**(A) SPECIAL NOTES :**

- 1.0** The items shall be brand new, unused & of prime quality. Bidder shall warrant (in the event of an order) that the product supplied will be free from all defects & fault in material, workmanship & manufacture and shall be in full conformity with ordered specifications. This clause shall be valid for 18 months from date of despatch/shipment or 12 months from date of receipt of the items at site whichever is earlier. The defective materials, if any, rejected by us shall be replaced by the supplier at their own expenses in F.O.R. destination basis. Bidders must confirm the same while quoting.
- 2.0** Item 10 and 20, i.e. Drill Collar Severing Assembly should contain complete explosive and hardware for Drill Collar Severing, e.g.(i)Explosive pellet & Cartridge kit (ii) DCST Hardware kit (iii) MDF assy. for all DCST and (iv)Detonator for DCST. Bidder must quote for all the items, if required. If any other additional items are required for the DCST assembly, Bidder must also quote for the same.
- 3.0** Total indented qty. for Item 30 (Contact Sub/ Firing Head) is 22 Nos. which should be split as a)14 Nos. for 2" DCST and b) 08 Nos. for 1.3/4" DCST.
- 4.0** Offer must meet all the technical specification mentioned against each item in the tender or else bid will be rejected.
- 5.0** Bidder must ensure and confirm that the offered Explosives items (Sl. 10 & 20) will perform as per its API recommendation and the technical specifications provided by the manufacturer. MSDS (Material Safety Data Sheet) for all the Explosive items is required to be submitted with the offer by Bidder.
- 6.0** The date of manufacture of Explosives should not be earlier than 01(one) year either from the date of shipment by the supplier or the date of handing over the consignment to OIL's freight forwarder, whichever is applicable. The Bidder must ensure and confirm this in the bid.
- 7.0** All the items should be procured from the same source for compatibility in the operations.
- 8.0**
  - (a) If the product offered by the lowest technically acceptable bidder is not field proven in Oil India Limited, the Company at its discretion may place a trial order to the extent of maximum 25% on such bidder for field trial and the purchase order for balance quantity of the tender will be placed on the other competitive bidders whose products have been field proven in Oil India Limited.
  - (b) In case, more than one such technically acceptable bidders, whose products have not been field proven in Oil India Limited, offer a price lower than the bidder, whose product is field proven in Oil India Limited, the Company may place trial orders on all such bidders by distributing the 25% (maximum) amongst them subject to other bidders matching the price offered by the

lowest technically acceptable bidder. In the event of other bidders (other than the lowest bidder), whose products have not been field proven in Oil India Limited, decline to match the price as stated above, only the lowest bidder will be eligible for the trial order. In such cases also, the purchase order for balance quantity of the tender will be placed on the other competitive bidders whose products have been field proven in Oil India Limited.

- 9.0** Item 10 and 20 are explosives items which are under specialized items of Sr. No. 97(a) and falls under negative list of import. So, necessary DGCA landing Permit/ explosive import License from the competent authority is required to be obtained for Air freighting /importing to Kolkata / Delhi / Mumbai, India. Hence the Bidder must quote with IATA classification and UN Number of all the Explosive items suitable for Air Freighting.
- 10.0** All the items are required to be air freighted for operational reasons.
- 11.0** Tech. evaluation Check list- Annexure A and BEC/BRC Clause Matrix-Annexure-B, both in tabular form is provided in attachment.
- 12.0** The minimum FOB/FCA charges in case of partial order for reduced quantity/ items shall have to be indicated by the bidder. In case this is not indicated specifically, the charges quoted would be prorated calculated and the same will be binding on the bidder.
- 13.0** Validity of the offers should be 90 days from the date of bid opening. Bids with lesser validity shall be rejected.
- 14.0** The items covered by this tender shall be used by Oil India Limited in the PEL/ML areas which are issued/renewed after 01/04/99 and hence Nil Customs Duty during import will be applicable. Indigenous bidder shall be eligible for Deemed Export Benefit against this purchase. Details of Deemed Export are furnished vide Addendum to MM/GLOBAL/01/2005 enclosed.

