Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. 1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 % of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be $(\text{Increased quantity} \div \text{Original quantity}) \times \text{Original delivery period (in days)}$, subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

2. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

1.0 Financing of trade receivables of Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) through Trade Receivables Discounting System (TReDS) platform.

Based on the initiatives of Government of India to help MSE vendors get immediate access to liquid fund based on Buyers credit rating by discounting, OIL has registered itself on TReDS platform with M/s RXII, and M/s A TREDIS Ltd. (Invoice Mart). MSE vendors can avail this benefit by registering themselves with any of the exchanges providing e-discounting / electronic factoring services on TReDS platform and following the procedures defined therein, provided OIL is also participating in such TReDS Platform as a Buyer.

(i) Vendor should be aware that all costs relating to availing the facility of discounting on TReDS platform including but not limited to Registration charges, Transaction charges for financing, Discounting Charges, Interest on financing, or any other charges known by any name shall be borne by MSE Vendor.

(ii) MSE Vendor hereby agrees to indemnify, hold harmless and keep OIL and its affiliates, Directors, officers, representatives, agents and employees indemnified, from any and all damages, losses, claims and liabilities (including legal costs) which may arise from Sellers submission, posting or display, participation, in any manner, on the TReDS Platform or from the use of Services or from the Buyer's breach of any of the terms and conditions of the Usage Terms or of this Agreement and any Applicable Law on a full indemnity basis.

(iii) OIL shall not be liable for any special, indirect, punitive, incidental, or consequential damages or any damages whatsoever (including but not limited to damages for loss of profits or savings, business interruption, loss of information), whether in contract, tort, equity or otherwise or any other damages resulting from using TReDS platform for discounting their (MSE Vendor's) invoices.

Note:

(i) Buyer means OIL, who has placed Purchase Order / Contract on a MSE Vendor (Seller).

(ii) Seller means a MSE vendor, who has been awarded Purchase Order / Contract by OIL, (Buyer).

2.0 FORWARDING LETTER & INSTRUCTION TO BIDDERS, GENERAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT, SPECIAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT, ALL ANNEXURES & PROFORMAS, BEC/ BRC, etc. attached in "Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC" tab. Bidders shall have to upload duly filled up Annexures and Proformas along with documentary evidence in support of evaluation criteria and item specifications as per tender along with the technical bid.

3.0 If any of the specifications/ clauses mentioned in the body of the tender document contradict with that mentioned in the document uploaded under "Buyer added bid specific ATC", the specifications/ clauses mentioned in "Buyer added bid specific ATC" shall prevail.

4.0 Bidders are advised to submit their queries, if any, within 15 days from the date of tender publication. OIL shall not be liable to respond to any queries received after the stipulated deadline.

5.0 Documents to be submitted by the bidder along with the bid:

- b) Make, Model & other technical specifications of the offered engine.
- c) Make, Model, technical specifications & pump performance characteristics or curve of the offered pump.
- d) Document mentioning the estimated fuel consumption per hour with full load condition and fuel tank capacity.

6.0 Documents to be submitted by the bidder along with the supply of item:

- a) Copy of certificate for PESO approved spark arrestor to be provided along with the supply of item.
- b) Test Reports for hydrostatic test to be submitted along with the supply of item.
- c) Detailed manual of operation and maintenance procedure of pump and engine, in English language preferably with pictorial representation.
- d) One complete set of workshop manual, spare parts catalogue for engine and pump shall be supplied along with the pump in English language
- e) Warranty/Guarantee Certificate for portable pump.

7.0 The supplied items shall be for a minimum warranty of 12 (Twelve) months from the date of successful commissioning of the units. Warranty/Guarantee Certificate to be submitted along with the supply.

8.0 PRE-DISPATCH INSPECTION:

The materials must be offered for Pre-dispatch Inspection at the supplier's works by OIL's representative(s). The supplier shall intimate OIL at least 15(fifteen) days in advance about the scheduled Pre-dispatch inspection for the ready item.

9.0 COMMISSIONING & TRAINING: Commissioning & Training of "Portable Fire Pump" to be carried out at Central Fire Station, OIL, Duliajan, Assam by the supplier's representative and the cost incurred thereof must be included in the quoted price.

4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.

9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.

12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

All GeM Sellers / Service Providers are mandated to ensure compliance with all the applicable laws / acts / rules including but not limited to all Labour Laws such as The Minimum Wages Act, 1948, The Payment of Wages Act, 1936, The Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, The Equal Remuneration Act, 1976, The Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972 etc. Any non-compliance will be treated as breach of contract and Buyer may take suitable actions as per GeM Contract.
