During the warranty period, the Seller shall remain responsible to arrange replacement in next Business day (NBD) and for setting right at his own cost any equipment installed by him which is of defective manufacture or design or becomes unworkable due to any cause whatsoever. The decision of the Buyers representative in this regard to direct the contractor to attend to any damage or defect in work shall be final and binding on the Seller.
- 23. The Bidder shall be responsible for any defects that may develop under the conditions provided by the contract and under proper USE, arising FROM faulty materials, design OR workmanship such AS corrosion, inadequate quantity of material TO meet equipment requirements, inadequate contact protection, deficiencies in design AND/ OR otherwise and shall remedy such defects at his own cost when called upon to do so by the Purchaser who shall state in writing in what respect the stores are faulty.
- 24. Warranty period of the supplied products shall be 1 years from the date of final acceptance of goods or after completion of installation, commissioning & testing of goods (if included in the scope of supply), at consignee location. OEM Warranty certificates must be submitted by Successful Bidder at the time of delivery of Goods. The seller should guarantee the rectification of goods in case of any break down during the guarantee period.
