1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

BB. 1.0 BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC)/ BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC):

The bids must conform to the specifications and terms & conditions given in the tender. Bids shall be rejected in

case the item(s) offered do not conform to the required minimum/maximum parameters stipulated in the technical specifications and to the respective international / national standards wherever stipulated. Notwithstanding the general conformity of the bids to the stipulated specifications and terms & conditions, the following requirements shall have to be particularly met by the bidders, without which the offer will be considered as non-responsive and rejected.

A) TECHNICAL :

1.0 Bidder's Qualification:

1.1 The bidder shall be an original equipment manufacturer (OEM) or an authorized distributor/dealer of the OEM for Foam Trolley (Mobile Foam Unit) / Skid Mounted Foam Tank / Foam Tank / Foam Fire Tender / Multi-Purpose Fire Tender.

In this regard, the bidder should submit the following documents along with their bid:

a) In case the bidder is an OEM, a copy of certificate specifying the nature of business of the firm should be furnished.

b) In case the bidder is an authorized distributor / dealer of the OEM, valid authorization certificate from the OEM should be submitted.

2.0 Bidders Experience:

2.1) In case, the bidder is an Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM), the following criteria should be met by the bidder:

The bidder should have the experience of successfully executing at least 01 (one) "similar order" for supply of minimum 50% of the ordered quantity i.e. **13 (Thirteen) Nos.** to any Central / State Govt. Organization / PSU / Public Limited company in last 05 (five) years preceding from the original bid closing date of the tender.

2.2) In case the Bidder is an authorized distributor / dealer of OEM, the following criteria shall be met by the Bidder:

The bidder should have the experience of successfully executing at least 01 (one) "similar order" for supply of minimum 50% of the ordered quantity i.e. **13 (Thirteen) Nos.** to any Central / State Govt. Organization / PSU / Public Limited company in last 05 (five) years preceding from the original bid closing date of the tender.

"Similar Order" means Purchase Order/Contract containing supply of Foam Trolley (Mobile Foam Unit) / Skid Mounted Foam Tank / Foam Tank / Foam Fire Tender / Multi-Purpose Fire Tender.

Notes:

a) Documentary evidence in respect of supply experience as specified under Clause Nos. 2.1 & 2.2 should be submitted in the form of copies of relevant Purchase Orders along with copies of any of the following documents in respect of satisfactory execution of each of those Purchase Orders, such as –

i. Satisfactory Supply Completion / Installation /Commissioning certificate

(OR)

ii. Consignee Receipted Delivery Challans.

(OR)

iii. Central Excise Gate Pass / Tax Invoices issued under relevant rules of Central Excise/GST

(OR)

iv. Any other documentary evidence that can substantiate the satisfactory execution of the purchase order.

b) The Purchase Order date need not be within 05 (five) years preceding the original bid closing date of this tender. However, the execution of supply should be within 05 (five) years preceding the original bid closing date of this tender.

c) Satisfactory supply completion/inspection/installation report (if submitted) should be issued on client's official letterhead with signature and stamp.

d) A job executed by a bidder for its own organisation / subsidiary cannot be considered as experience for the purpose of meeting BRC.

3.0 Approvals:

Bidders must submit a valid copy of FM approval for offered foam nozzle along with their bids for evaluation.

B) FINANCIAL:

The bidder must have annual Financial Turnover from Operations of at least **Rs. 30.47** Lakhs in any of the

preceding Three (3) financial/ accounting years reckoned from the original bid closing date of this tender as per the Audited Annual Reports.

[Annual Financial Turnover of the bidder from operations shall mean - "Aggregate value of the realization of amount made from the sale, supply or distribution of goods or on account of services rendered, or both, by the company (bidder) during a financial year" as per the Companies Act, 2013 Section 2 (91).]

b) The Net Worth of the bidder must be positive for the accounting year preceding the original bid closing date.

[Net worth shall mean: "Share capital + Reserves created out of profits and securities Premium - Aggregate value of accumulated losses (excluding revaluation reserves) - deferred expenditure - Miscellaneous Expenditure to the extent not written off and carried forward Loss - Reserves created out of write back of depreciation and amalgamation".]

Notes:

a) For proof of Annual Turnover & Net worth any one of the following documents must be submitted along with the bid: -

i) A certificate issued by a practicing Chartered Cost Accountant (with Membership Number and Firm Registration Number), certifying the Annual turnover & Net worth as per format prescribed in ANNEXURE-J.

ii) Audited Balance Sheet along with Profit & Loss account.

b) In case the bidder is a Central Govt. Organization/PSU/State Govt. Organization/Semi-State Govt. Organization or any other Central/State Govt. Undertaking, where the auditor is appointed only after the approval of Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the Central Government, their certificates may be accepted even though FRN is not available.
