1. The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. Documentary evidence in the form of certified Audited Balance Sheets of relevant periods or a certificate from the Chartered Accountant / Cost Accountant indicating the turnover details for the relevant period shall be uploaded with the bid. In case the date of constitution / incorporation of the bidder is less than 3-year-old, the average turnover in respect of the completed financial years after the date of constitution shall be taken into account for this criteria.

2. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. 3. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore): Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 100%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY.

- 2.Bidder/ Supplier/ Organization/ Proprietor/ ANY of the Director(s) shall not be banned or suspended or black listed by any Government / Public Sector Undertaking / Corporate organization or convicted in any Court of Law across India or declared Bankrupt or insolvent. A self declaration certificate must be uploaded in the GeM portal under Bidders Official Letter Head.
- 3.Buyer/consignee shall have the right to inspect the supplied goods themselves AND/OR through their appointed agency at consignees own cost, at consignees site(s) after receipt and accept OR reject on proper justification any consignment of goods within a period of 30 days of receipt of consignment of goods. 100% payment will be released within ten (10) days of issue of consignee receipt-cum-acceptance certificate (CRAC) and on on-line submission of bills
- 4.Bidder should be the Original Equipment Manufacturer. Letter of incorporation shall be submitted.

17. **OPTION CLAUSE:** The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.
18. Replacement under warranty clause shall be made by the Seller free of all charges at site including freight, insurance and other incidental charges. 21. Supplier shall ensure that the Invoice is raised in the name of Consignee with GSTIN of Consignee only.
22. The Bidder shall be responsible for any defects that may develop under the conditions provided by the contract and under proper USE, arising FROM faulty materials, design OR workmanship such AS corrosion, inadequate quantity of material TO meet equipment requirements, inadequate contact protection, deficiencies in design AND/ OR otherwise and shall remedy such defects at his own cost when called upon to do so by the Purchaser who shall state in writing in what respect the stores are faulty.
23. The buyer organization is an institution eligible for concessional rates of GST as notified by the Government of India.
