- 1.0 The tender will be governed by "General Terms & Conditions" for e-Procurement as per Booklet No. MM/GLOBAL/E-01/2005 for E-procurement (ICB Tenders) including Amendments & Addendum to "General Terms & Conditions" for e-Procurement.
- 2.0 Technical & Commercial Check list is furnished vide Annexure B. Please ensure that the check list is properly filled up and uploaded along with Technical bid.
- 3.0 Please note that all tender forms and supporting documents are to be submitted through OIL's e-Procurement site only except following documents which are to be submitted manually in sealed envelope super scribed with tender no. and due date to The Head Materials, Materials Department, Oil India Limited, Duliajan- 786602, Assam on or before the Bid Closing Date and Time mentioned in the Tender.

- 4.0 The tender is invited under SINGLE STAGE-TWO BID SYSTEM. The bidder has to submit both the "TECHNO-COMMERCIAL UNPRICED BID" and "PRICED BID" through electronic form in the OIL's e-Tender portal within the Bid Closing Date and Time stipulated in the e-Tender. The "Techno-commercial Unpriced Bid" shall contain all technical and commercial details except the prices which shall be kept blank. Details of prices as per Bid format / Commercial bid to be uploaded as attachment in the Attachment Tab "Notes and Attachments".
  - Any offer not complying with above submission procedure will be rejected as per Bid Rejection Criteria mentioned in the tender.
- 5.0 In Technical Bid opening, only Technical Rfx will be opened. Therefore, the bidder should ensure that "TECHNO-COMMERCIAL UNPRICED BID should contain details as mentioned in the technical specifications as well as BEC/ BRC and upload the same in the Technical Rfx Response-> User > Technical Bid. No price should be given in above Technical Rfx otherwise the offer will be rejected. Please go through the help document in details before uploading the document and ensure uploading of technical bid in the Technical Rfx Response-> User > Technical Bid only. The "PRICE BID" must contain the price schedule and the bidder's commercial terms and conditions. - 7.0 All the Bids must be Digitally Signed using "Class 3" digital certificate (e-commerce application) only as per Indian IT Act obtained from the licensed Certifying Authorities operating under the Root Certifying Authority of India (RCAI), Controller of Certifying Authorities (CCA) of India. The bid signed using other than "Class 3" digital certificate, will be liable for rejection.
- 8.0 Bidders are requested to examine all instructions, forms, terms and specifications in the bid. Failure to furnish all information required as per the bid or submission of offers not substantially responsive to the bid in every respect will be at the bidders risk and may result in the rejection of its offer without seeking any clarifications.
- 9.0 The Integrity Pact is applicable against this tender. OIL shall be entering into an Integrity Pact with the bidders as per format enclosed vide Annexure XII of the tender document. This Integrity Pact proforma has been duly signed digitally by OIL's competent signatory. The proforma has to be returned by the bidder (along with the technical bid) duly signed (digitally) by the same signatory who

signed the bid, i.e., who is duly authorized to sign the bid. Uploading the Integrity Pact with digital signature will be construed that all pages of the Integrity Pact has been signed by the bidder's authorized signatory who sign the Bid. If any bidder refuses to sign Integrity Pact or declines to submit Integrity Pact with the offer, their bid shall be rejected straightway.

#### **GENERAL NOTES FOR BIDDER:**

- 1. The items shall be brand new, unused & of prime quality. Bidder shall warrant (in the event of an order) that the product supplied will be free from all defects & fault in material, workmanship & manufacture and shall be in full conformity with ordered specifications. This clause shall be valid for 12 months from date of receipt at site or 18 months from the date of shipment/despatch. The defective materials, if any, rejected by us shall be replaced by the supplier at their own expense on FOR Destination basis. Bidders must confirm the same while quoting.
- 2. Bidder should furnish list of recommended spares for two (02) years operation indicating part numbers, quantity and unit price of each and every spares separately along with the quotation in the commercial bid and categorically confirm the same in the technical bid . However, price will not be considered for commercial evaluation. The price should remain valid for at least two (02) years.
- 3. The Bidder should indicate the name of the manufacturer, the country of origin, port of dispatch of the materials and their best delivery schedule.
- 4. Items in the event of order should be embossed (die stamping) with purchase order number & date. Bidders shall confirm compliance to the same while quoting.
- 5. Any deviation(s) from the tender specification should be clearly highlighted specifying justification in support of deviation.
- 6.To ascertain the substantial responsiveness of the bid OIL reserves the right to ask the bidder for clarification in respect of clauses covered under BRC also and such clarifications fulfilling the BRC clauses in toto must be received on or before the deadline given by the company, failing which the offer will be summarily rejected.
- 7. Other terms and conditions of the tender shall be as per "General Terms & Conditions" for e Procurement as per Booklet No. MM/GLOBAL/E-01/2005 for E-procurement (ICB Tenders). ## **SPECIAL NOTES:**

