Salient Features Of Eligibility Criteria for Tender No. DCO5349P10AG

1.0 BID REJECTION CRITERIA

1.1 The bid shall conform generally to the specifications and terms and conditions given in the Tender Documents. Bids will be rejected in case services offered do not conform to the required parameters stipulated in the technical specifications. Notwithstanding the general conformity of the bid to the stipulated specifications, the following mandatory requirements will have to be particularly met by the Bidders without which the same will be considered as non-responsive and rejected. All the documents related to BRC must be submitted along with the Techno-Commercial Bid.

1.2.1 The bidder shall have experience in executing SIMILAR nature of jobs in Central/State Govt./ PSUs/ State Govt. Enterprises during the last 7 (seven) years ending bid closing date.

"SIMILAR" nature means-

The job involving erection of pressure vessels/ Tanks/ piping network/ pumping set etc/ in oil/ gas installations like QPS/ EPS/ OCS/ GCS/ GGS/ Refinery/ POL Depot/ Tank farm terminals etc.

1.2.2 The bidder shall have experience of successfully executing the above nature of work(s) of the following magnitude during the last 7(seven) years ending bid closing date:

- i) Must have executed a minimum value of Rs. 45,00,000.00 (Rupees forty five lakh only) in a single contract,
OR
- ii) Must have executed a minimum value of Rs. 25,00,000.00 (Rupees twenty five lakh only) each in two separate contracts,
OR
- iii) Must have executed a minimum value of Rs. 20,00,000.00 (Rupees twenty lakh only) each in three separate contracts.

1.2.3 The bidder should have an average annual turnover during the last three years ending 31.03.2009 at least of Rs. 15,00,000.00 (Rupees fifteen lakh only).

1.2.4 Bid will be rejected if not accompanied with adequate documentary proof (Refer Note-1 below) in support of experience and turnover as mentioned in Para 1.2.2 and 1.2.3.

Note-1:-

A) For proof of Annual turnover, the following documents/ photocopy must be submitted along with the bid:

- i) A certificate issued by a practicing Chartered/ Cost Accountants' Firm, certifying the Annual Turnover and nature of business, and
- ii) Audited Balance Sheet and Profit and Loss account.

B) For proof of requisite Experience, any one of the following document/ photocopy must be submitted along with the bid:

i) In case of OIL contractors, copy of 'Certificate of Completion (COC)'/ 'Certificate of Payment (COP)'/ 'Service Entry Sheet (SES)' of jobs successfully executed during the last 7 (seven) years ending bid closing date showing gross value of job done.

ii) Certificate issued by any other Public Sector Undertaking/ Govt. Department/ State Govt. Enterprise during the last 7 (seven) years ending bid closing date showing:

- (a) Gross value of job done,
- (b) Nature of job done, and
- (c) Contract period.

1.2.5 The bidder shall submit Bank Account number, VAT Regd. No., Provident Fund Code number (Direct Code)/ or a declaration by the applicant that provisions of Provident Fund Act is not applicable to them (with documentary evidence). In case the P.F. is required to be deposited later on, the same will be deposited by the bidder (applicant).

1.0 BID REJECTION CRITERIA

1.1 The bid shall conform generally to the specifications and terms and conditions given in the Bid Documents. Bids will be rejected in case services offered do not conform to the required parameters stipulated in the technical specifications. Notwithstanding the general conformity of the bid to the stipulated specifications, the following mandatory requirements will have to be particularly met by the Bidders without which the same will be considered as non-responsive and rejected. All the documents related to BRC must be submitted along with the Techno-Commercial Bid.

1.2.1 The bidder shall have minimum experience in carrying out SIMILAR nature of jobs in PSUs/ Central/ State Govt. Enterprises.

"SIMILAR" nature means-

Jobs involving application of anti-corrosive coating/ FRP lining on the inside surface of crude oil storage/ formation water tank,

OR,

Tank fabrication jobs including application of anti-corrosive coating on the inside surface of crude oil storage/ formation water tank.

1.2.2 The bidder shall have experience of successfully executing the above nature of work(s) of the following magnitude during the last 7(Seven) years ending bid closing date:

i) Must have executed a minimum value of Rs.75,00,000.00 (Rupees seventy five lakh only) in a single contract.

OR

ii) Must have executed a minimum value of Rs.45,00,000.00 (Rupees forty five lakh only) each in two single contracts.

OR

iii) Must have executed a minimum value of Rs.35,00,000.00 (Rupees thirty five lakh only) each in three single contracts.

1.2.3 The bidder should have an average annual turnover during the last three years ending 31.03.2009 at least of Rs.25,00,000.00 (Rupees twenty five lakh only).

1.2.4 Documents (Commercial and Technical):

1.2.4.1 For proof of Annual turnover, the following documents/ photocopy must be submitted along with the bid:

- i) A certificate issued by a practising Chartered / Cost Accountants' Firm, certifying the Annual Turnover and nature of business, and
- ii) Audited Balance Sheet and Profit and Loss account.

1.2.4.2 The bidder shall submit Bank Account number, Provident Fund Code No. and VAT Regd. No.

1.2.4.3 For proof of requisite Experience, any one of the following document / photocopy must be submitted along with the bid:

i) In case of OIL contractors, copy of 'Certificate of Completion (COC)'/ 'Certificate of Payment (COP)'/ 'Service Entry Sheet (SES)' of jobs successfully completed during the last 7(Seven) years ending bid closing date showing gross value of job done. It may be clearly noted that simply mentioning of OIL CCO Number will not be accepted.

ii) Certificate issued by any other Public Sector Undertaking / Govt. Department / Upstream Oil Company in last seven years ending bid closing date) showing:

- (a) Gross value of job done,
- (b) Nature of job done,
- (c) Contract period
