2. Inspection of Stores by Nominated Inspection Authority / Agency of buyer or their authorized representatives

An independent third party Professional Inspection Body can help buyer in mitigating buyer's risk with predispatch/post-dispatch inspection in order to ensure that equipment, components, solutions and documentation conform to contractual requirements. The buyer has a right to inspect goods in reasonable manner and within reasonable time at any reasonable place as indicated in contract. Inspection Fee/ Charges (as pre-greed between buyer and Inspection Agency) would be borne by the buyer as per their internal arrangement but may be recovered from the seller if the consignment failed to conform to contractual specification and got rejected by the Inspection Officer .If so requested and accepted by the seller , initially seller may pay for inspection charges as applicable and get the same reimbursed from buyer if consignment accepted by the Inspecting Officer . For reimbursement seller has to submit proof of payment to Inspection Agency.

Seller/OEM shall send a notice in writing / e-mail to the Inspecting officer / inspection agency specifying the place of inspection as per contract and the Inspecting officer shall on receipt of such notice notify to the seller the date and time when the stores would be inspected. The seller shall, at his own expenses, afford to the Inspecting officer, all reasonable facilities as may be necessary for satisfying himself that the stores are being and or have been manufactured in accordance with the technical particulars governing the supply. The decision of the purchaser representative /inspection authority regarding acceptance / rejection of consignment shall be final and binding on the seller.

The Seller shall provide, without any extra charge, all materials, tools, labour and assistance of every kind which the Inspecting officer may demand of him for any test, and examination, other than special or independent test, which he shall require to be made on the seller's premises and the seller shall bear and pay all costs attendant thereon.

The seller shall also provide and deliver store / sample from consignment under inspection free of charge at any such place other than his premises as the Inspecting officer may specify for acceptance tests for which seller/OEM does not have the facilities or for special/ independent tests.

In the event of rejection of stores or any part thereof by the Inspecting officer basis testing outside owing to lack of test facility at sellers premises, the seller shall, on demand, pay to the buyer the costs incurred in the inspection and/or test. Cost of test shall be assessed at the rate charged by the Laboratory to private persons for similar work.

Inspector shall have the right to put all the stores or materials forming part of the same or any part thereof to such tests as he may like fit and proper as per QAP/governing specification. The seller shall not be entitled to object on any ground whatsoever to the method of testing adopted by the Inspecting officer.

Unless otherwise provided for in the contract, the quantity of the stores or materials expended in test will be borne by seller.

Inspecting officer is the Final Authority to Certify Performance / accept the consignment. The Inspecting officer's decision as regards the rejection shall be final and binding on the seller.

The seller shall if so required at his own expense shall mark or permit the Inspecting officer to mark all the approved stores with a recognised Government or purchaser's mark.

2. Generic

3. Generic

4. Generic

- iii) The Seller fails to deliver the Material(s) or any part thereof within the stipulated Delivery Period and/or to replace/rectify any rejected or defective Material(s) promptly.
- iv) The Seller becomes bankrupt or goes into liquidation.
- v) The Seller makes a general assignment for the benefit of creditors.
- vi) A receiver is appointed for any substantial property owned by the Seller.
- vii) The Seller has misrepresented to Buyer, acting on which misrepresentation Buyer has placed the Purchase Order on the Seller.

8. Generic

While generating invoice in GeM portal, the seller must upload scanned copy of GST invoice and the screenshot of GST portal confirming payment of GST.

9. Generic

Whereever Essentiality Certificate is applicable (PEL/ML), successful bidder should provide Proforma Invoice for processeing for EC application and material should be dispatche after receiving of EC rom DGH. In view of the same, an ATC may be incorporated in GeM, viz, "BIDDER/OEM must provide Proforma Invoice for processeing for EC application within 195 days from date of issue of GeM Contract and material should be dispatche after receiving of EC rom DGH."

12. Certificates

13. Warranty

Warranty period of the supplied products shall be 1 years from the date of final acceptance of goods or after completion of installation, commissioning & testing of goods (if included in the scope of supply), at consignee location. OEM Warranty certificates must be submitted by Successful Bidder at the time of delivery of Goods. The seller should guarantee the rectification of goods in case of any break down during the guarantee period. Seller should have well established Installation, Commissioning, Training, Troubleshooting and Maintenance Service group in INDIA for attending the after sales service. Details of Service Centres near consignee destinations are to be uploaded along with the bid.

