C).

(b) The contractor / construction firm must own in his / her / their own name / firm OR must produce an undertaking from the owners for providing services of the following minimum nos. of vehicles and equipment under good running condition, in the form of court affidavit:

- (i) Road roller of capacity 8-10 T: 2 (two) nos.
- (ii) Dumper / Truck: 2 (two) nos.
- (iii) Bitumen boiler: 1 (one) no.
- (iv) Hot mix plant of 6 – 8 TPH: 1(one) no.

The documentary evidence of ownership / undertaking in the form of court affidavit of the above plants & equipment should be submitted with the application.

- (c) Average Annual Financial Turnover during the last 3(three) years, ending financial year 2004-05 should be at least Rs 28.00 lakh for tenders mentioned under Para-1 (A/B) & Rs. 17.00 lakhs for tender mentioned under Para-1 (C). The proof of Annual Turnover should be either in the form of Audited Balance Sheet or Certification from Chartered / Cost Accountant firm indicating their membership / code number
- (d) Documentary evidence of PF code number & PAN issued by appropriate Govt. authority.
- (e) Documentary evidence of VAT Registration number issued by appropriate Govt. authority.
- (f) Documentary evidence in support of sound financial standing and Bank Account No. from any Nationalized Bank.
- (g) All the certificates and documentary evidences required to be submitted in support of Para 3.0(a), 3.0(b), 3.0(c), 3.0(d), 3.0(e) & 3.0(f) above should be clearly legible and duly attested by gazetted officer along with official seal. This will be applicable for all contractors / construction firms including OIL Registered contractors. **Illegible / Incomplete certificates or documents will not be considered for evaluation.**
- (h) OIL will have the right to check the original certificates / documents at any point of time if desired and the required documents should be produced for authentication.

4.0 The application indicating the Tender No. (any one) & applicant's name/ address with the details of information as mentioned above should reach the Office of HEAD (CONTRACTS), OIL INDIA LIMITED, Duliajan on or before 11:00 AM on **03.02.2006**. If however the date happens to be a Holiday/ Bandh, it will be received up to the next working day till the same time. Application may be sent by post. However, for the delay in receipt or non-receipt of the same, the Head (Contracts) will not be responsible.

5.0 OIL INDIA LIMITED reserves the right to curtail/ enhance the scope of the work stated above or cancel, if required. The details will be indicated in the final Tender Document.

6.0 The parties found suitable by the Company will be furnished with complete set of tender papers covering all details of work. The bid closing and opening time and date will be indicated on the tender documents.
