1. Scope of Supply

Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components) : Supply Installation Testing and Commissioning of Goods

2. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

- A. Bidder shall supply product catalogue/technical literature of the offered model/item along with the bid failing to which the offer will be rejected.
- B. Bidder should have valid ISO 9001/ISO 45001/ISO 14001 Certifications. Documentary evidence to be submitted along with the offer.
- C. Bidder must provide Design calculation in support of their design to ensure safety & stability along with offer.
- D. Bidder must provide Quality Assurance Plan (QAP) along with offer.
- E. Raw materials certificate from source has to be submitted, along with supply of materials. Sample of the similar certificate to be submitted along with offer.
- F. Test reports in favour of load bearing capacity, powder coating have to be submitted along with materials supply.
- G. Bidder should submit paint manufacturer's certificate along with offer.
- H. Warranty: Goods, materials to be supplied shall be new, of recent make, of the best quality & workmanship and shall be guaranteed by the Supplier for a period of 18 months from the date of dispatch / shipment or 12 months from the date of receipt at destination, whichever is earlier against defects arising from faulty materials, workmanship or design.

I. Delivery Schedule:

- I.1 Delivery of the Materials: Within 120 days
- I.2 Intimation will be provided to the supplier as soon as material is received at Instrumentation Department.
- I.3 The supplier shall be given intimation 15 days in advance for Installation and Commissioning.
- I.4 Time required for Installation & Commissioning including handing over to OIL: 45 days.
- I.5 Therefore total time required: 180 days
- J. PBG:
- J.1 PBG must be valid for Twenty (20) months from the date of GeM Contract delivery period (completed) and claim period atleast for minimum One (01) year after expiry of PBG.

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization.
