

OIL JEEVIKA INITIATIVE PROMOTES SUSTAINABLE FARMING PRACTISES

13th July 2024: In alignment with Swachhta Pakhwada 2024 and OILJeevika - Assam, a day long workshop was conducted amongst the beneficiary farmers of Hollowtup Village, Tinsukia district, Assam. The Workshop was conducted on the subject of 'Household Waste Management and Composting'. The farmers were given classroom orientation on the subject by an organic farmer from Na Motapung gaon who taught the process of Bio Char production, Jeevamrut preparation, a microbial culture prepared to be used as natural fertiliser in organic farming to provide nutrients to crops.

Thereafter, 2 nos of vermicompost units with a capacity of 104 MT were inaugurated by officials of OIL & OIRDS at Hallowtup Village. A total of 5 nos of vermicompost units are being set up under Project OIL Jeevika. The event was attended by around 70 farmers.
