**CORRIGENDUM –1 FOR OIL TENDER NO. CGI1973L27**

This corrigendum is issued to notify the following in the tender document.

1. **Total Estimated Cost: Rs 38,99,858.25 excluding PF & GST**
2. **TENDER VALUE: Rs. Rs 38,99,858.25**
3. PERIOD OF WORK COMPLETION: **6 months.**
4. This tender document is issued to **OIL Registered A, B & C Class Civil Contractors under Pipeline Sphere** only in line with clause no 7.6.3(i) of OIL's Manual for Procurement of Works. OIL Registered Civil Contractors other than **A, B & C** Class under Pipeline Sphere are not eligible to participate in this tender.
5. **The Integrity Pact is not applicable against this tender.**
6. Serial no. of **FINANCIAL CRITERIA** under **BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC)/BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC)** to be read as **9.0** instead of 2.0.
7. The bidder must have successfully executed/completed similar Works over last 7(seven) years reckoned from the Original Bid Closing Date in Central/State Government / PSUs/Nationalized Banks / Public Limited Company as under:
  - (i) One similar completed similar work each costing not less than INR 31,19,886.60 (excl. GST)
  - OR
  - (ii) Two similar completed works each costing not less than INR 19,49,929.13 (excl. GST)
  - OR
  - (iii) Three similar completed works each costing not less than INR 15,59,943.30 (excl. GST).
8. "Similar work" mentioned in Paragraph 8.0 (a) means the following:

**Construction of RCC building/RCC Framed Brick Boundary Wall.**

Note: "OIL-registered eligible bidders of Class A, B, and C are exempted from submitting documents fulfilling their experience and turnover criteria, as well as from depositing the bid security amount specified in Clause Nos. 8.0 (a) and 9.0 (a) of the BEC/BRC, provided they have submitted their One-Time Security Deposit in accordance with Clause No. 7.6.1 of the Manual for Procurement of Works."

**\*\*All Bidders including OIL registered bidder with one time security deposit must have to furnish the following information with relevant documents wherever necessary:**

- (a) Tax Exemption Certificate, if any, if applicable
- (b) PAN no. (photocopy of the PAN card required)
- (c) Goods & Service Tax registration No.
- (d) Bank account No. with name of Bank, Type of account, Bank address.
- (e) P.F. Account No. / Code or affidavit for applying P.F, if applicable.
- (f) ESI Registration Number, if applicable.

However, documents pertaining to sl. no. (b), (c) & (d) above are not applicable for OIL Registered Civil Contractors.

## **6.WORKS CONTRACT**

### **SCHEDULE OF COMPANY'S PLANTS, MATERIALS AND EQUIPMENT**

a) SCHEDULE OF MATERIALS AVAILABLE AT THE COMPANY'S STORES / STOCK PILES for permanent incorporation in works and

b) SCHEDULE OF COMPANY'S PLANTS AND EQUIPMENTS for use in the execution of work Materials:

- (i) Cement will be supplied by company free of cost.
- (ii) All empty cement bags must be returned to Company's Godown failing which Rs 8/- (Rupees Eight only) per bag for empty cement bags will be recovered from the Contractor's bill.

Plants and Equipment: - Nil

NOTE: -

1. The Contractor is to arrange transport of the above materials to site of work.
2. If the materials listed above are not available suitable substitute will be provided by the Company and Contractor shall incorporate the same in the works without extra cost.
3. Containers if issued to the contractor must be returned to Company in good condition.
4. Plants and equipment if issued to Contractor must be under proper watch so that no part is pilfered. These must be handled only by Company's operators. Contractor shall be responsible for any loss or damage to these plants and equipment while these are under his/their custody.
5. Materials issued to Contractor must be under proper watch & ward so that no part is pilfered. If any perforation takes place the matter will be referred to appropriate Govt. authorities for legal action as well as realization of the materials issued.
6. Cement, bitumen grade 30/40, bitumen felt issued to Contractor by the Company is meant only for the specific Company work relating to the Contract. However, if any quantity is left over from the quantities issued for any reason whatsoever, on the completion / cancellation / termination of the Contract the same shall have to be returned to the Company in full within one week of completion/cancellation of the work failing which the matter will be referred to appropriate Govt. authorities for legal action as well as realization of the materials.
7. All other materials issue to the Contractor by the Company if subsequently found to be in excess of the actual requirement will have to be returned by the Contractor within two weeks of completion of the work failing which the cost of all such materials will be recovered from the Contactor at double the value of materials without any reference to him
