Recruitment of Probationary Officers in Grade B and Recruitment of F&A Executives

Important Points to be noted:

1. **The above schedule is only tentative and not final.**
2. No request for change in the Test time, date, centre, venue etc. will be considered under any circumstance.
3. Candidates qualifying the Computer Based Test will be called in the ratio of 1:5 in order of merit for appearing in the GD and PI
4. Mere issue of call letter for the GD/PI will not constitute an offer of employment.
5. The Call Letters for the GD/PI to the shortlisted candidates will be sent via email to the candidates. Hence the candidates are advised to keep checking their registered email ID.
6. The candidature of the candidates for the GD/PI will be **'PURELY PROVISIONAL'** pending detailed scrutiny of eligibility as per Oil India Limited's advertisement. Call letter will be issued based on qualifying the Computer Based Test and as per the declarations made by the candidates in the online application submitted for the post. Detailed scrutiny of the documents will be done on the day of GD/PI before appearing for the same. In case, it is found at any stage of recruitment/selection process that the any candidate do not fulfill the eligibility criteria and the declarations made by the candidate or any document/information submitted by him/her are found to be false or the candidate has provided any wrong information, at any point of time, the candidature of such candidate will be cancelled. If such an event happens after appointment, the services will be terminated without prejudice to OIL's right to take any action as it may deem fit.
7. Candidates working in PSU's/Govt. Sector/ Autonomous Bodies will have to submit the No Objection Certificate (NOC) compulsorily on the day of GD/PI before appearing for the same.
