16	Pre-qualification	<p><u>BID REJECTION / EVALUATION CRITERIA:</u></p> <p>. BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC):</p> <p>The bid shall conform to the specifications and terms and conditions given in the Bidding Documents. Bids will be rejected in case material and services offered do not conform to the required parameters stipulated in the technical specifications. Notwithstanding the general conformity of the bid to the stipulated specifications, the following requirements will have to be particularly met by the Bidders without which the same will be considered as non-responsive and rejected. All the documents related to BRC shall be submitted along with the Techno-Commercial Bid.</p> <p>1.3. TECHNICAL :</p> <p>1.3.1. BIDDERS ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA</p> <p>The Bidder shall be in the business of API quality petroleum pipeline construction/laying conforming to ANSI # B 31.4 / ANSI # B 31.8 or installation of indirect heaters/installation of equipments in Oil and gas mine</p>

area and have successfully completed such works of the following magnitude during last 7 (seven) years ending last day of the month previous to the one in which applications are invited.

- i) Single contract of minimum value Rs. 80.89 lakhs 80%
OR
- ii) Two contracts of minimum value Rs. 50.56 lakhs 50%
OR
- iii) Three contracts of minimum value Rs.40.45 lakhs 40%

1.3.2 The bidders shall either own or give an undertaking to possess the following tools / equipment for consideration of their bids

a) 4 nos of welding generators as per with the following specifications

Welding range :60 – 400 amps

Maximum welding current at 60% duty cycle :400 amps.

Dia of coated electrode ; 2 to 6.3 mm

Coupled with suitable engine as per having auxiliary power source of 220/230 Volts.

b) One no of pipe trailer.

a) Three sets of Chain Pulley Blocks of 3 to 5 tons capacity

b) Sufficient no of Tripods as required.

c) Four sets of Tongs & Wrenches to accommodate 114 mm OD pipes.

d) Water feed pump with necessary hoses.

1.3.3 The average annual financial turnover of the Bidder during the last three years (ending 31st March 2011) should be not less than Rs 30.34 Lakhs only.

Note : All documents relating to clause 1.3.1, 1.3.2 and 1.3.3 above required for establishing successful completion of above contracts must be submitted along with techno-commercial bid. These documents should be in the form of copies of Contracts / work orders/ completion certificates/ payment certificates issued by the Owner. However, the originals of these documents shall have to be produced by the bidder as and when asked for.

1.3.4 COMMERCIAL:

1.3.4.1 Bidder shall furnish Bid Security. Bid security shall be furnished as a part of 'Techno-Commercial Bid'. Any bid not accompanied by a proper bid security will be rejected.

1.3.4.2 Any bid received in the form of Telex/Cable/Fax/E-mail/ Telephone call will not be accepted.

1.3.4.3 Bid shall be typed or written in indelible ink and original bid shall be signed by the

Bidder or their authorized representative on all pages failing which the bid will be rejected.

1.3.4.4 Bid shall contain no inter-lineation, erasures or overwriting except as necessary to correct errors made by Bidder, in which case such corrections shall be initialed by the

person(s) signing the bid. However, white fluid should not be used for making corrections. Any bid not meeting this requirement shall be rejected.

1.3.4.5 The Techno-Commercial Bid should not have any price indication.

1.3.4.6 Any bid containing false statement will be rejected.

1.3.4.7 Bidders must quote clearly and strictly in accordance with the price schedule outlined

in the Bidding Documents otherwise the bid will be rejected.

1.3.4.8 The Bid Documents are not transferable. Bids made by parties who have not purchased the Bid Documents from the Company will be rejected.

1.3.4.9 Any Bid received by the Company after the deadline for submission of bids prescribed by the Company will be rejected.

1.3.4.10 Price quoted by the successful Bidder must be firm during the performance of the Contract and not subject to variation on any account. A bid

submitted with an adjustable price will be treated as non-responsive and rejected.

1.3.4.11 The following Clauses with all its sub-clauses should be agreed in toto, failing which the bid shall be rejected.

- a) Performance Security Clause
- b) Force Majeure Clause
- c) Termination Clause
- d) Settlement of disputes Clause
- e) Liquidated Damages Clause.
- f) Acceptance of Jurisdiction and applicable law.
- g) Tax liabilities clause.
- h) Insurance clause.
- i) With holding clause.
- j) Liability clause.

1.4 GENERAL:

1.4.1 In case Bidder takes exception to any clause of Tender Document not covered under BEC/BRC, then the Company has the discretion to load or reject the offer on account of such exception if the Bidder does not withdraw/ modify the deviation when/as advised by the Company. The loading so done by the Company will be final and binding on the Bidders. No deviation will however, be accepted in the clauses covered under BEC/BRC.

1.4.2 To ascertain the substantial responsiveness of the bid the Company reserves the right to ask the Bidder for clarification in respect of clauses covered under BEC/BRC also and such clarification fulfilling the BEC/BRC clauses must be received on or before the deadline given by the Company, failing which the offer will summarily rejected.

1.4.3 In case, any of the clauses in the BRC contradict with other clauses of Bid Document elsewhere, then the clauses in the BRC shall prevail.

1.4.4 Any exceptions/deviations to tender must be spelt out by Bidder in their 'Techno-Commercial' bid only. Any additional information/terms/ conditions furnished in sealed 'Price Bid' will not be considered by Company for evaluation/award of contract.

1.5 INTEGRITY PACT:

Bidder shall submitted Integrity Pact Proforma / Annexure along with the Technical Bid, duly signed on all pages by same signatory who signed the bid, failing which the offer will summarily be rejected.

1.6 BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC):

1.6.1 The bids conforming to the technical specifications, terms and conditions stipulated in the bid documents and considered to be responsive after subjecting to the Bid Rejection Criteria will be considered for further evaluation as per the Bid Evaluation Criteria given below:

1.6.2 To ascertain the inter-se-ranking the comparison of the responsive bids will be made on the basis of total cost of various jobs envisaged under the contract.
