NOTICE FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR SERVICE OF CONSULTANCY from reputed consultant FOR CONVERSION OF OVERGROUND PIPELINE CROSSINGS ACROSS RIVER BRAHMAPUTRA TO SUBMERGED CROSSINGS

#### 1.0 Preamble:

Oil India Limited (OIL) is the second largest hydrocarbon exploration & production (E&P) Indian public sector Company under administrative control of the Ministry Petroleum and Natural Gas of the Government of India. OIL is engaged in the business of exploration, development and production of crude oil, natural gas and LPG as well as transportation of crude oil and petroleum products.

The 1157 km Naharkatia-Barauni Crude oil trunk pipeline (NBPL) stretching from Naharkatiya in Assam to Barauni in Bihar is the lifeline of the Company. It has given the company uninterrupted service for almost 60 years now. The pipeline Right-of-way (RoW) also accommodates two product pipelines namely Numaligarh –Siliguri multi product pipeline (NSPL) of OIL and Guwahati-Siliguri Product pipeline (GSPL) of IOCL.

All the three pipelines mentioned above cross river Brahmaputra (26°10′32″N 91°40′20″E) suspended from Rail cum Road Bridge ( Sarighat Bridge). The length of each pipeline crossing is 1.2 km approx. The dia. of the three pipelines crossing at Brahmaputra Bridge are 406.4 mm, 355.6 mm & 219.1 mm OD.

### 2.0 Scope of Work:

OIL intend to convert the over ground crossings across the river to submerged crossings either by HDD or micro-tunneling. The job will be carried out by a reputed Project Management Consultant / EPCM contractor.

The broad scope of work to be rendered by the consultant shall be as follows: --

i. Propose a cost effective and technically feasible method for crossing River Brahmaputra for

- all the three pipelines.
- ii. Overall Project Management for crossing 3 no. of pipeline, 2 no. of OFC casing a having provision of installation of 4th pipeline in future in case of micro tunnel.
- iii. Engagement of vendor for geo-tech Survey/Detailed Design of crossing methodology.
- iv. Estimation of detailed project cost of the selected methodology of crossing.
- v. Tender Assistance to OIL for carrying out the job.
- vi. Construction, Supervision and assistance in material procurement and execution as per design.
- vii Environmental Monitoring Guide lines.
- viii. Monitoring and Evaluation.
- ix. NOC/ Permission as required from concerned Authority / Stake holders

# 3.0 Qualification Criteria:

Interested parties with the following experience/Qualifying criteria only need to submit their **EXPRESSION OF INTEREST** (EOI) with credentials and supporting document: -

- a. High level of technical expertise & infrastructure for providing EPCM & PMC service in the hydrocarbon industry.
- b. Requisite experience & competency as PMC/ EPCM in design & execution of submerged crossings across river for hydrocarbon pipeline of minimum length 1000meter by HDD / Microtunneling for large cross-country hydrocarbon Pipeline Projects for over 10 years.
- c. Respondents, after scrutiny of the documents submitted, would be required to make a detailed presentation at Pipeline Headquarter in Guwahati, Assam (India), and to give a budgetary quotation to achieve the desired result.

#### EOI should include the following documents:

- (a) Letter of "Expression of Interest";
- (b) Company Profile;
- (c) Joint Venture Agreement, if applicable;
- (d) Relevant Experience Record;
- (e) Available Experts; and
- (f) Financial Information

Applicants meeting the qualification criteria may be invited for presentation / proposal before the selection committee of OIL.
