



CORRIGENDUM NOTIFICATION NO. OIL/ADMN/13A/25-26/243 DATED 21/08/2025

This corrigendum is being issued with reference to the advertisement no: OIL/ADMN/13A/25-26/240 dated 08/08/2025 for which applications were invited. The “**Selection Methodology**” as mentioned in clause 3.0 may be **READ AS** under:

3.0 SELECTION METHODOLOGY:

- (i) The selection process shall consist of a Computer Based Test (CBT) wherein the qualifying marks for the Computer Based Test (CBT) will be 50% for UR/ OBC(NCL)/ EWS posts. For the posts reserved for SC/ PwBD the qualifying marks for the Computer Based Test (CBT) will be 40%.
- (ii) Candidates will be called for Computer Based Test (CBT) on the basis of their declaration in the online application form.
- (iii) The question paper for Computer Based Test (CBT) will consist of 3 (three) sections as detailed hereunder viz. (A) General English & General Knowledge/Awareness with some questions on Oil India Limited; (B) Reasoning, Arithmetic/Numerical & Mental Ability and (C) Relevant Technical Knowledge on the trade/discipline. Accordingly, the Computer Based Test (CBT) will assess the candidates on the following parameters and distribution of marks:

Section/ Part	Parameters	Percentage of Marks
A	General English & General Knowledge/Awareness and Questions on Oil India Limited.	20%
B	Reasoning, Arithmetic/Numerical & Mental Ability	20%
C	Domain or Relevant Technical Knowledge: Questions will be based on the qualification prescribed for the post and commensurate with the level of the post.	60%

- (iv) The Computer Based Test (CBT) will comprise of questions in the multiple-choice questions (MCQ) format.
- (v) There will be no negative marking in the Computer Based Test (CBT).
- (vi) The Computer Based Test (CBT) will be bilingual i.e. English & Hindi.
- (vii) The total duration of the Computer Based Test (CBT) will be 02 (two) hours.
- (viii) Compensatory time in addition to the duration of the Computer Based Test (CBT) will be allowed to candidates who are Persons with Disabilities, as applicable.
- (ix) **If there is a tie in the marks obtained in the Computer Based Test (CBT), then the candidate who obtains more marks in Part-C of the Computer Based Test (CBT) will be given preference. In case, if the marks in Part-C are same, then the candidate who obtains more marks in Part-B will be given preference. If the marks in Part-B are also same, then the candidate older in age will be given preference in the list of shortlisted candidates called for the next stage of selection process i.e. Document Verification Process.**
- (x) **Candidate(s) will be shortlisted in the order of merit i.e. based on marks obtained in the Computer Based Test (CBT) and will be called for the next stage of selection process i.e. Document Verification Process in the ratio of 1:1 (i.e. for one vacancy, one candidate will be shortlisted with due cognizance to number of reserved posts). In the event that a shortlisted candidate fails to submit the requisite documents, as per the prescribed eligibility criteria as notified in the advertisement,**

during the document verification stage, the next candidate in order of merit will be called for document verification. This process will continue until the vacancy is filled or the merit list is exhausted, whichever is earlier.

- (xi) Candidates will be intimated in their registered e-mail/phone number for the Document Verification Process as per their declaration in the online application form.
- (xii) In case the candidate is called for Document Verification Process, he/she has to bring the downloaded application form along with all ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS [in the order as mentioned in para 4.0 of the Advertisement No. OIL/ADMN/13A/25-26/240 dated 08/08/2025] together with ONE SEPARATE SET OF PHOTO COPY of all documents duly SELF ATTESTED (in the same order) at the time of document verification process, failing which his/her candidature will be cancelled outright.
- (xiii) However, merely securing qualifying marks in Computer Based Test (CBT) will not make candidate(s) eligible to appear in the Document Verification Process.
- (xiv) Upon clearance of the document verification stage, the final selection will be made in order of merit, based on the marks obtained in the Computer Based Test (CBT), subject to the candidate fulfilling all the prescribed eligibility criteria as notified in the advertisement.

IMPORTANT:

1. All other terms & conditions of the Detailed Advertisement no. OIL/ADMN/13A/25-26/240 dated 08/08/2025 remain unaltered.
2. In case of any inconsistency in any terms & conditions pertaining to the Selection Methodology of the concerned Advertisement and this Corrigendum, the terms & conditions of this Corrigendum shall prevail.
3. The online application process for the concerned advertisement remains unaffected by this corrigendum.
