**1.0 BIDDERS ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

The Bidder should be experience in carrying out Geotech investgation of Rivers for laying petroleum pipeline across rivers.

1.1 Bidder shall submit the offer under the bid put inside one single envelop, duly sealed, super-scribing the Tender No. and Bid closing date. Any offer, not complying with the above mentioned procedure will be rejected.

1.2 Bidder shall furnish Earnest Money Bid Security along with Bid as referred to in Section-II. Earnest Money shall be furnished as a part of Bid. Any bid not accompanied by a proper Earnest Money will be rejected.

- 1.3 Validity of the bid shall be minimum 180 days. Bids with lesser validity will be rejected.
- 1.4 Any bid received in the form of Telex/Cable/Fax/E-mail/ Telephone call will not be accepted.
- 1.5 Bid shall be typed or written in indelible ink and original bid shall be signed by the Bidder or their authorized representative on all pages failing which the bid will be rejected.
- 1.6 Bid shall contain no inter-lineation, erasures or overwriting except as necessary to correct errors made by Bidder, in which case such corrections shall be initialed by the person(s) signing the bid. However, white fluid should not be used for making corrections. Any bid not meeting this requirement shall be rejected.
- 1.7 Bidders must quote clearly and strictly in accordance with the price schedule outlined in Section- V of Bidding Documents, otherwise the bid will be rejected.
- 1.8 Any bid containing false statement will be rejected.
- 1.9 The Bid Documents are not transferable. Bids made by parties who have not purchased the Bid Documents from the Company will be rejected.
- 1.10 Any Bid received by the Company after the deadline for submission of bids prescribed by the Company will be rejected.
- 1.11 Price quoted by the successful Bidder must be firm during the performance of the Contract and not subject to variation on any account. A bid submitted with an adjustable price will be treated as non-responsive and rejected.
- 1.12 The following Clauses with all its sub-clauses should be agreed in toto, failing which the bid will be rejected. To this effect Bidder shall submit an undertaking along with the Bid.
  - a) Performance Security Clause
  - b) Force Majeure Clause
  - c) Termination Clause
  - d) Settlement of disputes Clause
  - e) Liquidated Damages Clause.
  - f) Acceptance of Jurisdiction and applicable law.
  - g) Tax liabilities clause.
  - h) Insurance clause.
  - i) With holding clause.
  - j) Liability clause.

## **2.0 GENERAL:**

In case Bidder takes exception to any clause of Tender Document not covered under BEC then the Company has the discretion to load or reject the offer on account of such exception if the Bidder does not withdraw/ modify the deviation when/as advised by the Company. The loading so done by the Company will be final and binding on the Bidders.

### **3.0 BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC):**

To ascertain the inter-se-ranking, the comparison of the responsive bids of the duly qualified bidder as per BEC will be made on the basis of total cost of various works envisaged under the contract.

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
