DESCRIPTION:

Hiring of Services for Multi-Frac in 05 (five) nos. of Horizontal Wells to be completed while drilling to enhance production from the wells.

1.0 PREAMBLE:

OIL INDIA LIMITED (OIL), a Government of India Enterprise under the Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas, is a premier upstream Maharatna E&P Company engaged in the business of Exploration, Production & Transportation of Crude Oil & Natural Gas as well as production of LPG. Its Field Headquarters (FHQ) is at Duliajan, Dibrugarh district, Assam (INDIA) and Corporate Office is in Noida, UP (INDIA). OIL's operations are largely based in the North-Eastern parts of India particularly in Assam, Arunachal Pradesh, and Tripura. Additionally, OIL operates in Rajasthan, Andhra Pradesh, Andaman and Kerala-Kankan and also has overseas presence.

2.0 OBJECTIVE:

Horizontal wells are drilled primarily in thick sand reservoirs primarily to enhance the production from the wells. OIL started drilling horizontal wells since 2006 with the first horizontal well being MKM-019 which was in production from 2006 to 2015. OIL has been producing from various fields of Assam and Arunachal, mainly from Naharkatiya, Jorajan, Moran, Makum, Hapjan, Kumchai etc. Balimara area which falls under Western Satellite Fields was discovered in 2012 with the first producing well being Balimara-1. Since then, several other wells have been drilled and are on production.

Now, OIL has planned to go for drilling horizontal wells in Balimara area with multiple fracture treatments in order to enhance production from these wells. OIL has planned for multistage fracking for drilling in five (05) horizontal locations in Balimara area. The targeted reservoir is the 4032-m Barail Sand of BMR001 Block. The expected average gross and net reservoir sand thicknesses are approximately 52 m and 33 m, respectively. The objective depths of these locations fall in the range of 3870 m to 3950 m TVDSS. The primary aim of this campaign is to increase the surface area for fluid flow and improve production, by creating multiple hydraulic fractures along the horizontal wellbore.

This EOI is floated with an intention to invite participation from the prospective vendors and thereby to submit their bids for providing services for Multi-Fracking in the Horizontal wells while drilling in 05 (five) nos. of wells in Balimara area of Assam.

3.0 DELIVERABLES:

The bidder may be required to give a presentation to OIL on a later date after submission of EOIs on the possibility of rendering the services of “Multi-Fracking in 05 (five) nos. of Horizontal Wells” of OIL to be hired through an open tender in the future.

4.0 EVALUATION CRITERIA:

The proposals received through this Expression of Interest (EOI) shall be evaluated based on the following criteria for OIL’s future open tender for hiring Service for Multi-Fracking in 05 (five) nos. of Horizontal Wells:

- i. Technical experience in performing multi-stage fracturing in horizontal wells with a minimum of 03 similar jobs in past 05 years.
- ii. Availability and readiness of specialized equipment.
- iii. Availability of qualified and experienced personnel including Frac Engineer, Supervisors, and Pumping Operators.
- iv. Compliance with safety, environmental, and regulatory requirements.

- iii. List and specification of available equipment.
- iv. Tentative Scope of Work, Terms of Reference and necessary specification with proposed methodology.

Note: Based on the inputs received from the prospective bidders, a Scope of Work will be prepared and forwarded to the parties for obtaining Budgetary Quotation for OIL’s future open tender.