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization. Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity/restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and/or terms and conditions governing the bid. Any clause incorporated by the Buyer such as demanding Tender Sample, incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to make in India Policy, mandating any Brand names or Foreign Certification, changing the default time period for Acceptance of material or payment timeline governed by OM of Department of Expenditure shall be null and void and would not be considered part of bid. Further any reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses shall also be null and void. ANNEXURE-A

SPECIFICATIONS & SCOPE OF WORK

Item Description:

Skid mounted Rectangular Chemical Tank of size: Length-8000mm; Width 2700 mm; Height 1500 mm mounted on a Base Frame made out of ISMC 125mm X 65mm which is mounted on an Oil Field type 3 (three) runner skid made out of ISMB-250.

The body of the tank should be made out of 8.0 mm thick MS crimped plates, bottom should be made out of 8.0mm thick plain MS plate & top of the tank should be covered with serrated flooring on a rugged frame suitably welded on structure.

Each tank must have the basic features viz. 6" suction points with connection in the front and rear side of each tank, cleanout & outlet with connection (2 Nos), ladder, folded type railing and other accessories.

Technical details of the tank are mentioned in Annexure-A-1 as follows:

A rough sketch of the tank is attached herewith. However the bidder must have to provide the detail drawing of the tank, Master skid, ladder and folded type railing with dimensions, accessories, crimp design etc for technical scrutiny.

Annexure: A-1

1.0 Dimension of the Tank: Each tank should have following dimensions:

- i. Length: 8000mm [Overall Length: 9200 mm including 600mm long working platform with 10mm chequered plate welded on it in the front side & 300mm skid extension on each end for tail boarding]
- ii. Width: 2700 mmiii. Height: 1500 mm

1.1 Construction of Tank Wall, Roof & Bottom:

- i) Tank Wall: All 4(four) walls should be constructed with 8.0mm thick MS crimped plates welded on Body Frame.
- ii) Body Frame: The Body Frame of the tank should be made out of:
 - a) Vertical Post [Min 8 nos]: 91.4mm MS SHS of min 5.4mm thick.
 - b) Horizontal Wall Framing [bottom, middle]: 91.4mm MS SHS of min 5.4mm thick.
 - c) Horizontal Wall Framing [top]: Mud gunning line along the length of the tank & should be made out of 113.5mm MS SHS of min 5.4mm thick. 2 Nos 2 inch nipple with butterfly valve to be fixed in the mud gunning line

- d) Support members for Roof/ Top of the tank (Breadth wise): 72mm MS SHS of min 4.8mm thick.(minimum 5 Nos) and lengthwise: 72mm MS SHS of min 4.8mm thick.(minimum 2 Nos)
- d) Each tank has two Nos chamber separated by 8 mm plate and plate shall be welded on a frame made of 72mm MS SHS of min 4.8mm thick. The frame shall be welded on the tank structure. Two nos 10" Gate valves (operated from top of the tank) to be fixed in the partitions (8 mm plate)
- e) Other steel structural item may be used for fabrication of Tank Frame.

The detail should be shown in the drawing to be provided along with the offer.

iii) Tank Top:

- a) Tank top should be flat & covered with serrated flooring (steel serrated flooring slip proof plate-form of 100 MM pitch of fasted cross bars of size 8 mm and 40 mm pitch of load bearing bars of size 25 mm x 5 mm serrated flooring should be made mild steel IS: 226-62). Bidder should forward schematic drawing of serrated flooring with support angle bar at the top of tanks along-with quotation on a rugged frame suitably welded on tank structure. There should be 2 (two) nos manhole covered with serrated flooring duly welded on a rugged frame with hinge at one side for opening.
- b) Each tank should be provided with 2(two) nos strongly built, properly welded sturdy ladder with handrails from inside the tank & 1no ladder with handrails on the front of the tank for climbing.
- c) Each tank must have folding type railing to be provided all along the outer periphery of each tank. The railing should be made out of min 40mm MS SHS of min 4.0mm of height 1000mm from the top of the tank with two-rail railings & 150mm high toe board.

