#### (A) General Notes for e-tender:

- 1. The tender will be governed by "General Terms & Conditions" for e-Procurement as per Booklet No.MM/GLOBAL/E-01/2005 for Eprocurement(ICB Tenders) including Amendment and Addendum.
- 2. The general details of tender can be viewed by opening the RFx [Tender] under RFx and Auctions. The details of items tendered can be found in the Item Data and details uploaded under Technical RFX.
- 3. Bid must be submitted electronically only through OIL's e-procurement portal. Bid submitted in any other form will be rejected.
- 4. Please note that all tender forms and supporting documents are to be submitted through OIL's e-Procurement site only except following documents which are to be submitted manually in sealed envelope super scribed with tender no. and due date to The Head Materials, Materials Department, Oil India Limited, Duliajan- 786602, Assam or before 13:00 hrs (IST) on the Bid Closing Date mentioned in the Tender.
  - a) Original Bid Security along with two duplicate copies of Bid Security.
  - b) Any other document which have been specified to be submitted in original.
- 5. Bidders must ensure that their bid is uploaded in the system before the tender closing date and time. Also, they must ensure that above documents which are to be submitted in a sealed envelope are also submitted at the above mentioned address before the bid closing date and time failing which the offer shall be rejected.
- 6. Bidders are requested to examine all instructions, forms, terms and specifications in the bid. Failure to furnish all information required as per the bid or submission of offers not substantially responsive to the bid in every respect will be at the bidders risk and may result in the rejection of its offer without seeking any clarifications.
- 7. All the Bids must be Digitally Signed using "Class 3" digital certificate (e-commerce application) with organisation nameas per Indian IT Act obtained

- from the licensed Certifying Authorities operating under the Root Certifying Authority of India (RCAI), Controller of Certifying Authorities (CCA) of India.
- 8. Please do refer the User Manual provided on the portal on the procedure How to create Response for submitting offer.

#### (B) General Notes for Bidder's:

- 1. The items shall be brand new, unused & of prime quality. Bidder shall warrant (in the event of an order) that the product supplied will be free from all defects & fault in material, workmanship & manufacture and shall be in full conformity with ordered specifications. This clause shall be valid for 18 months from date of Despatch/shipment or 12 months from date of receipt of the items whichever is earlier. The defective materials, if any, rejected by us shall be replaced by the supplier at their own expense. Bidders must confirm the same while quoting.
- 2. The minimum FOB/FCA charges in case of partial order for reduced quantity/ items shall have to be indicated by the bidder. In case this is not indicated specifically, the charges quoted would be prorata calculated and the same will be binding on the bidder.
- 3. Bidders other than OEM (Original Equipment Manufacturer) must submit proper valid authorisation certificate alongwith the warranty back-up from OEM failing which offer shall be rejected.
- 4. In the event of an order, One set of operation and maintenance manual shall be supplied along with the material.
- 5. Quotation must be submitted in triplicate.
- 6. **Delivery Clause:** "Bidder should categorically confirm in the technical bid a delivery schedule within 18 Weeks, FOB Port of dispatch, after establishment of letter of credit (in case of foreign bidder) or for dispatch of the equipment within 18 Weeks after receipt of formal order (in case of indigenous bidder) failing which their offer will be rejected."
- 7. The items covered by this tender shall be used by Oil India Limited in the PEL/ML areas which are issued/renewed after 01/04/99 and hence Nil Customs Duty during import will be applicable. However, OIL will not issue Recommendatory Letters to Indian bidders. Deemed Export Benefit for domestic bidders is not applicable against this tender. Domestic Bidders to quote their prices without considering the Deemed Export Benefit. Domestic bidders to also quote the applicable rate of Excise Duty in their price bid. If a domestic bidder emerges L1 after loading of applicable rate of Excise Duty, order shall be placed upon the bidder inclusive of the Excise Duty amount.

#### (C) SPECIAL NOTES:

- 1. The items shall be brand new, unused & of prime quality. Bidder shall warrant (in the event of an order) that the product supplied will be free from all defects & fault in material, workmanship & manufacture and shall be in full conformity with ordered specifications. This clause shall be valid for 18 months from date of despatch/shipment or 12 months from date of receiptof the item at site which ever is earlier. In case of breakdown during the warranty period, a competent service engineer of the supplier shall make as many visits as shall be necessary to rectify the system. The supplier shall provide all spares required for making the system operational. Bidders must confirm the same while quoting.
- 2. Validity of the offers should be 90 days from the date of bid opening. Bids with lesser validity shall be summarily rejected.
- 3. The items covered by this tender will attract Custom Duty on merit. Indian bidders are required to quote NON DEEMED EXPORT price.
- 4. Technical & Commercial Check-List vide **Annexure- B** shall be filled-up and submitted along with the offer.
- 5. To ascertain the substantial responsiveness of the bid OIL reserves the right to ask thebidder for clarification in respect of clauses covered under BRC also and such clarificationsfulfilling the BRC clauses in to must be received on or before the deadline given by the company, failing which the offer will be summarily rejected.
- 6. Bidders to note that Govt. of India under Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Development (MSMED) Act 2006, has proclaimed the Public Procurement Policy, 2012 with effect from 1st April, 2012 in respect of procurement of goods and services, produced and provided by micro and small enterprises, by its Ministries, Departments and Public Sector Undertakings for promotion and development of Micro and Small Enterprises. A new Clause on applicability of Public Procurement Policy for procurement of goods from Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises(MSME) in the tender is furnished vide Amendment to General Terms and Conditions for Global Tender (MM/GLOBAL/E-01/2005). Bidders are requested to take note of the same and to submit their offers accordingly.

### BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC)/BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC)

#### I. BID REJECTION CRITERIA -TECHNICAL

The bids shall broadly conform to the specifications and terms and conditions given in this bid document. Bids shall be rejected in case the items offered do not conform to required parameters stipulated in the technical specifications and to the respective international/national standards wherever stipulated. Notwithstanding the general conformity of the bids to the stipulated specifications and terms and conditions, the following requirements will have to be particularly met by the Bidders without which the same will be considered as non-responsive and rejected.

#### A) TECHNICAL:

- 1.0 BRC /BEC (Technical) Qualification
- 1.1 The bidder shall be an Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) of the tendered item(s)

OR

1.2 An authorized agent / dealer / distributor / supply house of an OEM of the tendered item(s) having valid authorization letter / dealership certificate with warranty/ guarantee back up from the principal (OEM). Copy of authorization letter / dealership certificate with warranty/ guarantee back up from the principal (OEM) shall be submitted along with the technical bid.

#### 2.0 BRC/BEC (Technical) - Experience

2.1 The bidder shall have experience of successful execution of past supply for minimum 50% quantity (to be rounded off to next higher integer) of each tender item of same or higher specification as specified in the tender in last 5 years preceding the original bid closing date of the tender, to any Oil & Gas Industry or service provider to an E&P company.

- 2.2 The bidder shall submit documents in support of his previous supply experience as applicable under clause 2.1 as follows:
- (i) Copy(ies) of Purchase Order(s)/Contract document(s), And
- (ii) Any one or combination of the following documents that confirms the successful execution of each of the purchase order(s) / contract(s) -
- Completion report / performance certificate from the clients,

- any other documentary evidence that can substantiate the successful execution of each of the Purchase Order(s) / contract(s) cited above.
- 3. The bidder should categorically confirm in the technical bid that the tendered items will be supplied within the delivery period, if mentioned in the tender, without which the bid will be rejected.

#### 4.0 Financial Criteria:

- 4.1 **Annual Turnover**: The bidder shall have an annual financial turnover of minimum **US\$ 14,688.00 or Rs 9,98,750.00** during any of the preceding 03 (three) financial years reckoned from the original bid closing date of the tender.
- 4.2 "Net Worth" of the bidder should be positive for the preceding financial/accounting year.
- 4.3 Documentary evidence in the form of Audited Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss Account for the preceding 03 (three) financial/accounting years should be submitted along with the Technical Bid.
- 4.4 In case the Audited Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss Account submitted along with the bid are in currencies other than INR or US\$, the bidder shall have to convert the figures in equivalent INR or US\$ considering the prevailing conversion rate on the date on which the Audited Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss Account is signed. A CA certificate is to be submitted by the bidder regarding converted figures in equivalent INR or US\$.

#### B. COMMERCIAL:

- 1. Bids are invited under **Single Stage Composite Bid System**. Bidders shall quote accordingly under Single Stage Composite Bid System.
- 2.0 **Bid security of US \$ 588.00 or Rs. 39,950.00** shall be furnished as a part of the TECHNICAL BID (refer Clause Nos.9.0 & 12.0 (Section A) of "General Terms & Conditions" for e-Procurement as per Booklet No. MM/GLOBAL/E-

01/2005 for E-procurement (ICB Tenders)). A bid shall be rejected straightway if Original Bid Security is not received within the stipulated date & time mentioned in the Tender and/or if the Bid Security validity is shorter than the validity indicated in Tender and/or if the Bid Security amount is lesser than the amount indicated in the Tender.

- 5. Successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bank Guarantee @10% of the order value. The Performance Bank Guarantee must be valid for a period of 18 months from the date of shipment/dispatch or twelve(12) months from the date of receipt of the items at site, whichever is earlier. Bidder must confirm the same in their Technical Bid. Offers not complying with this clause will be rejected.
