Buyer Added Bid Specific Terms and Conditions

1. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

- **A.** Bidders must meet the following technical criteria failing which their offer will be rejected:
- i. <u>Experience Criteria</u>: The bidder should have executed at least 1 (one) number of project with contract value not less than **INR 28.8 Lakh** for each contract of providing manpower services to

Central / State Gov. Departments / PSUS / Autonomous Bodies in last 3 financial years.

For proof of requisite experience, bidders have to along with the bid: Contract document / Work order / any other relevant document showing details of work supported with Completion Certificate issued by the end user for each contract, indicating the following: a. Contract / Work Order Number b. Detailed Scope of Work c. Actual Dates of Commencement and Completion.

- ii. The bidder / contractor should be registered with Labour Dept. of Government of Andhra Pradesh, holding a valid license under the latest Contract Labour (Regulation & Abolition) Act and should be having valid ESI, EPF Code No., Income-tax Account No., GST No., etc.
- iii. The bidder has to submit an undertaking stating that in the event of award of contract, they will pay wages to the deployed manpower not less than what they are getting from the principal employer.
- **B.** Total Price excluding GST, for each category [Tn] = (Basic pay + ESI + Provident Fund + ELDI + Bonus + EPF Admin Charges + Transport & Mobile Allowance) x Tenure / Duration of Employment x Number of manpower

Total Price excluding GST for all 4 categories [T] = T1 + T2 + T3 + T4

The service charge is to be quoted in percentage of [**T**].

Total contract cost = **T** + **GST** + **Service Charge Amount**.

- **C.** The Service Charge (in percentage) will remain firm and free from any escalation during the entire period of the Contract. It includes charges towards all the services under the Terms of Reference / Scope of Work of the Contract including and not limited to maintenance of the Contractor's Personnel, their uniform, equipment, out of pocket expenses, conveyance etc. and all applicable statutory taxes and duties.
- **D.** The Personnel to be deployed by the service provider will be selected by the Company.
- **E.** OIL has appointed Independent External Monitors (IEM) for a period of 03 (Three) years to oversee implementation of Integrity Pact in OIL. Bidders may contact the Independent External Monitors for any matter relating to the Integrity Pact at the following addresses:

Integrity Pact, in respect of a particular contract / order, shall be operative from the date IP is signed by both the parties till the completion of contract or as mentioned in Section 9 – Pact Duration, whichever is later. Any violation of the same would entail disqualification of the bidders and exclusion from future business dealings. Any issue relating to execution of contract / order, if specifically raised before the IEMs shall be looked into by IEMs.

In the event of any dispute between the management and the Contractor / Supplier, in case, both the parties are agreeable, they may try to settle dispute through mediation before the panel of IEMs in a time bound manner. If required, the organizations may adopt any mediation rules for this purpose. In case, the dispute remains unresolved even after mediation by the panel of IEMs, the organization may take further action as per the terms and conditions of the Contract / order. The fees / expenses on dispute resolution shall be equally shared by both the parties.

2. Generic

3. Financial Criteria

NET WORTH: Net Worth of the OEM should be positive as per the last audited financial statement.

4. Certificates

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

5. Generic

Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization. Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specification and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. Any clause incorporated by the Buyer such as demanding Tender Sample, incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to make in India Policy, mandating any Brand names or Foreign Certification, changing the default time period for Acceptance of material or payment timeline governed by OM of Department of Expenditure shall be null and void and would not be considered part of bid. Further any reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents / clauses shall also be null and void. If any seller has any objection / grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

This Bid is governed by the <u>General Terms and Conditions</u>, conditions stipulated in Bid and <u>Service Level</u>

<u>Agreement</u> specific to this Service as provided in the Marketplace. However in case if any condition specified in General Terms and Conditions is contradicted by the conditions stipulated in Service Level Agreement, then it will over ride the conditions in the General Terms and Conditions.

In terms of GeM GTC clause 26 regarding Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India, any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority. While participating in bid, Bidder has to undertake compliance of this and any false declaration and non-compliance of this would be a ground for immediate termination of the contract and further legal action in accordance with the laws.
