TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS AND PARAMETERS FOR CREW HUT	Bidder's Remark
1.0 SCOPE OF WORK:	
Design, fabrication & supply of Skid mounted crew Hut fitted with two wooden benches & one desk for resting of Production crew, one door, windows in three sides. The hut shall be robust in structure & transportable so that it can be transferred from one location to other location depending on requirement. The crew hut shall be constructed as per the dimensions of tentative drawing attached herewith.	
2.0 GENERAL DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION:	
2.1 Main Shell: The main fabrication of the structural framework should be of integral and all welded type to comprise of the bottom frame, overall framework, sloping self-draining roof and desired doors & windows etc. The main corner vertical support posts shall be of 2 inch tubing. All the corner posts shall be suitably welded at the top with a heavy gauge MS plate which should be able to hold steel forged lifting hooks.	
2.2 Skid: The under structure / base frame of the hut is to be mounted on the skid consisting of 02 (two) nos. of medium beam - ISMB 200 mm x 100 mm hot rolled 'I' section. At the end portion of the 'I' section structure on both the sides, Steel Pipe of size 142 mm NB X 9.5 mm W/Thickness should be inserted & welded properly. Base frame and skid should be made in such a way that no foundation is needed for placement of crew hut.	
2.3 Flooring: The entire flooring of the crew hut shall be of 6 mm thick MS plate, welded lengthwise and breadth wise properly with the base frame of the Skid.	
2.4 Side End Walls: The exterior cladding of the shell shall be of Vertical corrugated pressed steel as per IS. The Corrugated steel sheet shall be of 3 mm thick and shall be welded to the bottom MS channel frame, corner posts, top frame and roof frame. The corrugated version acts as stiffeners and increase strength to weight ratio and eliminates the use of any other vertical	

supports. All gaps should be sealed at edges and at seams, bottom sills to prevent ingress of insects, moisture etc.	
2.5 Roof: The roof shall be of sloping type from the centre towards the walls for efficient drain of rainwater. The roof shall be made of 3 mm thick plain MS steel sheets as per IS and is provided with adequately pressed reinforced sections from inside for additional strength. All the structural steel used shall be of standard quality as per IS specifications and all steel component / section, machine pressed for rigidity to optimize strength to weight ratio.	
2.6 Weather Shed: All doors & windows opening shall be provided with weather shed. The weather shed shall be made out of 2 mm thick MS sheets as per IS.	
2.7 Door & Windows: 2.7.1 Door: One (1) no. of Door in each hut of size 1800 mm (H) x 900 mm (W). The door shall be open from outside. Door shall have the provision of locking arrangement externally/internally. 2.7.2 Windows: Three (3) nos. of Windows in each hut as per dimensions given in the tentative drawing.	
2.8 Insulation (Inner paneling): Insulation of thick Thermo Cool/ Marine Glass Wool/ Mineral glass wool / Fiber glass resin bonded wool should be provided on all side walls, end walls, roof with special weather proof adhesives. This insulation should be hot proof, fire retardant, non-hygroscopic and vermin proof and besides having excellent thermal efficiency and acoustic performance.	
2.9 Electrical fittings: i. One 5 Amp socket along with a switch and one point for bulb along with a switch shall be provided in each hut. Necessary electrical wirings for the same shall be provided. ii. Suitable connection for connecting external power source for fan, cooler etc. shall be provided at the exterior. iii. Two cabin earth points (on the skid or body, outside) shall be provided for final termination of earth wires.	
2.10 Pre-treatment & Painting: The surface preparation for all steel surfaces shall be pre-treated by sand or shot blasting for degreasing and de-rusting followed by one coat of primer and followed by one coat of epoxy paint. The colour of the paint shall be grey.	
2.11 Suitable sitting arrangement: Huts are to be provided with suitable sitting arrangement of 2 Benches & 1 Desk (dimension a	

s per drawing) and a foldable table (wall mounted ; dimension not specified).	
3.0 THE HUT SHOULD BE FABRICATED AS PER THE FOLLOWING SPECIFICATIONS:	
3.1 All the tubular members, angle irons, M.S sheets etc. should be painted with two coats of red oxide paints for providing protection against the rust. The wooden members are to be painted with suitable paints.	
3.2 The huts shall be painted with three (3) coats with synthetic paints. The colour of the paint will be Grey colour .	
3.3 All tubular posts should be welded to the skid and not the chequered plate.	
3.4 Doors should be fitted with suitable #L# drops.	
3.6 Proper lighting facilities to be provided in each hut.	
3.7 One number of wall fan in each room are to be mounted at convenient place at suitable height.	
3.8 One number of window mounted desert air cooler to be incorporated in each hut having at least 50 Litres capacity and 2000 cubic metre coverage at each hut.	

