- 4.0 The tender is invited under SINGLE STAGE-TWO BID SYSTEM. The bidder has to submit both the "TECHNO-COMMERCIAL UNPRICED BID" and "PRICED BID" through electronic form in the OIL's e-Tender portal within the Bid Closing Date and Time stipulated in the e-Tender. The "TECHNO-COMMERCIAL UNPRICED BID is to be submitted as per Scope of Work & Technical Specification of the tender and "PRICED BID" as per the Online Priced Bid format.
- 5.0 In Technical Bid opening, only Technical Rfx will be opened. Therefore, the bidder should ensure that "TECHNO-COMMERCIAL UNPRICED BID should contain details as mentioned in the technical specifications as well as BEC/ BRC and upload the same in the Technical RFx Response-> User > Technical Bid. No price should be given in above Technical Rfx otherwise the offer will be rejected. Please go through the help document in details before uploading the document and ensure uploading of technical bid in the Technical RFx Response-> User > Technical Bid only. The "PRICE BID" must contain the price schedule and the bidder's commercial terms and conditions. The prices of the items should be quoted in "Conditions Tab". - 6.0 PRICED BIDS OF ONLY THOSE BIDDERS WILL BE OPENED WHOSE OFFERS ARE FOUND TO BE TECHNO-COMMERCIALLY ACCEPTABLE.
- 7.0 All the Bids must be Digitally Signed using "Class 3" digital certificate (*e-commerce application*) only as per Indian IT Act obtained from the licensed Certifying Authorities operating under the Root Certifying Authority of India (RCAI), Controller of Certifying Authorities (CCA) of India. The bid signed using other than "Class 3" digital certificate, will be liable for rejection.
- 8.0 Bidders are requested to examine all instructions, forms, terms and specifications in the bid. Failure to furnish all information required as per the bid or submission of offers not substantially responsive to the bid in every respect will be at the bidders risk and may result in the rejection of its offer without seeking any clarifications.
- 9.0 The Integrity Pact is applicable against this tender.OIL shall be entering into an Integrity Pact with the bidders as per format enclosed vide Annexure XII of the tender document. This Integrity Pact proforma has been duly signed digitally by OIL's competent signatory. The proforma has to be returned by the bidder (along with the technical bid) duly signed (digitally) by the same signatory who signed the bid, i.e., who is duly authorized to sign the bid. Uploading the Integrity Pact with digital signature will be construed that all pages of the Integrity Pact has been signed by the bidder's authorized signatory who sign the Bid.

(B) GENERAL NOTES FOR BIDDERS:

- 1.0 All Bellow Unit Assembly (BUA)shall be brand new and original. Following mandatory supporting proofs required to be submitted at the time of delivery and have to confirm at the time of bid submission.
- 1.1 BUA Importer(Outsource): (In case of bidder is a trader "or" manufacturer of chart recorder those outsource BUA from another BUA OEM)
- 1.1.1 Unpriced quotation copy of BUA OEM (Original equipment Manufacturer) Name, Model No, with OEM Contact Person name, address, emails ID and contact no. For Verification.
- 1.1.2 OEM original certificate and declaration clearly stating that "All BUA manufactured in respective facility is their own designed, brand new and is not refurbished. Certificate must contain OIL Tender Ref No, Name, Model No, with OEM Contact Person name, address, emails ID and contact no. for verification. Bidder must verify the above OEM certificate from international third party agencies such as Lloyds, SGS etc and verification letter from the third party must be submitted along with the tender.
- 1.1.3 In case of event of an order unpriced Sales order acknowledgement Copy from OEM and corresponding Unpriced Invoice copy having above SI. No. of BUA & DPU with AWB/Bill Of Lading to be submitted along with OEM Contact Person name, address, emails ID and contact no. for verification.
- 1.2 BUA Manufacturer: (In case of bidder is manufacturer of chart recorder those are also OEM of BUA)
- 1.2.1 OEM original certificate and declaration clearly stating that "All BUA manufactured in respective facility is their own designed, brand new and is not refurbished. Certificate must contain OIL Tender Ref No, Name, Model No, with OEM Contact Person name, address, emails ID and contact no. For Verification. Bidder must verify the above OEM certificate from any international third party agencies such as Lloyds, SGS etc and verification letter from the third party must be submitted along with the tender.
- 2.0 Bidder must quote for all the parameters serially as specified in TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS.
- 3.0 All the equipment are to be guaranteed against any manufacturing defects for a minimum period of 12 months from the date of commissioning or 18 months from the date of receipt.
- 4.0 Quotations must be accompanied with original relevant catalogue/ literature and drawings.
- 5.0 The material supply should be accompanied with test/calibration certificates.

