1.0 Preamble:

OIL INDIA LIMITED (OIL), a premier National Oil Company, is engaged in the business of exploration, production and transportation of crude oil and natural gas for over five decades. It is a Maharatna Company under Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas, Government of India and the second largest National Oil Company in the country.

OIL's KG Basin Project office located at Kakinada is presently carrying out Development and production activities of oil and natural gas from the Krishna Godavari offshore basins and Exploration activities in Kerala Konkan Offshore Block. The Project Office of OIL at Kakinada is well connected by road, rail and air.

a. DSF II Block, KG/OSDSF/GSKW/2018:

OIL acquired the Block, KG/OSDSF/GSKW/2018 covering an area of 93.902 Km² with 100% stake as the Operator under Discovered Small Fields (DSF) round II in March 2019 & awarded by Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas (MOP&NG), Govt. of India for carrying out appraisal and development for Petroleum & Natural Gas in the block. The block lies in shallow water offshore area off Amalapuram coast and south of Ravva field and is in two parts separated by a distance of around 1.75 km, with water depths ranging from 5 to 15 m. The area of the Eastern part of the block is 64.547 Km² and the Western part of the block is 29.355 Km². The closest point of block boundary to the east coast is at around 650 m, while the farthest point of the block boundary is at around 11.2 km.

b. Kerala Konkan (KK) Offshore Block:

The offshore block KK-OSHP-2018/1 in Kerala- Konkan offshore was awarded to OIL by MoPNG under the OALP-III bidding round. The Company is the sole participant in the block with 100% participating interest. The Revenue Sharing Contract (RSC) for the block was signed on 16th August, 2019.

2.0 Objective:

OIL intends to engage Jack-up drilling unit to drill & complete 4 (four) development wells through Unmanned Wellhead Platforms in DSF II Offshore Block, KG/OSDSF/GSKW/2018 and to drill 01 (one) exploratory well in Kerala Konkan Offshore block, KK/OSHP/2018-1.

Before floating the tender, OIL intends to understand the bidder's perspective on the tender conditions through interaction with reputed & established Offshore Drilling unit providers around the globe who have expertise in offering Offshore Well Drilling & Completion services.
