

Bid Corrigendum

GEM/2022/B/1911588-C4

Following terms and conditions supersede all existing "Buyer added Bid Specific Terms and conditions" given in the bid document or any previous corrigendum. Prospective bidders are advised to bid as per following Terms and Conditions:

Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

1. Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components) : Only supply of Goods
2. The buyer organization is an institution eligible for concessional rates of GST as notified by the Government of India. The goods for which bids have been invited fall under classification of GST concession and the conditions for eligibility of concession are met by the institution. A certificate to this effect will be issued by Buyer to the Seller after award of the Contract. Sellers are requested to submit their bids after accounting for the Concessional rate of GST.
Applicable Concessional rate of GST : 5%
Notification No.and date : 3/2017-Integrated Tax (Rate) dated 28/06/2017
3. Whereever Essentiality Certificate is applicable (PEL/ML), successful bidder should provide Proforma Invoice for processeing for EC application and material should be dispatche after receiving of EC rom DGH. In view of the same, an ATC may be incorporated in GeM, viz, "BIDDER/OEM must provide Proforma Invoice for processeing for EC application within 15 days from date of issue of GeM Contract and material should be dispatche after receiving of EC rom DGH."
4. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

(I) BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC):

The bids must conform to the specifications and terms and conditions given in the tender. Bids shall be rejected in case the item(s) offered do not conform to the required minimum/maximum parameters stipulated in the technical specifications and to the respective international / national standards wherever stipulated. Notwithstanding the general conformity of the bids to the stipulated specifications and terms and conditions, the following requirements shall have to be particularly met by the bidders, without which the offer will be considered as non-responsive and rejected.

A) TECHNICAL:

1.0 Bidder's Qualification:

1.1 The bidder shall be an original equipment manufacturer (OEM) or an authorized distributors/authorized dealers/authorized agents of the OEM.

In this regard, the bidder should submit the following documents along with the bid:-

- a. In case of an OEM, a copy of certificate specifying the nature of business of the firm shall be furnished.
- b. In case of authorized distributors/authorized dealers/authorized agents, valid authorization certificate from the OEM shall be submitted.

2.0 Bidders Experience:

2.1) In case, the bidder is an Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM), the following criteria shall be met by the Bidder:

2.1a) The bidder should be a manufacturer of “Air compressor along with safe filling cabinet for breathing apparatus set” and the bidder shall be in the business of manufacturing the air compressor along with safe filling cabinet for breathing apparatus set for the last 5 years as on original bid closing date of this tender. In this regard, the bidder should submit the copy of purchase order(s) and proof of supply/ commissioning report(s)/ performance report(s) along with bid.

2.1b) The bidder shall have experience of successfully executing of at least 01 (one) purchase order of quantity not less than 01 No. of “**Air compressor along with safe filling cabinet for breathing apparatus set**” in preceding 05 (five) years from the original stipulated bid closing date of the tender. In this regard, the bidder should submit the copy of purchase order(s) and proof of supply/ commissioning report(s)/ performance report(s) to any central govt. / state govt. / PSU / public limited company along with the bid.

2.2) In case the Bidder is an authorized dealer of OEM, the following criteria shall be met by the Bidder:

2.2a) The bidder shall be in the business of supply of “Air compressor along with safe filling cabinet for breathing apparatus set” for the last 5 years as on original bid closing date of this tender. In this regard, the bidder should submit the copy of purchase order(s) and proof of supply/ commissioning report(s)/ performance report(s) along with bid.

2.2b) The bidder shall have experience of successfully executing of at least 1 (one) purchase order of quantity not less than 01 No. of “**Air compressor along with safe filling cabinet for breathing apparatus set**” in preceding 05 (five) years from the original stipulated bid closing date of the tender. In this regard, the bidder should submit the copy of purchase order(s) and proof of supply / commissioning report(s) / performance report(s) to any central govt. / state govt. / PSU / public limited company along with the bid.

Notes:

(a) Documentary evidence in respect of supply experience as specified under **Clause Nos. 2.1a), 2.1b), 2.2a) and 2.2b)** should be submitted in the form

of copies of relevant Purchase Orders along with copies of any of the following documents in respect of satisfactory execution of each of those Purchase Orders, such as –

i. Satisfactory Supply Completion / Installation /Commissioning certificate

(OR)

ii. Consignee Receipted Delivery Challans

(OR)

iii. Central Excise Gate Pass / Tax Invoices issued under relevant rules of Central Excise/GST

(OR)

iv. Any other documentary evidence that can substantiate the satisfactory execution of the purchase order.

(b) The Purchase Order date need not be within 05 (five) years preceding the original bid closing date of this tender. However, the execution of supply should be within 05 (five) years preceding the original bid closing date of this tender.

(c) Satisfactory supply completion/inspection/installation report (if submitted) should be issued on client's official letterhead with signature and stamp.

(d) A job executed by a bidder for its own organisation / subsidiary cannot be considered as experience for the purpose of meeting BEC.

B) FINANCIAL:

a) Annual Financial Turnover of the bidder during any of preceding 03 (three) financial / accounting years from the original bid closing date should be at least **₹12,50,000.00.**

b) Net Worth of the firm should be Positive for preceding financial / Accounting year **(FY: 2020-2021).**

Note -For (a) & (b): Considering the time required for preparation of Financial Statements, if the last date of preceding financial/accounting year falls within the preceding six months/within the due date for furnishing of audit report as per Section 139(1) of IT Act, 1961 (read along with latest circulars/notifications issued by CBDT from time to time) reckoned from the original bid closing date and the Financial Statements of the preceding financial/accounting year are not available with the bidder, then the financial turnover of the previous three financial /accounting years excluding the preceding financial/accounting year will be considered. In such cases, the Net worth of the previous financial/accounting year excluding the preceding

financial/accounting year will be considered. However, the bidder has to submit an affidavit/undertaking certifying that **'the balance sheet/Financial Statements for the financial year 2020-2021 has actually not been audited as on the original bid closing date'**.

Note:

a) For proof of Annual Turnover & Net worth any one of the following document must be submitted along with the bid:-

i) A certificate issued by a practicing Chartered Cost Accountant (with Membership Number and Firm Registration Number), certifying the Annual turnover & Net worth as per format prescribed in ANNEXURE-J.

OR

ii) Audited Balance Sheet along with Profit & Loss account."

b) In case the bidder is a Central Govt. Organization/PSU/State Govt. Organization/Semi-State Govt. Organization or any other Central/State Govt. Undertaking, where the auditor is appointed only after the approval of Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the Central Government, their certificates may be accepted even though FRN is not available. However, bidder to provide documentary evidence for the same.