4.0 SPECIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS:	
4.1 Bidder must forward along with the quotation the detailed drawings & specifications of proven design including each and every item (main shell, base frame, skid, flooring, side & end wall, roof, weather shed, insulation, inner panelling, doors, windows, shelf, electrical fitting/items, electrical drawing, details of wiring etc.) along with Bill of material failing which the offer will be rejected.	
4.2 Bidder to submit drawings with dimensions of the offered hut along with the bid for evaluation. Bid without drawings will be summarily rejected.	
4.3 Bidder shall furnish the details of the materials to be used for fabrication of the huts along with the bid.	
4.4 Bidder shall furnish the details list materials/items to be installed in each Crew Hut per the scope of work, design & drawing with quantity (without mentioning the prices) as per AN NEXURE-LIST along with the technical bid.	
4.5 P.O & Sl. Nos. of the huts are to be embossed and written by welding on a visible space with date such as on the top of the doors.	
4.6 In case of placement of order, the supplier s	

shall prepare the detail engineering drawing, GAD , etc. of the hut. Drawings shall be sent to OIL for approval within 4 weeks from the receipt of Purchase Order and fabrication of huts shall be started after approval only.	
4.7 Inspection by OIL: OIL reserves the right to depute OIL's engineer for inspection with following scopes and the supplier must arrange for the same accordingly by informing at least 15 days in advance . Each hut should be offered for inspection by OIL Engineer at the following stages : A) On completion of fabrication job but before fixing the plyboard lining. B) On completion of inside lining, painting i.e. before dispatching. C) At any time during the fabrication of the hut.	
4.8 Bidder must clearly mention the Brand/Make of their offered product fitted inside a Hut in their technical bid. The bidder shall confirm that materials to be supplied shall be new, of recent make, of the best quality & workmanship and shall be guaranteed by the Seller for a period of 18 months from the date of dispatch/shipment or 12 months from the date of receipt at destination, whichever is earlier, against defects arising from faulty materials, workmanship or design. Defective goods / materials or parts notified by OIL to the Seller shall be replaced immediately by the Seller on F.O.R destination basis including payment of all taxes and duties at Seller's expense. This guarantee shall survive and hold good notwithstanding inspection, payment for and acceptance of the goods.

1.1	The bidder should be a fabricator and should have the credentials of supplying Steel Fabricated Huts/ Crew Cabins/Bunk Houses in the past.	
2.0	BIDDER'S EXPERIENCE: 2.1 The bidder should have successfully executed at least one single similar order* of 50% of tendered quantity (rounded off to next higher integer) during last five (5) years preceding the original bid closing date of the tender to any Govt. organization/ PSU/ Central Govt./ Public Limited Company/Reputed Private Company. Note: *The term "Similar Order" shall mean: Order for Designing, Fabrication, Testing and Supply of Fabricated Huts/ Crew Cabins/ Bunk Houses having specification similar to NIT specification.	
2.2	The following three (03) sets of documentary evidences in support of above Para. 1.1 & 2.1 must be submitted along with the technical bid, failing which the Bid shall be treated as incomplete and rejected: Set-1: Any one of the following documents: a) Copy of Purchase order(s) b) Copy of contract(s) awarded by Client(s) Set-2: Any one of the following documents: a) Copy of Consignee delivery receipts b) Copy of challans c) Copy of Bill of Lading d) Copy of Tax Invoice/Commercial Invoice <u>Set-3: Any one of the following documents:</u> a) True copies of Original Signed and sealed Completion report (on Client's/User's official letter head with signature & stamp).

9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
