Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 100%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY.

Buyer Added Bid Specific Terms and Conditions

1. Generic

The buyer organization is an institution eligible for concessional rates of GST as notified by the Government of India. The goods for which bids have been invited fall under classification of GST concession and the conditions for eligibility of concession are met by the institution. A certificate to this effect will be issued by Buyer to the Seller after award of the Contract. Sellers are requested to submit their bids after accounting for the Concessional rate of GST.

2. Generic

Whereever Essentiality Certificate is applicable (PEL/ML), successful bidder should provide Proforma Invoice for processeing for EC application and material should be dispatche after receiving of EC rom DGH. In view of the same, an ATC may be incorporated in GeM, viz, "BIDDER/OEM must provide Proforma Invoice for processeing for EC application within 45 days from date of issue of GeM Contract and material should be dispatche after receiving of EC rom DGH."

3. Scope of Supply

Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components) : Only supply of Goods

4. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

A.0 The supplied item(s) and accessories should be brand new, unused and of prime quality.

B.0 The bidder must quote latest model for the item(s).

C.0 Instrument to be supplied along with accredited calibration certificate with minimum validity for 1 year.

D.0 The bidder shall provide technical literature/ catalogue along with the offer for technical scrutiny,

failing which the offer will be rejected.

E.0 The item shall be procured from original equipment manufacturer or their authorized dealers/agents. In case of dealer/agent, party must submit copy of their valid authorization certificate from OEM, without which the offer shall be rejected.

F.0 Responsibility for replacement of either defective or dissimilar materials of order is under the scope of the Supplier. If such a case arises, the supply shall be considered complete only after rectification/replacement of the damaged/defective material up to the satisfaction of M/s OIL.

G.0 The warranty period of the item should be for a minimum of 18 months from the date of dispatch/shipment or 12 months from the date of receipt of the item, whichever is earlier.

H.0 The material supply shall be accompanied with all accessories, O&M manual, test, calibration, hazardous area and warranty certificates.

I.0 Intrinsically Safe Certification Number Sticker should be pasted onto the supplied unit.

J.0 Hands on operation and maintenance training after material delivery (either at M/s OIL, Duliajan or through online webinar)

K.0 Packing must be adequate to avoid transit damages.

L.0 The communicators/Calibrators upon receipt at site shall be tested and if latest Device Description (DD) files are not available it will be the sole responsibility of the supplier to rectify the same at their own expense in all respect.

M.0 PBG

PBG must be valid for Twenty (20) months from the date of GeM Contract delivery period (completed) and claim period atleast for minimum One (01) year after expiry of PBG.

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization. Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specification and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. Any clause incorporated by the Buyer such as demanding Tender Sample, incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to make in India Policy, mandating any Brand names or Foreign Certification, changing the default time period for Acceptance of material or payment timeline governed by OM of Department of Expenditure shall be null and void and would not be considered part of bid. Further any reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents / clauses shall also be null and void. If any seller has any objection / grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

In terms of GeM GTC clause 26 regarding Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India, any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority.