(Bidder to confirm compliance and technically justify their offer regarding the following points):

(a) Bidder should furnish detailed Catalogue, Drawing, and Literature (in printed form, not in computer media such as floppies or CDs) indicating all parts with part numbers along with the quotation in English language (US & UK).

- (b) The shock subs should be able to absorb energy either through the use of Belleville spring assembly or by utilizing a stack of disk springs or any equivalent design while the force dampening should be accomplished by mechanical friction.
- (c) As the shock sub is most effective closest to the bit, it should be made of high quality, hardened steel.
- (d) The shock sub should be designed for transmitting the required drilling torque while isolating the axial loads.
- (e) The seals for isolating internal components from the drilling fluid should be able to withstand temperatures up to 300 degree F, minimum.
- (f) The shock sub should be self-activating. During drilling or milling operations it should work constantly regardless of the hole depth, bit weight, mud weight, torque etc.
- (g) The shock sub should equally work well with low or high WOB.

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### BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC)/BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC)

#### I. BID REJECTION CRITERIA:

The bids shall in general conform to the specifications and terms and conditions given in the tender. Bids shall be rejected in case the goods offered do not conform to the required minimum/maximum parameters stipulated in the technical specifications and to the respective international / national standards wherever stipulated. Notwithstanding the general conformity of the bids to the stipulated specifications and terms and conditions, the following requirements will have to be particularly met by the bids, without which the same will be considered as non-responsive and be rejected.

- 1. The opening travel of the shock sub is 1.8 inches or more and the closing travel of the shock sub is 2.9 inches or more.
- 2. The pump open area of the shock sub is 15.90 square inches or more.
- II EXPERIENCE CRITERIA
- 1. In case, the bidder is an Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM):
- 1.1The bidder should have the experience of supplying at least 3 (three) numbers of Shock Subs, of any sizes, in the last 3 (three) years preceding the original bid closing date of the tender.
- 1.2Documentary evidence to substantiate supply record should be submitted in the form of copies of relevant Purchase Orders along with copies of any of the documents in respect of satisfactory execution of each of those Purchase Orders, such as:
- (i) Satisfactory Inspection report (OR)
- (ii) Satisfactory supply completion/ Installation / Commissioning report (OR)
- (iii) Delivery challans received by Consignee (OR)

- 1.3 In support of manufacturing thread connections with stress relief grooves and bore back box as per API, the bidder should submit copies of API 7-1 certificates with validity covering minimum 3 (three) years continuously (without break) reckoned prior to the original bid closing date of the tender.
- 1.4 Bidder quoting as manufacturer must guarantee uninterrupted supply of spares and availability of service for at least 10 years with effect from delivery of the Item / product for the item / product to be supplied under the Tender / Order, if order is awarded to them by OIL.
- 2. In case the bidder is a sole selling agent /authorized distributors /authorized dealers/authorized supply house of any API approved Original Equipment manufacturer (OEM), then bidder must furnish the following documents:

- 2.1Back-up authority cum warranty letter in original on manufacturer's letter head, valid at the time of bidding which should remain valid during the entire execution period of the order, from the concerned manufacturer guaranteeing supply of the items to the bidder in the event of an order on the bidder and also authorized them to market their products. The bid shall be rejected in case of any change of the proposed OEM after submission of the bid.
- 2.2 The bidders quoting on behalf of the manufacturers must also submit undertaking in original from the manufacturer for back up guarantee, after sale services and uninterrupted supply of spares for at least 10 years with effect from delivery of the Item / product for the item / product to be supplied under the Tender / Order, if order is awarded to them by OIL.
- 2.3 The bidders quoting on behalf of the manufacturers should additionally have the experience of supplying at least 2 (two) numbers of Shock Subs, of any sizes, in the last 3 (three) years preceding the original bid closing date of the tender.

#### (B) COMMERCIAL:
