BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC): The bid shall conform to the specifications and terms and conditions given in the Bidding Documents. Bids will be rejected in case material and services offered do not conform to the required parameters stipulated in the technical specifications. Notwithstanding the general conformity of the bid to the stipulated specifications, the following requirements will have to be particularly met by the Bidders without which the same will be considered as non-responsive and rejected. All the documents related to BRC shall be submitted along with the Techno-Commercial Bid.</p> <p>2.0 <u>TECHNICAL :</u></p> <p>2.1 BIDDERS ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA</p>

The bidder must have experience of construction and laying of API quality 'Cross-country' or 'installation piping-works' conforming applicable/ relevant ANSI, ISI Codes or standards during last 5(Five) years ending bid closing date.

i) Single contract of minimum value Rs. 12.0 lakh (Rupees Twelve lakh) only.

OR

ii) Two contracts each of minimum value Rs. 8.0 lakh each (Rupees Eight lakh) only.

OR

iii) Three contracts each of minimum value Rs. 6.0 lakh each (Rupees Six lakh) only.

Note : Documents establishing successful completion of above contracts must be submitted along with techno-commercial bid . These documents should be in the form of copies of Contracts / work orders and completion certificates/ payment certificates issued by the clients. However, the originals of these documents shall have to be produced by the bidder as and when asked for.

3.0 FINANCIAL

3.1. The average minimum annual turnover achieved by the bidder as per their audited financial results during the last three financial years shall be 5.0 lakh (Five Lakh) only.

3.2. Bidders net worth as per last three-audited financial year statement shall be positive.

3.3. Documentary evidence to this effect should be submitted along with the techno-commercial bid.

3.4. Price quoted shall be inclusive of all tax.

3.5. Item rate of SOR in Price Bid shall be quoted in figure as well as in words, failing which the Bid shall be rejected.

4.0 COMMERCIAL:

4.1 Bid security shall be furnished as a part of 'Techno-Commercial Bid'. Any bid not accompanied by a proper bid security will be rejected.

4.2 Any bid received in the form of Telex/Cable/Fax/E-mail/ Telephone call will not be accepted.

4.3 Bid shall be typed or written in indelible ink and original bid shall be signed by the Bidder or their authorized representative on all pages failing which the bid will be rejected.

4.4 Bid shall contain no inter-lineation, erasures or overwriting except as necessary to correct errors made by Bidder, in which case such corrections shall be initialed by the person(s) signing the bid.

However, white fluid should not be used for making corrections. Any bid not meeting this requirement shall be rejected.

- 4.5 The Techno-Commercial Bid should not have any price indication.
- 4.6 Any bid containing false statement will be rejected.
- 4.7 Bidders must quote clearly and strictly in accordance with the price schedule of Bidding Documents, otherwise the bid will be rejected.
- 4.8 The Bid Documents are not transferable. Bids made by parties who have not purchased the Bid Documents from the Company will be rejected.
- 4.9 Any Bid received by the Company after the deadline for submission of bids prescribed by the Company will be rejected.
- 4.10 Price quoted by the successful Bidder must be firm during the performance of the Contract and not subject to variation on any account. A bid submitted with an adjustable price will be treated as non-responsive and rejected.
- 4.11 The following Clauses with all its sub-clauses should be agreed in toto, failing which the bid will be rejected.
 - a) Performance Security Clause
 - b) Force Majeure Clause
 - c) Termination Clause
 - d) Settlement of disputes Clause
 - e) Liquidated Damages Clause.
 - f) Acceptance of Jurisdiction and applicable law.
 - g) Tax liabilities clause.
 - h) Insurance clause.
 - i) With holding clause.
 - j) Liability clause.

5.0 GENERAL:

- 5.1 In case Bidder takes exception to any clause of Tender Document not covered under BEC/BRC, then the Company has the discretion to load or reject the offer on account of such exception if the Bidder does not withdraw/ modify the deviation when/as advised by the Company. The loading so done by the Company will be final and binding on the Bidders. No deviation will however, be accepted in the clauses covered under BEC/BRC.
- 5.2 To ascertain the substantial responsiveness of the bid the Company reserves the right to ask the Bidder for clarification in respect of clauses covered under BEC/BRC also and such clarification fulfilling the BEC/BRC clauses must be received on or before the deadline given by the Company, failing which the offer will summarily rejected.
- 5.3 In case, any of the clauses in the BRC contradict with other clauses of Bid Document elsewhere, then the

		<p>clauses in the BRC shall prevail.</p> <p>5.4 Any exceptions/deviations to tender must be spelt out by Bidder in their 'Techno-Commercial' bid only. Any additional information/terms/ conditions furnished in sealed 'Price Bid' will not be considered by Company for evaluation/award of contract.</p> <p>6.0 BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC):</p> <p>6.1 The bids conforming to the technical specifications, terms and conditions stipulated in the bid documents and considered to be responsive after subjecting to the Bid Rejection Criteria will be considered for further evaluation as per the Bid Evaluation Criteria given below:</p> <p>6.2 To ascertain the inter-se-ranking, the comparison of the responsive bids will be made on the basis of total cost of various surveys envisaged under the contract.</p> <p style="text-align: right;">*****</p>
