

Bid Corrigendum

GEM/2022/B/1836556-C2

Following terms and conditions supersede all existing "Buyer added Bid Specific Terms and conditions" given in the bid document or any previous corrigendum. Prospective bidders are advised to bid as per following Terms and Conditions:

Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

1. Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.
2. Bidder shall submit the following documents along with their bid for Vendor Code Creation:
 - a. Copy of PAN Card.
 - b. Copy of GSTIN.
 - c. Copy of Cancelled Cheque.
 - d. Copy of EFT Mandate duly certified by Bank.
3. OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.
4. Supplier shall ensure that the Invoice is raised in the name of Consignee with GSTIN of Consignee only.
5. The buyer organization is an institution eligible for concessional rates of GST as notified by the Government of India. The goods for which bids have been invited fall under classification of GST concession and the conditions for eligibility of concession are met by the institution. A certificate to this effect will be issued by Buyer to the Seller after award of the Contract. Sellers are requested to submit their bids after accounting for the Concessional rate of GST.
Applicable Concessional rate of GST : 5%

6. While generating invoice in GeM portal, the seller must upload scanned copy of GST invoice and the screenshot of GST portal confirming payment of GST.
7. Whereever Essentiality Certificate is applicable (PEL/ML), successful bidder should provide Proforma Invoice for processeing for EC application and material should be dispatche after receiving of EC rom DGH. In view of the same, an ATC may be incorporated in GeM, viz, "BIDDER/OEM must provide Proforma Invoice for processeing for EC application within 30 to 45 days days from date of issue of GeM Contract and material should be dispatche after receiving of EC rom DGH."
8. Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components) : Only supply of Goods
9. Data Sheet of the product(s) offered in the bid, are to be uploaded along with the bid documents. Buyers can match and verify the Data Sheet with the product specifications offered. In case of any unexplained mismatch of technical parameters, the bid is liable for rejection.

11. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

Amendment dated 28.01.2022

The instant tender was floated with provision for submission of bid security. This provision has since been reviewed and it has since been decided to seek '**Bid Security Declaration**' in lieu of Bid Security. Accordingly, this amendment to tender is issued to notify the bidders that Bid Security is **not applicable** against this tender.

However, the bidders shall have to submit along with their bid a signed "**Bid Security Declaration**" (as per format attached as **Annexure-I** in **Buyer uploaded ATC Document**) accepting that, if they withdraw or modify their bids during the period of validity; or if they are awarded the contract / PO and they fail to sign / accept the contract / order; or if they fail to submit performance security before the deadline defined in the NIT; they will be suspended for a period of two years. This suspension of two years shall be automatic without conducting any enquiry.

All other terms and conditions of the tender remain unchanged. Bidders are requested to submit their offer considering above amendment/notification.

Amendment dated 03.02.2022:

As per Gazette Notification No. CG-DL-E-19012022-232763 dated 19.01.2022 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises, the existing enterprises registered under EM Part-II or UAM till 30.06.2020 shall continue to be valid till 31st day of March 2022. Accordingly, Clause [A] of Buyer uploaded ATC document has been amended as under:

"Documents required to be submitted by bidders who wish to avail benefit under MSE Policy:

*Categorisation and various criteria applicable to MSE bidders shall be guided by the Gazette Notification No. CG-DL-E-26062020-220191 dated 26.06.2020, Amendments vide Gazette Notification Nos. CG-DL-E-160-62021-227649 dated 16.06.2021 and No. CG-DL-E-19012022-232763 dated 19.01.2022 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small And Medium Enterprises. The existing enterprises registered under EM-Part-II or UAM till 30th June, 2020 shall continue to be valid only for a period up to the **31st day of March, 2022***

Bidders claiming the MSE status (MSE-General, MSE-SC/ST, MSE-Woman) against this tender have to submit the following documents along with the technical bid for availing the benefits applicable to MSEs:

i. Udyam Registration Number with Udyam Registration Certificate.

or

ii. Proof of registration with District Industry Centres or Khadi & Village Industries Commission or Khadi & Village Industries Board or Coir Board or National Small Industries Corporation or Directorate of Handicrafts & Handloom or Udyog Aadhaar registration or registration with any other body specified by Ministry of MSME.

Further, in case bidding MSE is owned by Schedule Caste or Schedule Tribe or Woman entrepreneur, valid documentary evidence issued by the agency who has registered the bidder as MSE owned by SC / ST entrepreneur / Woman entrepreneur should also be enclosed."