5. Bidders must ensure that their bid is uploaded in the system before the tender closing date and time. Also, they must ensure that above documents which are to be submitted in a sealed envelope are also submitted at the above mentioned address before the bid closing date and time failing which the offer shall be rejected.
  6. Bidders are requested to examine all instructions, forms, terms and specifications in the bid. Failure to furnish all information required as per the bid or submission of offers not substantially responsive to the bid in every respect will be at the bidders risk and may result in the rejection of its offer without seeking any clarifications.
  7. All the Bids must be Digitally Signed using "Class 3" digital certificate (*e-commerce application*) with organisation names per Indian IT Act obtained from the licensed Certifying Authorities operating under the Root Certifying Authority of India (RCAI), Controller of Certifying Authorities (CCA) of India.

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**BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC)/BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC)**

**I. BID EVALUATION CRITERIA –TECHNICAL**

The bids shall broadly conform to the specifications and terms and conditions given in this bid document. Bids shall be rejected in case the items offered do not conform to required parameters stipulated in the technical specifications and to the respective international/national standards wherever stipulated. Notwithstanding the general conformity of the bids to the stipulated specifications and terms and conditions, the following requirements will have to be particularly met by the Bidders without which the same will be considered as non-responsive and rejected.

1. The Bid along with all technical documentation must be in English Language only
2. The bidder must submit full technical literature of the offered item(s) as per the Tender requirements.
3. The bidder's offer must meet all the technical specifications mentioned against each item of the tender document.

4. If the bidder is the **original manufacturer** of the offered item(s), then:

[a] The bidder must have minimum 05 (Five) years of experience in manufacturing similar items. The bidder must provide firm confirmation regarding this in its bid.

[b] **The bidder must have sold the quoted item(s) to at least 01 E&P company/Logging service provider in last 05 (Five) years. At least 01 (one) of such orders successfully executed by the bidder in last 05 (five) years must be for minimum 50% of the estimated value of this tender.**

[c] If the bidder has supplied similar items to OIL in the past, then the relevant Purchase Order No. must be mentioned in the bid.

[ii] The 05 (Five) years period will be reckoned from the date of Bid Closing for this tender.

9.0 **Financial Criteria:**

9.1 **Annual Turnover:**The bidder shall have an annual financial turnover of minimum **US\$ 28,258.20 or Rs19,32,861.08** during any of the preceding 03 (three) financial years reckoned from the original bid closing date of the tender.

9.2 “Net Worth” of the bidder should be positive for the preceding financial/accounting year.

- 9.3 Considering the time required for preparation of Financial Statements, if the last date of preceding financial / accounting year falls within the preceding six months reckoned from the original bid closing date and the Financial Statements of the preceding financial / accounting year are not available with the bidder, then the financial turnover of the previous three financial / accounting years excluding the preceding financial / accounting year will be considered. In such cases, the Net worth of the previous financial / accounting year excluding the preceding financial / accounting year will be considered. However, the bidder has to submit an affidavit/undertaking certifying that ‘the balance sheet/Financial Statements **for the financial year.....** (As the case may be) has actually not been audited so far’.

A CA certificate is to be submitted by the bidder regarding converted figures in equivalent INR or US\$.

- 1.0 Bids are invited under **Single Stage Composite Bid System**. Bidders shall quote accordingly under Single Stage Composite Bid System.
- 2.0 **Bid security of US \$ 1,130.00 or Rs. 77,315.00** shall be furnished as a part of the TECHNICAL BID (refer Clause Nos.9.0 & 12.0 (Section A) of “General Terms & Conditions” for e-Procurement as per Booklet No. MM/GLOBAL/E-01/2005 for E-procurement (ICB Tenders)).A bid shall be rejected straightway if Original Bid Security is not received within the stipulated date & time mentioned in the Tender and/or if the Bid Security validity is shorter than the validity indicated in Tender and/or if the Bid Security amount is lesser than the amount indicated in the Tender.

- 4.0 Bidders must confirm that Goods, materials or plant(s) to be supplied shall be new of recent make and of the best quality and workmanship and shall be guaranteed for a period of 18 months from the date of shipment/dispatch or twelve(12) months from the date of receipt of the items at site, whichever is earlier against any defects arising from faulty materials, workmanship or design. Defective goods/materials or parts rejected by OIL shall be replaced immediately by the supplier at the supplier's expenses at no extra cost to OIL.
- 5.0 Successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bank Guarantee @10% of the order value. The Performance Bank Guarantee must be valid for a period of 18 months from the date of shipment/dispatch or twelve(12) months from the date of receipt of the items at site, whichever is earlier.