Bidder must provide separate detail drawing for the above accessories along with the offer.

iv) Tank Bottom:

- a) Tank bottom should be constructed with 8.0mm thick plain MS plate.
- b) Approx. 75mm (3") slope is to be maintained towards the drain out point.
- c) There should be 2 Nos 150mm (6") drain out point at side wall of each tank for cleaning job.

- v) Tank Connections:
 - a) 2 Nos 150mm (6") NB screwed NPT #150 RF flange of ANSI B16.5 standard should be welded on the front and rear side of the tank & 2 Nos 150mm (6") NB screwed NPT #150 RF flange of ANSI B16.5 standard should be welded on the side wall of each tank for drain out point . 1 No 76.2 mm (3") NB screwed NPT #150 RF flange of ANSI B16.5 standard should be welded on the side wall of each tank for drain out point
 - b. All the outlet flanges should be fitted with suitable screwed NPT fittings & Butterfly type valves [Make: Audco / Intervalve]. The Butterfly valves should be firmly supported to withstand transportation and handling abuses.

1.2 Master Skid & Base Frame of the Tank:

i) Master Skid: 3(three) runner oilfield type skid fabricated out of ISMB250 reinforced with min 5nos cross member. The width of the Master skid should be 2700 mm.

Approx 600 mm long x 2700mm wide working platform with 10mm chequered plate welded on it should be provided in the front portion of the tank.

The ends of the skid should be projected out by 300mm and curved upwards. 150mm (6") NB X 11mm thick pipe with provision for lifting should reinforce the end of skid for tail boarding.

- ii) Base Frame of the Tank: Base Frame of Length-8000mm & Width-2700mm should be fabricated out of ISMC 125 X 65 reinforced with 6 Nos. cross members.
- **1.3 Material Specification**: Material for fabrication of tanks should be as follows:
 - i. Beam, Channel, Angle, Plate etc.: as per IS-2062
 - ii. SHS: as per IS 4923 YST 310
 - iii. Chequered Plate: as per IS 3502-2009
 - iv. Tail Boarding Pipe: ASTM-A106 Gr.B- Sch80
- **1.4 Welding Procedure**: All welding procedure should be followed as per standard norms & done by certified welder. All welding electrodes should be as per IS: 814. There should be minimum 3(three) layers of welding & all welds should be visually inspected / examined. The critical welds should be subjected to radiography test/magnetic particle test/dye penetration test. If tests are carried out necessary test certificate must be shown at the time of inspection & provided along with dispatch documents.

- **1.5 Surface Preparation**: After completion of all fabrication jobs, the surface preparation should be carried as follows:
 - i. All welds should be made free of slag, slag inclusion, pinholes, spatter etc. Scrapping & Wire brushing should be carried out on all steelworks after removing all oil & grease deposit if any using approved degreasing agent & solvent.
 - ii. Preferably Sand blast cleaning should be carried out in a controlled blasting shop & not during inclement weather conditions. Bidder must confirm if any other suitable surface cleaning method is applied other than mentioned above.
 - iii. All sand blast cleaned surfaces should be coated with the prescribed primer within 4(four) hours of blasting.
- **1.6 Mud Agitator:** Each mud tank shall be equipped with 2 (two) Nos mud agitators (one in each chamber) so positioned to have proper churning of mud, each complete with flameproof electric motor(s) of suitable capacity which shall operate on 415 Volts, 3-phase, 50 Hz AC power supply. The mud agitators should be of aerofoil design impeller and heli-bevel type gearbox. The turn-over rate of the agitator should be around 50 seconds. Make and model of the Mud Agitator is GAURAV ASSOCIATES and GAMA-MAI respectively

1.7 Electrical Motor:

The electric motor (to be mounted on the vessel) shall be of suitable capacity, 3 phase squirrel cage flameproof (Ex-d) induction motor suitable for hazardous areas of oilfields, Zone-I and gas group IIA & II B, and conforming to IS/IEC/EN 60079.