- 6.0 Make and model of the original manufacturer should be given along with the bid.
- 7.0 The flow cum pressure recorders—shall be inspected by OIL's deputed engineer at manufacturers / assembler's works / factory prior to dispatch. However, such inspection will not relieve the supplier of his responsibility to ensure that the equipment supplied conforms to the correct specifications and is free from manufacturing and all other defects.
- 8.0 Inspection call for carrying out the inspection of the flow cum pressure recorders shall be given to OIL at least 75 days in advance for making necessary arrangements for deputing OIL personnel.OIL in turn shall confirm the scheduled date of visit of their personnel in advance to you. All to and fro fares, boarding and lodging of OIL's personnel going for pre dispatch inspection will be borne by OIL.

(C) SPECIAL NOTES:

- 1. The items shall be brand new, unused & of prime quality. Bidder shall warrant (in the event of an order) that the product supplied will be free from all defects & fault in material, workmanship & manufacture and shall be in full conformity with ordered specifications. This clause shall be valid for 12 months from date of successful commissioning or 18 months from the date of receipt. The defective materials, if any, rejected by us shall be replaced by the supplier at their own expense on FOR Destination basis. Bidders must confirm the same while quoting.
- 2. The items covered by this tender shall be used by Oil India Limited in the PEL/ML areas which are issued/renewed after 01/04/99 and hence Nil Customs Duty during import will be applicable. Indigenous bidder shall be eligible for Deemed Export Benefit against this purchase. Details of Deemed Export are furnished vide Addendum to MM/GLOBAL/01/2005 enclosed. However no Recommendatory letters will be issued to Indian Bidders.
- 3. To ascertain the substantial responsiveness of the bid OIL reserves the right to ask the bidder for clarification in respect of clauses covered under BRC also and such clarifications fulfilling the BRC clauses in toto must be received on or before the deadline given by the company, failing which the offer will be summarily rejected.

The bids must conform to the specifications and terms and conditions given in the tender. Bids shall be rejected in case the item(s) offered do not conform to the required minimum/maximum parameters stipulated in the technical specifications and to the respective international / national standards wherever stipulated. Notwithstanding the general conformity of the bids to the stipulated specifications and terms and conditions, the following requirements shall have to be particularly met by the bidders, without which the offer will be considered as non-responsive and rejected.

(A) TECHNICAL

- i) Bidders should have the credential of successful execution of at least 01(one) order not less than 30% of the estimated tender quantity for each item during the last three (03) years as on bid closing date to any E&P companies. Documentary evidence in support of bidder's past supply experience of similar items shall be submitted in the form of copy(s) of purchase order along with relevant documents that confirm the satisfactory execution of each order(s), viz., satisfactory supply completion certificate/ bill of lading/consignee received delivery challan / invoice etc.
- ii) Bidders other than Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) must submit valid authorization certificate from OEM along with warranty back-up from OEM.

(B) COMMERCIAL:

Commercial Bid Rejection Criteria will be as per Section D of General Terms & Conditions of Global Tender (MM/GLOBAL/E-01/2005) with following Special Bid Rejection Criteria.

- Bids are invited under **Single Stage Two Bid System**. Bidders shall quote accordingly under Single Stage Two Bid System. **Please note that no price details should be furnished in the Technical (i.e. Unpriced)bid**. The "Unpriced Bid" shall contain all techno-commercial details except the prices, which shall be kept blank. The "Price Bid" must contain the price schedule and the bidder's commercial terms and conditions.
 - Bidder not complying with above submission procedure will be rejected.
- 2) Bid Security of US \$ 2435.00 or Rs. 1,56,735.00 shall be furnished as a part of the TECHNICAL BID (refer Clause Nos.9.0 & 12.0 (Section A) of "General Terms & Conditions" for e-Procurement as per Booklet No. MM/GLOBAL/E-01/2005 for E-procurement (ICB Tenders)). Any bid not accompanied by a proper bid security in ORIGINAL will be rejected without any further consideration. - Successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bank Guarantee @10% of the order value. The Performance Bank Guarantee must be valid for 18(eighteen) months from the date of receipt at site or 12(twelve) months from the date of successful commissioning.
