Bid Corrigendum

GEM/2022/B/2750648-C1

Following terms and conditions supersede all existing "Buyer added Bid Specific Terms and conditions" given in the bid document or any previous corrigendum. Prospective bidders are advised to bid as per following Terms and Conditions:

Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

- 1. OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.
- 2. Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components) : Supply Installation Testing and Commissioning of Goods
- 3. The buyer organization is an institution eligible for concessional rates of GST as notified by the Government of India. The goods for which bids have been invited fall under classification of GST concession and the conditions for eligibility of concession are met by the institution. A certificate to this effect will be issued by Buyer to the Seller after award of the Contract. Sellers are requested to submit their bids after accounting for the Concessional rate of GST.

Applicable Concessional rate of GST: 12%

- 4. The Buyer has an existing set up / inventory of similar products. The offered / supplied product must be compatible with existing system. The bidder has to ensure Compatibility of the supplied items or shall have to include in the supply the necessary hardware / software to make them compatible at no extra cost to the buyer. The details of items with which compatibility is required are as under: 30
- 5. **Upload Manufacturer authorization:** Wherever Authorised Distributors are submitting the bid, Manufacturers Authorisation Form (MAF)/Certificate with OEM details such as name, designation, address, e-mail Id and Phone No. required to be furnished along with the bid.
- 6. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

A. The **TECHNICAL BID** submitted by the bidder must also comply the following:

- Technical Specifications, Standard Terms & Conditions and Special Terms and Conditions as per **Annexure-I**
- ii. Buyer added text based additional terms and conditions BEC/BRC (Annexure-II)
- iii. The bidders must submit the **Profoma-1**, **Profoma-2**, **Profoma-3** as applicable.
- iv. For the convenience of the bidders, Experience Criteria & Financial Criteria (Detailed in **Annexure-II**) is reproduced as under:

a) Experience Criteria:

1. Bidder should have the experience of successful execution of **SUPPLY AND COMMISSIONING** of at one **Similar Order for Rs. 9.70 Lakhs** in preceding **5** (five) years as on the original Bid Closing date.

'Similar Order' means Purchase Order containing supply of Fixed base stations, Mobile base stations and Walkie-Talkie sets.

b) Financial Criteria:

The bidder must have annual Financial Turnover from Operations equal to **Rs. 9.70 Lakh** (Rupees Thirty Lakh only) in any of the preceding 3 (Three) financial/accounting years reckoned from the original bid closing date as per the Audited Annual Reports. The Bidder must submit the complete list of recommended spares of the compressor unit, engine, control and instrumentation system with part number & price list along with the offer (**Priced bid under Financial Document section**). This list of spares & price list must be uploaded by the bidder under the **Financial Document Section** & **NOT along with the technical bid.**

*The bidder may also include detailed break-up of the prices in the Financial Document.

- c) Delivery period: Within 120 (One Hundred and Twenty) Days after obtaining WPC clearance in all respect. The bidder must assist OIL for completing the necessary formalities to obtain the necessary WPC permission
- <u>d) Installation & Commissioning:</u> Installation & Commissioning at site must be completed within 4 weeks after receipt of equipment.

e) Scope of Installation, Testing, Commissioning:

- i. To carry out installation of active components, passive components and accessories supplied as per standards for successful integration and implementation of the systems at sites as per OIL's requirement.
- ii. The Successful Bidder shall provide warranty for all the supplied items. as per Tender, for a period of one year from the date of the issuance of Field Acceptance Test Certificate. Any delay for acceptance, caused by the successful bidder will result in automatic extension of the total warranty period by the same period.
- iii. FIELD ACCEPTANCE TEST: Once the system is installed and operating, it shall be tested by the successful bidder and witnessed by OIL ENGINEER. The Test shall be carried out as per the detailed test procedure supplied by Bidder and approved by the OIL ENGINEER.
- iv. TEST RUN: This Test aims at keeping the complete system in operation for a period of 03 days continuously. In case of failure, the successful bidder shall rectify the fault and the Tests will be re-started till the system operates without failure for 03 days continuously. OIL ENGINEER shall have the right to reject the complete system or part thereof in the event(s) of the acceptance Tests failing in two attempts. The 'Test Run' shall be carried out after the commissioning of

complete system.

- v. Various observations and test results obtained during the various tests shall be documented and produced in the form of a report by the Bidder.
- vi. If malfunctions or failure of a unit or sub-system repeat, the Test shall be terminated, and Bidder shall replace the necessary components and assemblies to correct the deficiencies. Thereafter, the Test shall commence all over again from the start as mentioned above. If after this one replacement, the unit or sub-system still fails to meet the requirement, the Bidder shall replace the complete unit or sub-system with the one that meets the requirements and restart the Test all over again.
- vii. Any hardware or software not specifically mentioned but required to achieve full functionality as per specifications and for the safe operation, shall be included in the Bidder's scope of supply, installation & commissioning.
- viii. Installation & Commissioning completion certificate will be released only after successful installation & commissioning and functionality test of the equipment.

Note: In Case Bidder submits priced bid anywhere along with the technical bid & not with the Priced Bid, such offers shall be straightaway rejected.

Any clause incorporated by the Buyer such as demanding Tender Sample, incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to make in India Policy, mandating any Brand names or Foreign Certification, changing the default time period for Acceptance of material or payment timeline governed by OM of Department of Expenditure shall be null and void and would not be considered part of bid. Further any reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses shall also be null and void. If any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations. Also, GeM does not permit collection of Tender fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction as the case may be. Any stipulation by the Buyer seeking payment of Tender Fee / Auction fee through ATC clauses would be treated as null and void.