- i) Type: AC Induction type, 3 phase.
- ii) Power Rating: To be decided by supplier as per design requirements.
- iii) RPM: To be decided by supplier as per design requirements.
- iv) Totally enclosed type, flameproof (Ex-d) and weatherproof (suitable for gas groups IIA & IIB and Zone-I of hazardous area (Oil Mines) as per IS/IEC/EN 60079), with provisions of cable entry through flameproof (Ex-d) double compression cable glands. (Ref: Central Electricity Authority (Measures relating to Safety and Electric Supply) Regulations, 2010, Regulation no. 110).
- v) Cooling: Fan Cooled or liquid cooled.
- vi) Voltage: 415volts
- vii) Frequency: 50Hz
- viii) Insulation: Class F
- ix) Ingress Protection: IP 55 (Minimum)
- x) Duty: S1 continuous duty
- xi) Temperature class: T4
- xii) Paint: Epoxy anticorrosive painted surface.

1.8 Starter Panel:

Type: The type of starter is to be decided by supplier, depending upon current requirements of the motor.

- i) Rating: To be decided by supplier.
- ii) Enclosure: It shall be totally enclosed type, flameproof (Ex-d) and weather proof (suitable for gas groups IIA & IIB and Zone-I of hazardous area (Oil Mines) as per IS/IEC/EN 60079), with provisions of cable entry through flameproof (Ex-d) double compression cable glands. (Ref: Central Electricity Authority (Measures relating to Safety and Electric Supply) Regulations, 2010, Regulation no. 110).
- iii) Components: The starter must (but not be limited to) include:
 - 1. Stop Push Button Red Mushroom Head with padlocking arrangement with "1 NC" contact: 1 no.
 - 2. Start Push Button Green shrouded with "1 NO" contact: 1 no.
 - 3. Protection Features:
 - a. Suitable overload protection.
 - b. Suitable earth leakage protection with sensitivity of 30/100mA.
 - 4. Indications:
 - a. One red indication light to indicate the availability of power to starter.
 - b. One green indication light to indicate that the motor is running.
 - c. One yellow/amber indication light to indicate motor tripped.
- iv) Remote control station (if used):

Remote Push Button Station (PBS), if used in conjunction with the starter, shall be with the following provisions:

- a. Circuit voltage shall not exceed 30V. (Ref: Central Electricity Authority (Measures relating to Safety and Electric Supply) Regulations, 2010, Regulation no. 102).
- b. Connection between the starter and the PBS shall be through a suitable intrinsically safe barrier. (Ref: Central Electricity Authority (Measures relating to Safety and Electric Supply) Regulations, 2010, Regulation no. 110).
- v) Earthing: The starter body shall be provided with two distinct earthing points one on the outside, and one on the inside.
- vi) Name plate: Raised lettering cast internally on the cover.
- vii) Ingress Protection: IP55 (Minimum).

1.9 Statutory Requirements

- i. Motor, its enclosure along with its terminal box, starter, double compression cable glands and PBS (if used) shall be of flameproof (Exd) type, suitable for use in oilfield hazardous area, Zone-I of Oil Mines, and gas group IIA & II B of oil mines and shall conform to IS/IEC/EN:60079-0 and IS/IEC/EN:60079-1. (As per Central Electricity Authority (Measures relating to Safety and Electric Supply) Regulations, 2010, Regulation no. 110).
- ii. Test reports conforming to the above from an Indian Government Laboratory or NABL accredited laboratory or IEC-Ex accredited laboratory or ATEX notified body, which is not a part of manufacturer's facility, shall be submitted with the bid as well as with the supply of materials.
- iii. In case the bidder is unable to provide the test reports/ certificates at the time of bid submission, the bidder must categorically confirm in their offer that "Test reports/ certificates will be submitted along with the supply of materials."
- iv. The electrical system should be compliant with OMR-2017, OISD Regulations and Central Electricity Authority (Measures relating to Safety and Electric Supply) Regulations, 2010 or their revisions thereafter.

