Bid Documents (non-transferable) can be obtained from the office of Head (Contracts), Oil India Limited, P.O. Duliajan, Assam-786602 from **24.11.2006** to **23.12.2006** on application alongwith Tender Fee (non-refundable) amounting to Rs.500/- only through a Crossed Demand Draft / Banker's cheque in favour of 'Oil India Limited' payable at Duliajan. Applicants can also deposit the tender fee directly in UBI/UCO Bank/SBI/Allahabad Bank Canara Bank of Duliajan Branch and proof of such deposit must be furnished along with the applications for tender documents.

Salient Features Of Eligibility Criteria

a) The Bidder shall be in the business of executing projects involving Design, Detailed Engineering, Procurement, Construction, Fabrication, Erection, Installation, testing and commissioning of petroleum storage tanks having individual capacity of at least 50% of the individual tank capacity under the current tender, including related civil, mechanical, structural, electrical, instrumentation, piping works etc in any Tank Farm Terminals, Oil / Gas Production Installations, Refineries etc. The Bidder should also have a minimum of 7 (seven) years experience in Fabrication jobs of various nature like in-plant piping, process plant piping etc. for petroleum, petroleum products and other process fluids.

b) The Bidder shall have the experience of successfully executing similar work(s) of following magnitude in the last 7 years, ending bid closing date :

- (i) Single contract of minimum value Rs. 92.00 Lakhs;
OR
- ii) Two contracts of minimum value Rs. 57 Lakhs each;
OR
- iii) Three contracts of minimum value Rs. 46.00 Lakhs each.

Note :

1) Documents establishing successful execution of above contracts must be submitted along with the techno-commercial bid. These documents should be in the form of duly attested copies of contracts / work orders / completion certificates etc. issued by clients.

2) 'Similar work' mentioned above means work comprising of the following types of jobs: Design, Detailed Engineering, Procurement, Construction, Fabrication, Erection, Installation, testing, commissioning of petroleum storage tanks having individual capacity of at least 50% of the individual tank capacity under the current tender including related civil, mechanical, structural, electrical, instrumentation and piping works of Tank Farm Terminals, Oil / Gas Production Installations, Refineries etc. Fabrication and construction of tanks are to be carried out as per API std. 650 and as such, the bidders must have experience in construction of tanks as per the standard mentioned here.

c) (i) In respect of design and detail engineering part of the contract (for both mechanical and civil works), if the primary Bidder does not have the requisite experience as set forth above, the Bidder may also bid on the strength of collaborator / joint venture partner to cover the shortfall in experience mentioned in para Note (2) above.

(ii) Collaboration to cover the shortfall in experience mentioned in para c.(i) shall be through a pre-tender bi-partite Agreement or Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between the primary bidder and the collaborator.

The pre-tender bi-partite Agreement / MOU between the primary bidder & its collaborator, valid for the entire duration of the contract, must be submitted with the bid. Such MOU must specify clearly the role & responsibility of the collaborator.

(iii) Duly attested documentary evidences in support of experience of the collaborator must be submitted with the bid. These documents should be in the form of copies of contracts/ Work orders/ completion certificates etc. issued by the client(s).

(iv) All relevant documents pertaining to the design of the tank as well as the foundation will have to be approved by any of the following reputed institutions.

B. PDIL

C. IIT Roorkee

Compliance of this effect will be submitted by the bidders along with the bid.

d) The individual average annual financial turnover of the primary bidder during the last 3 years (ending 31st March 2006) should be not less than Rs. 35 Lakhs. Documentary evidence in support of the same is to be submitted along with the bid. Documentary evidences in the form of (i) a certificate issued by a practicing chartered / cost accountant certifying the annual turnover and (ii) audited Balance sheet and Profit and Loss Account etc. to be submitted.

e) The bidder shall specify list of each proposed equipment / machineries, transport etc. to be deployed for the work, if the contract is awarded to them, indicating following details, duly signed and sealed by the bidder.

g) The Bidder shall submit copies of original documents defining the constitution or legal status, place of registration and principal place of business of the company or firm or partnership.

h) The Bidder shall submit Banker's certificate from any Nationalized Bank as to the financial viability of the bidder.

i) The bidder to comply to engage the following key personnel for administration and execution of the contract.

- i) Project In Charge
- ii) Supervisor (Mechanical construction)
- iii) Supervisor (Civil construction)

The Bidder shall submit detail qualification and experience of the key personnel.

j) The Bidder to comply to submit design details, fabrication drawing, general arrangement drawing and other relevant documents of the Tank and other items as applicable to Oil India Limited within one (1) month from the date of issue of Letter of Intent (LOI) for approval.
