

### Bid Corrigendum

GEM/2024/B/4777553-C1

Following terms and conditions supersede all existing “Buyer added Bid Specific Terms and conditions” given in the bid document or any previous corrigendum. Prospective bidders are advised to bid as per following Terms and Conditions:

#### Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

1. OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.
2. While generating invoice in GeM portal, the seller must upload scanned copy of GST invoice and the screenshot of GST portal confirming payment of GST.
3. Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components) : Only supply of Goods
4. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

#### Special Terms and Conditions

- 1) Materials shall be procured either from manufacturer or their authorized dealers/channel partners only. In case of authorized dealers or channel partners, they must submit valid dealership certificate along with the offer.
- 2) Catalogue/technical details of the offered item must be submitted along with the offer for technical evaluation.
- 3) Packing of materials should be adequate to avoid ingress of water/moisture and any transit damage. If any damage found at the time of receive, the item must be replaced with new one by the party with their own cost.
- 4) The meter must be provided with the enclosure.
- 5) Meter must be warranted for at least 1 year from the date of receipt at site.
- 6) Vending Charges, Site Creation, mobile app design shall be included for one year.
- 7) Technical checklist and General notes to bidders are attached as Buyer uploaded ATC document. Bidders shall submit their compliance against the same for evaluation.

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process.
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
