BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC)

The bid shall conform to the specifications and terms and conditions given in the Bidding Documents. Bids shall be rejected in case material and services offered do not conform to the required parameters stipulated in the technical specifications. Notwithstanding the general conformity of the bid to the stipulated specifications, the following requirements shall have to be particularly met by the Bidders without which the same shall be considered as non-responsive and will not be considered for evaluation. All the documents related to BEC shall be submitted along with the Technical Bid.

1.0 <u>TECHNICAL CRITERIA</u>:

1.1 **EXPERIENCE**:

The bidder must have experience in successfully executing/completing at least 01 (One) 'SIMILAR WORK' of minimum value of Rs. 24,22,260.00 (Rupees Twenty-Four Lakh Twenty Two Thousand Two Hundred Sixty) only, under single contract during the last 07 (Seven) years reckoned from the original bid closing date in Central Govt./State Govt./Public Sector Undertaking/State Govt. Enterprise/Public Limited Company.

Notes to BEC Clause 1.1 above:

- A) "SIMILAR" nature of work mentioned in 1.1 means:"Experience in carrying out Upkeepment/Sanitation Services".
- **B)** The bidder must submit a notarised undertaking on non-judicial stamp paper as per **PROFORMA-XIV** regarding compliance of Minimum wage, PF, ESIC & Bonus as per the applicable acts.
- **C)** For proof of requisite experience (refer Clause No. 1.1, the following documents/photocopy (self-attested/attested) must be submitted along with the bid:

- **E)** Mere award of contract(s) shall not be counted towards experience. Successful completion of the awarded contract(s) to the extent of volume & value, as stipulated respectively under Clause Nos. 2.1 shall only be treated as acceptable experience.
- **F)** Following work experience shall also be taken into consideration:
 - i) If the prospective bidder is executing similar work which is still running and the contract value/quantity executed prior to original bid closing date is equal to or more than the minimum prescribed value in the BEC.
 - ii) In case the start date of the requisite experience is beyond the prescribed 07 (Seven) years reckoned from the original bid closing date but completion is within the prescribed 07 (Seven) years reckoned from the original bid closing date. However, the value of Similar Work done must be requisite within the prescribed 07 (Seven) years period from the original bid closing date.

- **G)** Experience of executing similar work through 'sub-contracting' shall not be considered for evaluation.
- **H)** SIMILAR work executed by a bidder for its own organization/subsidiary cannot be considered as experience for the purpose of meeting BEC.

2.0 FINANCIAL CRITERIA:

- 2.1 Annual Financial Turnover of the bidder during any of preceding 03 (Three) financial/accounting years from the original bid closing date should be at least Rs. 14,53,360.00 (Rupees Fourteen Lakh Fifty Three Thousand Three Hundred Sixty only).
- 2.2 Net worth of the bidder must be Positive for the preceding financial/accounting year.

Note:

i. Annual Financial Turnover of the bidder from operations shall mean: 'Aggregate value of the realisation of amount made from the sale, supply or distribution of goods or on account of services rendered, or both, by the company (bidder) during a financial year' as per the Companies Act, 2013 Section 2 (91).

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ii. 3.0 COMMERCIAL EVALUATION CRITERIA:

3.1 The bids are to be submitted in Single Stage under Two Bid System i.e. Un-priced Techno-Commercial Bid and Price Bid separately. The Un-priced techno-commercial bid (or Technical bid) must comprise of all the technical documents substantiating the previous experience, financial & technical credentials of the bidder and any other document as asked for in the bid document. There should not be any indication of price in the Technical bid; otherwise, the bid shall be rejected straightway.

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3.2 Bidders must fill the 'PRICE BIDDING FORMAT/FINANCIAL DOCUMENT' and compute all-inclusive (including GST) bid value. This all-inclusive (including GST) bid value is to be entered against the 'OFFER PRICE' field in the GeM portal. The duly filled 'PRICE BID/FINANCIAL DOCUMENT' in electronic form must be submitted by the bidders through GeM Portal only along with the Financial Bid. Any Financial Bid without the duly filled Price Bid shall be liable for rejection.]

Note: The breakup of the quoted/offered price i.e. the duly filled Price Bid Format MUST NOT be uploaded with the technical bid; otherwise the bid shall be rejected straightway.

