Buyer Added Bid Specific Terms and Conditions

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

2. Generic

Bidder financial standing: The bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings, should not be bankrupt. Bidder to upload undertaking to this effect with bid.

3. Generic

Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.

4. Certificates

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

5. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

1.0 The bidder must have to deploy their Engineer / Technical staff, free of cost, at Logistics Department, Duliajan after receiving of spares to evaluate the suitability of supplied spares. The spare parts will be rejected if not conformed as per our requirement at the time of joint physical inspection.

Transportation / lodging / fooding of the supplier's representative / engineer is to be in supplier's scope.

- **2.0** Bidder shall categorically confirm that they will submit 100% interchangeability certificate along with the supplies in the event of award of Purchase Order on them.
- **3.0** The items shall be procured from the same source due to compatibility reasons. Bidder must quote for all the items in the scope of the tender. In case any item is not quoted, then the bid shall be rejected straight-away.
- **4.0** Bidder should have proven capabilities of service support to back up for any requirement of "after sales service" against the supply of tendered scope of materials. Bidder must submit minimum 03 (three) work orders from Govt., Semi-Govt. and Reputed Public Limited Organizations to prove his service capabilities. Contact No., email ID and address of the client (as mentioned above) to be submitted; failing which the bid shall be liable for rejection.

- **5.0** The bidder must be in the business of supply of spares for TIL Make Crane of model TMS 750B in any Govt, Semi Govt. or Public Sector Undertakings (PSU's) in the last seven (07) years. Self-certification (duly sealed and signed by the bidder) regarding the same to be provided along with the bid; failing which the bid shall be liable for rejection.
- **6.0** Bidder's quoted price shall be on F.O.R. Duliajan Basis that shall be inclusive of all taxes and duties, freight, transit insurance charges and any other charges as envisaged by the bidder.
- **7.0** Bidder shall confirm warranty period of supplied spare parts for 18 (eighteen) months from the date of supply.
- **8.0** Packaging of the material shall be adequate enough to avoid any transit damages.
- **9.0** Bidders are requested to fill up and duly seal and sign the Undertaking (Format as per enclosed Annexure-K) regarding authenticity of documents submitted by them.
- **10.0** Bidders are required to take a note of all the terms and conditions and attachments associated with this tender document while bidding.

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6. Generic

Bidder shall submit the following documents along with their bid for Vendor Code Creation:

8. Generic

9. Scope of Supply

Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components) : Only supply of Goods

10. Generic

The buyer organization is an institution eligible for concessional rates of GST as notified by the Government of India. The goods for which bids have been invited fall under classification of GST concession and the conditions for eligibility of concession are met by the institution. A certificate to this effect will be issued by Buyer to the Seller after award of the Contract. Sellers are requested to submit their bids after accounting for the Concessional rate of GST.

11. Generic

Supplier shall ensure that the Invoice is raised in the name of Consignee with GSTIN of Consignee only.

12. Certificates

The bidder is required to upload, along with the bid, all relevant certificates such as BIS licence, type test certificate, approval certificates and other certificates as prescribed in the Product Specification given in the bid document.

13. Generic

- 1. The Seller shall not assign the Contract in whole or part without obtaining the prior written consent of buver.
- 2. The Seller shall not sub-contract the Contract in whole or part to any entity without obtaining the prior written consent of buyer.
- 3. The Seller shall, notwithstanding the consent and assignment/sub-contract, remain jointly and severally liable and responsible to buyer together with the assignee/ sub-contractor, for and in respect of the due performance of the Contract and the Sellers obligations there under.

14. Generic

While generating invoice in GeM portal, the seller must upload scanned copy of GST invoice and the screenshot of GST portal confirming payment of GST.

15. Generic

Whereever Essentiality Certificate is applicable (PEL/ML), successful bidder should provide Proforma Invoice for processeing for EC application and material should be dispatche after receiving of EC rom DGH. In view of the same, an ATC may be incorporated in GeM, viz, "BIDDER/OEM must provide Proforma Invoice for processeing for EC application within AT LEAST 30 DAYS PRIOR TO THE SCHEDULED DESPATCH OF MATERIALS days from date of issue of GeM Contract and material should be dispatche after receiving of EC rom DGH."

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization. Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity/restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and/or terms and conditions governing the bid. Any clause incorporated by the Buyer such as demanding Tender Sample, incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to make in India Policy, mandating any Brand names or Foreign Certification, changing the default time period for Acceptance of material or payment timeline governed by OM of Department of Expenditure shall be null and void and would not be considered part of bid. Further any reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses shall also be null and void. If any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. In terms of GeM GTC clause 26 regarding Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India, any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority. While participating in bid, Bidder has to undertake compliance of this and any false declaration and non-compliance of this would be a ground for immediate termination of the contract and further legal action in accordance with the laws.
