BID REJECTION / EVALUATION CRITERIA

A) BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC)

The bid shall conform to the specifications and terms and conditions given in the Bidding Documents. Bids will be rejected in case material and services offered do not conform to the required parameters stipulated in the technical specifications. Notwithstanding the general conformity of the bid to the stipulated specifications, the following requirements will have **to be particularly met by the Bidders without which the same will be**

considered as non-responsive and rejected. All the documents related to BRC shall be submitted along with the Techno-Commercial Bid.

1.0 TECHNICAL :

1.1 BIDDERS ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

The Bidder shall be in the business of

- a) Civil construction in Road and Buildings AND/OR
- b) Construction of API quality cross-country Hydrocarbon pipeline conforming to ANSI – B 31.4 / ANSI – B 31.8 or 600 # Plant Piping for sizes 12 inches (300 mm) diameter or above.

Should a single bidder not have the requisite experience as mentioned in (a) and (b) above, a Pre-bid agreement entered between two different contractors shall have to be submitted, clearly mentioning therein the leader of the consortium. The agreement shall also clearly define the roles and responsibilities of each party, with the matrix forming a part of the agreement. In case of a consortium the term bidder shall for all purpose mean the consortium.

- c) The bidder shall have experience in Installation of electrical equipment and ancillaries in Zone 1 hazardous area, and have valid electrical license for the state of Assam.
- d) The bidder shall have experience in design, supply and installation of Automatic Fire detection and alarm system for at least 3 years

In case the Bidder does not have the qualification as specified in (c) and (d) above the Bidder shall have Pre-bid Tie-up in the form of agreement or MOU with parties who meets the requisite qualification as mentioned in (c) and (d) above. The leader however shall be either (a) or (b) above.

1.2 The average annual financial turnover of the Bidder during the last three years (i.e. ending 31st March 2007) should not be less than Rs 1.90 crores (Rupees one crore and ninty lakhs only).

1.3 Experience of having successfully completed in the last 7 years ending last day of month previous to the month of the Bid closing.

- a) 3 similar works of value not less than Rs. 2.50 crores (Rupees two crores and forty five lakhs only) OR
- b) 2 similar works of value not less than Rs. 3.12 crores (Rupees three crores and five lakhs only) OR
- c) 1 similar work of value not less than Rs. 4.97 crores (Rupees four crores and ninty lakhs only)

The term similar works, in reference to para. above shall mean Civil construction of Roads and Buildings/construction of API quality cross-

country Hydrocarbon pipeline / 600 # API quality Plant piping as per ANSI B.31.4 /ANSI B.31.8 of dia 12" (300 mm) and above.

Note: All documents relating to clause 1.3 above, required for establishing bidders turnover and experience, must be submitted along with the techno-commercial bid. These documents should be in the form of **photocopies of Work Orders/ Completion certificates / Payment certificates** issued by the Owner. The bidder shall produce the original documents for verification by OIL when requested for.

2.0 COMMERCIAL:

- 1.1 Bidder shall submit the offer under Single Stage" Two Bid System" viz the "Techno-commercial bid" and the "Price Bid". Both the bids shall be sealed in two separate envelopes super-scribing the Tender No., Bid closing date and clearly mentioning about the bid i.e. either "**TECHNO-COMMERCIAL BID**" or "**PRICE BID**" as the case may be. Both the envelopes shall then be put inside one single envelop, duly sealed, super-scribing the Tender No. and Bid closing date. Any offer, not complying with the above mentioned procedure will be rejected.
- 1.2 The Techno-Commercial Bid should not have any price indication.
- 1.3 Bidder shall furnish Bid Security along with Bid as referred to in Section-II. Bid security shall be furnished as a part of 'Techno-Commercial Bid'. Any bid not accompanied by a proper bid security will be rejected.
- 1.4 Validity of the bid shall be minimum 180 days. Bids with lesser validity will be rejected.
- 1.5 Any bid received in the form of Telex/Cable/Fax/E-mail/ Telephone call will not be accepted.
- 1.6 Bid shall be typed or written in indelible ink and original bid shall be signed by the Bidder or their authorized representative on all pages failing which the bid will be rejected.
- 1.7 Bid shall contain no inter-lineation, erasures or overwriting except as necessary to correct errors made by Bidder, in which case such corrections shall be initialed by the person(s) signing the bid. However, white fluid should not be used for making corrections. Any bid not meeting this requirement shall be rejected.
- 1.8 Bidders must quote clearly and strictly in accordance with the price schedule outlined in Section-V of Bidding Documents, otherwise the bid will be rejected.
- 1.9 Any bid containing false statement will be rejected.

- 1.10 The Bid Documents are not transferable. Bids made by parties who have not purchased the Bid Documents from the Company will be rejected.
- 1.11 Any Bid received by the Company after the deadline for submission of bids prescribed by the Company will be rejected.
- 1.12 Price quoted by the successful Bidder must be firm during the performance of the Contract and not subject to variation on any account. A bid submitted with an adjustable price will be treated as non-responsive and rejected.
- 1.13 The following Clauses with all its sub-clauses should be agreed in toto, failing which the bid will be rejected. To this effect Bidder shall submit an undertaking along with the Techno Commercial Bid.
- a) Performance Security Clause
 - b) Force Majeure Clause
 - c) Termination Clause
 - d) Settlement of disputes Clause
 - e) Liquidated Damages Clause.
 - f) Acceptance of Jurisdiction and applicable law.
 - g) Tax liabilities clause.
 - h) Insurance clause.
 - i) With holding clause.
 - j) Liability clause.

2.0 GENERAL:

- 2.1 In case Bidder takes exception to any clause of Tender Document not covered under BEC/BRC, then the Company has the discretion to load or reject the offer on account of such exception if the Bidder does not withdraw/ modify the deviation when/as advised by the Company. The loading so done by the Company will be final and binding on the Bidders. No deviation will however, be accepted in the clauses covered under BEC/BRC.
- 2.2 To ascertain the substantial responsiveness of the bid the Company reserves the right to ask the Bidder for clarification in respect of clauses covered under BEC/BRC also and such clarification fulfilling the BEC/BRC clauses must be received on or before the deadline given by the Company, failing which the offer will be summarily rejected.
- 2.3 In case, any of the clauses in the BRC contradict with other clauses of Bid Document elsewhere, then the clauses in the BRC shall prevail.
- 2.4 Any exceptions/deviations to tender must be spelt out by Bidder in their 'Techno-Commercial' bid only. Any additional information/terms/ conditions furnished in sealed 'Price Bid' will not be considered by Company for evaluation/award of contract.

B) BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC):

- 1.0 The bids conforming to the technical specifications, terms and conditions stipulated in the bid documents and considered to be responsive after subjecting to the Bid Rejection Criteria will be considered for further evaluation as per the Bid Evaluation Criteria given below:
- 2.0 To ascertain the inter-se-ranking, the comparison of the responsive bids will be made on the basis of total cost of various works envisaged under the contract.
