Buyer Added Bid Specific Terms and Conditions

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

2. Generic

Bidder financial standing: The bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings, should not be bankrupt. Bidder to upload undertaking to this effect with bid.

3. Scope of Supply

Scope of supply (Bid price to include all cost components): Only supply of Goods

4. Certificates

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

5. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

1.0 BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC):

The bid shall conform generally to the specifications, terms and conditions given in this document. Notwithstanding the general conformity of the bids to the stipulated specifications, the following requirements will have to be particularly met by the Bidders without which the same will be considered as non-responsive and rejected.

A) TECHNICAL:

1.0 Bidder's Qualification:

The bidder should be a reputed fabricator and should have the credentials of supplying similar type of tank in the past. Necessary evidence in the form of order copies / proof of supplies / acceptance / performance certificates should be submitted along with the offer.

A) TECHNICAL:

a) The bidder should be a reputed fabricator and should have the credentials of supplying similar type of tank in the past. Necessary evidence in the form of order copies / proof of supplies / acceptance / performance certificates should be submitted along with the offer.

Note: Term " similar type of tank " means Steel Fabricated Mud tank, Water tank, Preflux Tank etc.)

- b) Bidder should have successfully executed a single order of quantity not less than **01(One) No**. for manufacture and supply of tank in the past **05 years**, preceding the technical bid closing date. Necessary proof in support of the same should be submitted along with the offer failing which the offer will be rejected.
- c) Bidder must forward along with the quotation the detailed drawing of the tank, Bill of material failing which the offer will be liable for rejection.
- d) The bidder should be a Government registered vendor. Necessary proof in support of the same should be furnished.
- e) The bidder, if registered as an SSI, should submit the certificate copy of registration with the concerned authorities.
- f) Bidder should have the required machinery, manpower and resources for undertaking the fabrication of tank, viz welding, painting, pressing of sheets (corrugation) etc. A list of all the facilities (including list of machineries) available is to be submitted along with the offer.

<u>Note</u>: Documentary evidence in respect of the above should be submitted in the form of copies of relevant Purchase Order / Contract along with copies of any of the following documents in respect of satisfactory execution of each of those Purchase Orders, such as -

- (i) Satisfactory Inspection Report (OR)
- (ii) Satisfactory Supply Completion / Installation Report (OR)
- (iii) Consignee Receipted Delivery Challans (OR)
- (iv) Central Excise Gate Pass / Tax Invoices issued under relevant rules of Central Excise/VAT/GST (OR)
- (v) Any other documentary evidence that can substantiate the satisfactory execution of each of the purchase orders cited above.

Note:

- a) The Purchase Order date need not be within 5 (five) years preceding original bid closing date of this tender. However, the execution of supply should be within 5 (five) years preceding original bid closing date of this tender.
- b) Satisfactory supply/completion/installation report (if submitted) should be issued on client's official letterhead with signature and stamp.

B) FINANCIAL:

- 1.0 The bidder must have annual Financial Turnover from Operations equal to or more than Rs 10.33 Lakh in any of the preceding 3 (three) financial / accounting years reckoned from the original bid closing date as per the Audited Annual Reports.
- 2.0 "Net Worth" of the bidder should be positive for the financial/ accounting year just preceding to the original bid closing date of the tender, i.e. 2021-2022.
- 3.0 Considering the time required for preparation of Financial Statements, if the last date of preceding financial / accounting year falls within the preceding six months reckoned from the original bid closing date and the Financial Statements of the preceding financial / accounting year are not available with the bidder, then the financial turnover of the previous three financial / accounting years excluding the preceding financial / accounting year will be considered. In such cases, the Net worth of the previous financial / accounting year excluding the preceding financial / accounting year will be considered. However, the bidder has to submit an affidavit/undertaking (refer **PROFORMA-1**) certifying that 'the balance sheet/Financial Statements for the financial year (As the case may be) has actually not been audited so far'.

- a) For proof of Annual Turnover & Net worth any one of the following documents must be submitted along with the bid: -
- i) A certificate issued by a practicing Chartered/Cost Accountant (with Membership Number and Firm Registration Number), certifying the Annual turnover & Net worth as per format prescribed in **PROFORMA 2**.

- ii) Audited Balance Sheet along with Profit & Loss account. b) In case the bidder is a Central Govt. Organization/PSU/State Govt. Organization/Semi-State Govt. Organization or any other Central/State Govt. Undertaking, where the auditor is appointed only after the approval of Comptroller and Auditor General of India and the Central Government, their certificates may be accepted even though FRN is not available. However, bidder to provide documentary evidence for the same.
- 4.0 In case the Bidder is subsidiary company (should be 100% owned subsidiary of the parent/ultimate parent/holding company) who does not meet financial criteria by itself and submits its bid based on the strength of parent/ ultimate parent/ holding company, then following documents need to be submitted: i) Turnover of the parent/ ultimate parent/ holding company should be inline with requirement. ii) Net Worth of the parent/ultimate parent/ holding company should be positive in line with the requirement. iii) Corporate Guarantee (as per **PROFORMA-3**) on parent / ultimate parent / holding company's company letter head signed by an authorised official undertaking that they would financially support their wholly owned subsidiary company for executing the project/ job in case the same is awarded to them. iv) Document of subsidiary company being 100% owned subsidiary of the parent/ultimate parent/holding company.

- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the

case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