- 3.3 The quantities shown against each item in the BOQ shall be considered for the purpose of Bid Evaluation. It is, however, to be clearly understood that the assumptions made in respect of the quantities for various operations are only for the purpose of evaluation of the bid and the Contractor will be paid on the basis of the actual quantity consumed, as the case may be.
- 3.4 The price quoted by the successful bidder must be firm during the performance of the contract and not subject to variation on any account except as mentioned in the bid document. Any bid submitted with adjustable price quotation other than the above shall be treated as non-responsive and rejected.
- 3.5 Bid Security is not applicable against this tender. However, bidders shall submit along with their bid a signed "Bid Security Declaration" (PROFORMA-V) accepting that, if they withdraw or modify their bids during the period of validity; or if they are awarded the contract and they fail to sign the contract; or if they fail to submit performance security before the deadline defined in the NIT; they shall be suspended for the period of two years. This suspension of two years shall be automatic without conducting any enquiry.
- 3.6 Any bid received in the form of Physical document/Telex/Cable/Fax/E-mail shall not be accepted.
- 3.7 Bids shall be typed or written in indelible ink. Bids shall contain no interlineations, erasures or overwriting except as necessary to correct errors made by bidder, in which case such corrections shall be initialed by the authorized signatory. However, white fluid should not be used for making corrections. Any bid not meeting this requirement shall be rejected.
- 3.8 Any bid containing false statement shall be rejected and action shall be taken by Company as per bid document.
- 3.9 There should not be any indication of price in the Un-priced Techno-Commercial Bid. A bid will be straightway rejected if this is given in the Un-priced Techno-Commercial Bid.
- 3.10 Bid received with validity of offer less than **150 (one hundred fifty) days** from the date of Technical Bid opening shall be rejected. Bidder must submit a declaration regarding bid validity as per the format prescribed in **PROFORMA-I**.
- 3.11 Bidder must accept and comply with the following provisions as given in the Tender Document in toto, failing which offer shall be rejected:
- (i) Firm price
- (ii) Bid Security Declaration

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- (iii) Period of validity of Bid
- (iv) Price Schedule
- (v) Performance Bank Guarantee/Security deposit
- (vi) Delivery/Completion Schedule
- (vii) Scope of work
- (viii) Guarantee of material/work
- (ix) Liquidated Damages clause
- (x) Tax liabilities
- (xi) Arbitration/Resolution of Dispute Clause
- (xii) Force Majeure, Liability, Termination, Withholding
- (xiii) Applicable Laws
- (xiv) Specifications
- (xv) Integrity Pact
- 3.12 The Integrity Pact is applicable against this tender. OIL shall be entering into an Integrity Pact with the bidders as per format enclosed vide "Integrity Pact" of the tender document. This Integrity Pact proforma has been duly signed digitally by OIL's competent signatory. The proforma has to be returned by the bidder (along with the Un-priced Techno-Commercial Bid) duly signed (digitally) by the same signatory who signed the bid, i.e., who is duly authorized to sign the bid. Uploading the Integrity Pact with digital signature shall be construed that all pages of the Integrity Pact has been signed by the bidder's authorized signatory who sign the Bid.

4.0 PRICE EVALUATION CRITERIA:

- 4.1 Price bids shall be opened in respect of only the techno-commercially acceptable bidders whose bids have been found to be substantially responsive. A substantially responsive bid is one that meets the terms and conditions of the Tender and/or the acceptance of which bid shall not result in indeterminate liability on OIL.
- 4.2 Bidders are required to quote for all the items in the BOQ. In case the bidder does not quote against any of the line items, the total bid value shall be considered as inclusive of the cost of the particular service/item.
- 4.3 The bidders are advised not to offer any discount/rebate separately and to offer their prices in the BOQ after considering discount/rebate, if any.
- 4.4 Conditional and unsolicited discount shall not be considered in evaluation. However, if such bidder happens to be the lowest recommended bidder, unsolicited discount without any condition shall be considered for computing the contract price.
- 4.5 In case of identical overall lowest offered rate by more than 01 (one) bidder, the selection shall be made in accordance with GeM GTC.

5.0 GENERAL:

- 5.1 In case bidder takes exception to any clause of bidding document not covered under BEC-BRC, then the Company has the discretion to load or reject the offer on account of such exception if the bidder does not withdraw/modify the deviation when/as advised by company. The loading so done by the company shall be final and binding on the bidders. No deviation shall however be accepted in the clauses covered under BEC/BRC.
- 5.2 Bidders should provide self-attested copies of GST Registration Certificate, PAN Card, ESIC registration (if applicable), P.F. Registration Number OR Declaration (Declaration by applicant that provisions of Provident Fund Act are not applicable to them. In case P.F. is required to be deposited later on, the same shall be deposited by the bidder (applicant). In case successful bidder doesn't have P.F. Code at the time of bidding and PF Act is applicable on him/her, the same has to be provided by him/her before signing of contract agreement and issue of Work Order by OIL.
- 5.3 To ascertain the substantial responsiveness of the bid the Company reserves the right to ask the bidder for clarification in respect of clauses covered under BEC-BRC also and such clarifications fulfilling the BEC-BRC clauses in toto must be received on or before the deadline given by the company, failing which the offer shall be shall be evaluated based on the submission. - 5.5 Bidder(s) must note that requisite information(s)/financial values etc. as required in the BEC/BRC & tender are clearly understandable from the supporting documents submitted by the Bidder(s); otherwise Bids shall be rejected.

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- 5.6 OIL shall not be responsible for delay, loss or non-receipt of applications for participating in the bid sent by mail and shall not entertain any correspondence in this regard.
- 5.7 The originals of such documents [furnished by bidder(s)] shall have to be produced by bidder(s) to OIL as and when asked for.
