### **CORRIGENDUM-6**

# GeM Tender No. GEM/2022/B/2614615

This Corrigendum No. 6 dated 28.12.2022 to GeM Tender No. GEM/2022/B/2614615 dated 07.10.2022 for "Hiring services for Design, Development, Hosting and Maintenance of a Web-Based Application System of 3-tier architecture for online collection of Application Forms, with a Registration Mechanism and provision for generation of various reports that may be required by Oil India Limited from time to time for miscellaneous purposes like Recruitment of personnel, Hiring of transport services / Special Services of same nature etc." is issued to amend the following:

(i) Clause No. 1.5 of SCC (under Section-II of STC of the tender) and of Scope of Work (SOW) has been amended as under:

# **Existing Clause**

The System must be designed such that the Application process begins with applicant's registration process. Registration process shall be deemed complete when applicant the authenticates / verifies himself/herself by entering the OTP sent on the provided Mobile Number and Email ID subsequent to which user profiles shall be created with unique Login ID and secure password. To ensure uniqueness of the registration, the Aadhaar Number of the applicants must be obtained. However, the Aadhaar Number obtained must be stored in encrypted form as per the existing norms of the Government of India. Further, Aadhaar Number has to be verified with the UIDAI which shall be in the Scope of the Contractor and a new reference number corresponding to that Aadhar number must be generated and stored in the database in encrypted form Aadhaar number should not be shown / displayed anywhere either in the database or in the hard copy of the application. Aadhaar details are highly confidential, and it should not be shared with anyone including the officials of Oil India unless Oil India specifically warrants such details. The Contractor must comply in toto with the latest Aadhar act and shall take all the necessary measures for compliance of the guidelines as laid down by the government from time to time.

# **Amended Clause**

The System must be designed such that the Application process begins with applicant's registration process and system should allow registration of users once only (per event) - uniqueness in record. Registration process shall be deemed complete when the applicant authenticates / verifies himself/herself by entering the OTP sent on the provided Mobile Number and Email ID subsequent to which user profiles shall be created with unique Login ID and secure password. To ensure uniqueness registration, proper provision/procedures shall be implemented by the Contractor. For instance, the Aadhaar number linked mobile number verification swithout capturing the full Aadhar number in the database may be provisioned as per the existing norms of the Government of India. In such a case, it becomes imperative for the Contractor mandatorily comply in toto with the latest Aadhar act and shall take all the necessary measures for compliance of the guidelines as laid down by the government from time to time.

(ii) Clause No. 1.15 of SCC (under Section-II of STC) and of Scope of Work (SOW) of the tender has been amended as under:

# **Existing Clause**

Testing: The developed system shall be tested. The contractor must have an inhouse quality assurance and product testing team with a robust quality management processes that are followed to test and certify the system. Testing should not be limited to system features and functionality. The system must be tested for Performance, Security, High-Availability, Usability, Business Continuity, and Disaster-Recovery. The testing should be done with proper Test Script which should be duly certified by OIL before commencement of the testing.

The contractor must provide a test environment to test the newly developed system by filling in the data and checking the integrity of the submitted data. OIL authority will scrutinize the system to certify the security, technicality and suitability of the developed system to meet the requirements of OIL. OIL will give the Final approval / User Acceptance of the only after system satisfactory Further improvement / performance. development of the system must be carried out by the Contractor if felt necessary by OIL team for enhancing the efficiency of the system without any additional cost / financial implication to OIL. On Final approval / User Acceptance of the system, Phase-1 of the contract shall be deemed complete.

### **Amended Clause**

Testing: The developed system shall be tested. The contractor must have an inhouse quality assurance and product testing team with a robust quality management process that are followed to test and certify the system. Testing should not be limited to system features and functionality. The system must be tested for Performance, Security, Usability, High-Availability, Business Continuity, and Disaster-Recovery. The testing should be done with proper Test Script which should certified OIL before dulv bv commencement of the testing.

The contractor must provide a test environment to test the newly developed system by filling in the data and checking the integrity of the submitted data. OIL authority will check the system to certify the suitability of the developed system to meet the requirements of OIL. OIL will give the Final approval / User Acceptance of the system only after satisfactory performance. Further improvement / development of the system must be carried out by the Contractor if felt necessary by OIL team for enhancing the efficiency of the system without any additional cost / financial implication to OIL. On Final approval / User Acceptance of the system, Phase-1 of the contract shall be deemed complete.

(iii) The number of Categories mentioned under Clause 2.1 of SCC shall be read as 02 (Two) in lieu of the existing as shown below.

(v) Clause No. 24 has been additionally inserted to the SCC (Section-II of STC) & Scope of Work (SOW) of the tender. The aforesaid Clause is reproduced as under:

# "Exit Management/Transition Out Phase

The responsibilities of Solution Provider are stated as follows:

- 1. Bidder must provide a comprehensive exit management plan and ensure that all the documentation required for smooth transition including configuration documents (in addition to the documentation provided by the CSP) are kept up to date and is handed over to the OIL during regular intervals as well as during the exit management process.
- 2. On expiry or termination of the contract, the contractor must transfer the data to OIL; the format of the data transmitted from the CSP to the OIL should leverage industry standard data formats (e.g., OVF, VHD, excel, bak etc.) whichever deemed fit by OIL to ease and enhance portability. Once the data transfer to OIL / exit process is completed, the bidder shall remove the data, content and other assets from the cloud environment and destroy the VMs, Content and data of OIL including backup data as per stipulations and shall ensure that the data cannot be forensically recovered and furnish a certificate towards the same to OIL.
- 3. The ownership of the data generated upon usage of the system, at any point of time during the contract or expiry or termination of the contract, shall rest absolutely with OIL."