1.10 Notes for Electrical Items

- i) The motor, starter panel and PBS (if used) shall be provided with two distinct body earthing points.
- ii) Certified flameproof (Ex-d) double compression cable gland should be fitted with the motor, starter, PBS (if used) and junction box (if used).
- iii) The supplier must note that the electrical system available at the well-site is 3-phase 3-wire, without neutral. The motor starting and running system shall thus be designed for 3-phase 3-wire system, without neutral.

1.11 Earthing:

- i. 2(two) coats of inorganic zinc primer of 100-125 micron DFT should be applied all over the tank, skid, ladder etc.
- ii. 2(two) coats of High Build Epoxy paint of 180-200 micron DFT of Grey colour should be applied on the inner wall only & 2(two) coats of Synthetic Enamel paint of 100-125 micron DFT of Grey colour should be applied on the outer tank wall surface, ladder, connections etc.
- iii. 2(two) coats of Synthetic Enamel paint of 90-100 micron DFT of Black colour should be applied on the Skid of the tank.

Note: HB Epoxy & Synthetic Enamel paint should be of make Berger, ICI, Jenson & Nicholson and Shalimar only. Bidder must provide the brochure of paint [both High Build Epoxy & Synthetic Enamel] offered for painting.

Each tank should be offered for inspection to OIL as per following schedule. Prior intimation should be given well in advance for carrying out the inspection.

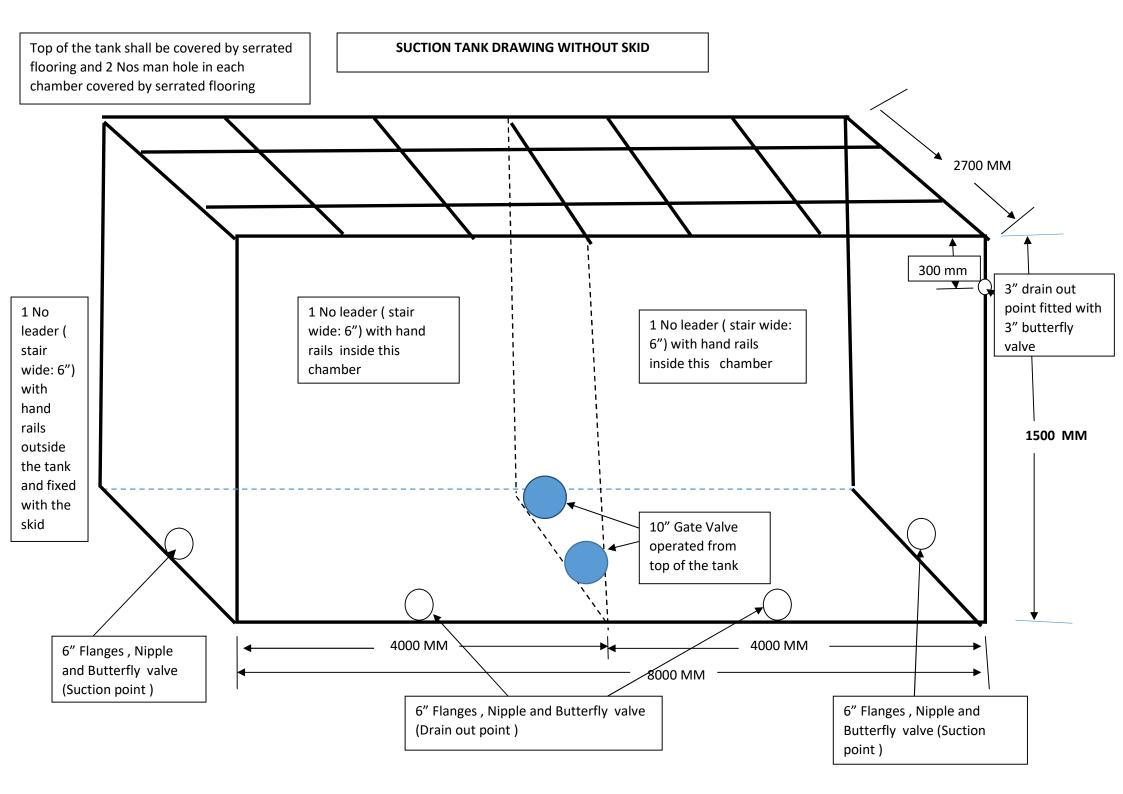
