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**NOTE: BID CLOSING AND OPENING DATE FOR THE ABOVE TENDER:
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2.0 The complete set of bidding documents (non-transferable) for the above tender may be purchased from the office of the HEAD-CONTRACT w.e.f. **19.10.2009 to 02.11.2009** during working hours by interested bidders on submission of written application to the Head-Contract, Oil India Limited, Duliajan-786602, Assam and on payment of non-refundable tender fee mentioned against the tender through Demand Draft/Banker's Cheque, Pay-in-slip from any Nationalized Bank in favour of Oil India Limited, payable at Duliajan. Cost of the tender documents may also be deposited in cash in favour of Oil India Limited in UCO Bank, Canara Bank, UBI & SBI of Duliajan branch and proof of such deposit must be furnished along with the application for tender documents. Application received after the above mentioned period will not be considered.

3.0 Bid Rejection Criteria & Bid Evaluation Criteria for the tender.

AA) BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC):

(I) The bids shall conform generally to the terms and conditions given in the bidding documents. Notwithstanding the general conformity of the bid, the following requirements will have to be particularly met by the

bidders without which the same will be considered non-responsive and rejected. Also it is to be noted that in case the bidders have experience of working inside the crude oil storage tank for various jobs, it should be clearly mentioned in the documentary evidence for requisite experience only in the amount of job done against cleaning and replacement of steam coil which will only be considered for evaluation of the bids.

(i) The bidder must have work-completion certificate from the customer like State Govt./Central Govt./PSU for successfully completing similar nature of job mentioned in Para (AA) above i.e. cleaning and steam coil replacement job in crude oil storage tank cutting and removing the damaged steam coil and replacing the same by welding with new pipes supplied by the company in Hazardous area marked as Zone-1 (where flammable atmosphere due to presence of gases and vapors are likely to be present in crude oil storage area) in State Govt./Central Govt./PSU in last seven years. The total contract value in last seven years reckoning from the last date of bid submission with PSUs / Central / State Govt. Organizations should be:

a. Three similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to Rs.2.884 lakhs each.

OR

b. Two similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to Rs.3.605 lakhs each.

OR

c. One similar completed works costing not less than the amount equal to Rs.5.768 lakhs.

(ii)The average annual financial turn over during the last 3 (three) years, ending 31st March 2009, should be at least Rs.2.163 lakhs.

(iii)Bidders must submit all necessary documents related to experience and turnover, otherwise the bid will be rejected. (Duely attested)

(iv)Bidders shall quote directly and not through their agents. Offers made by their agents on behalf of their principals will be rejected. Similarly, bids received from unsolicited parties shall be rejected.

(v)Any offer containing incorrect information will be rejected.

(II) TECHNICAL PART:

(A) (i) The bidders shall either own or give an undertaking to possess the following essential infrastructure to carry out the necessary repairing/replacement job:

a. Engine driven welding generator.

b. The bidder must have skilled welder and competent supervisor, experienced in successfully carrying out high quality welding job preferably in steam line in hazardous area during the last five years. The bidder must provide documentary evidence or certificate in support of the skilled welders and supervisor's work experience who will be employed in the work of steam coil replacement, failing which their offer will be liable for rejection.

c. At least two (02) sets of oxy-acetylene cutting equipment.

d. Truck and Trailer for transportation of equipment and materials.

e. Minimum two (02) sets of chain pulley blocks of 3-5 Ton capacity with suitable tripod.

f. Grinding machine, high speed angle grinder: Minimum 1 no.

(ii) The bidder shall have to declare of possessing or hiring skilled, competent and experienced person to supervise / carry out the above mentioned job smoothly taking all necessary safety precautions as per the HSE policy of OIL while carrying out the above mentioned repair / replacement work since the tank being in the operating tank-farm.

(iii) The bidder must use low hydrogen welding electrodes of reputed manufacturers like ESSAB, D&H, L&T, ADOR whose products are being used by Oil India Limited for critical applications.

(iv) Bidder has to arrange for test piece for inspection before starting of the welding job at site.

(v) The bidder must possess VAT registration certificate.

(B) As a part of experience in support of **Para (AA)** the bidder shall furnish copies of detailed work orders indicating clearly the scope of work, contract value, scheduled and actual completion date etc. without which the same shall be treated non-responsive.

Note:

"Similar nature of job" means the **cleaning of sludge and other materials from inside the tank, cutting and removing the damaged steam coil and then replacing the same by welding new 4" dia pipes and bends in Hazardous area marked as Zone-1 where flammable atmosphere due to presence of gases and vapors are likely to be present in crude oil storage area. Pipes & bends will be supplied by the company. The contractor should have carried out above jobs in State Govt./Central Govt./ PSU in last seven years.**

C. (I) For proof of annual turnover, any one of the following documents/attested must be submitted along with the bid:

(i) A certificate issued by a practicing Chartered / Cost Accountant's Firm, with membership no. certifying the Annual Turnover and nature of business.

(ii) Audited Balance Sheet and Profit and Loss Account.

C.(II) For proof of requisite Experience, any one of the following document / attested must be submitted along with the bid:-

i) In case of OIL contractors, copy of 'Certificate of Completion (COC)' / 'Certificate of Payment (COP)' of jobs successfully completed, showing gross value of job done. It may be clearly noted that simply mentioning of OIL CCO/Works Contract Number will not be accepted.

ii) Certificate issued by any other Public Sector Undertaking / Govt. Department in last seven years ending bid closing date showing:

(a) Gross value of job done; and

(b) Nature of job done; and

(c) Time period covering the financial year (s) as per the NIT.

(iii) Non-submission of the documents as specified in BRC above will result in **rejection** of bids.

(BB) BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC) :

The bids conforming to the terms and conditions stipulated in the bid documents and considered to be responsive after subjecting to the Bid Rejection Criteria will be considered for further evaluation as per the Bid Evaluation Criteria given below:

1.To ascertain the inter-se-ranking, the comparison of the responsive bids will be made on the basis of total amount quoted for the items of Part-II (i.e. Schedule of Works, Units, Quantity, Rate and Price) of the tender.

2.OIL will not be responsible for delay, loss or non receipt of applications (for bidding documents) sent by mail and will not entertain any correspondence in this regard.

3.Discount: Bidders are advised not to indicate any separate discount. Discount, if any, should be merged with the quoted price. Discount of any type indicated separately will not be taken in to account for evaluation purposes. However, in the event such offer without considering discount is found to be lowest, OIL shall avail such discount at the time of award of contract.

B) Solvency Certificate from Bank

CC) GENERAL

a) In case bidder takes exception to any clause of Tender Document not covered under BEC / BRC, then the Company has the discretion to load or reject the offer on account of such exception if the bidder does not withdraw / modify the deviation when / as advised by the Company. The loading so done by the Company will be final and binding on the Bidders. No deviation will however, be accepted in the clauses covered under BRC.

b) To ascertain the substantial responsiveness of the bid the Company reserves the right to ask the Bidder for clarification in respect of clauses covered under BRC also and such clarification fulfilling the BRC clauses must be received on or before stipulated date mentioned in the letter of clarification sought by the Company, failing which the bid will be summarily rejected.

c) In case any of the clauses in the BRC contradict with other clauses of Bid Document elsewhere, then the clauses in the BRC shall prevail.

d) The originals of such documents [furnished by bidders(s)] shall have to be produced by bidder(s) to OIL as and when asked for.
