Specimen traverse in X and Y direction must be 17.5 mm or more.

The system should comprise of a Turbo-molecular pump of capacity of more or less 30I/s or better and a rotary or diaphragm pump.

The Electron Microscope must be supplied with Back Scattered Electron detector and Secondary Electron detector.

The system should consist of an Energy Dispersive X-ray Spectrometer (EDS) system equipped with the latest Silicon Drift detector. The detection element must be Boron (5) to Uranium (92) or Boron (5) to Americium (95). The energy resolution should be 157eV (Cu-Ka) (equivalent to 135eV with Mn-Ka). It should have multichannel analyser with 20kV channel (10 eV per channel). It should have a 2-stage thermo-electric (Peltier) cooling (without fan and LN2 free). The system shold consist of EDS Interface Kit for necessary interfacing with the Microscope.

It should have Auto image adjustment function: Auto (start, focus, brightness).

The frame memory should be of 640×480 pixels or higher.

It must be able to store images in TIF, BMP, JPEG and other formats.

It should have ability to print images directly from user interface.

The system should consist of a detector, analyser and appropriate software which should have the ability of report generation and printing. Necessary interfacing or integrating to the electron microscope must be provided.

The electron microscope must operate on PC controlled electronics having following specification:

PC with Intel Core 2 Duo Processor or greater, 2GB RAM, 160 GB HD, Display resolution 1280×800 pixels WXGA, DVD R/W, USB 2.0, PC Card Slot, Window 7 Professional Operating System. The user interaction should be through mouse and keyboard. High end colour Laser jet printer.

The data display should have micro marker, micron value,

date, time, image number comments.

Bidder to specify the Installation requirements.

All accessories required for the smooth running of the machine should be quoted.

In addition the following accessories are also required.

Cartridge Filament 7 boxes (10pcs)

Carbon Tapes 5 boxes

Aluminium Stubs 2nos. each of 3 different sizes. The system should be preferably equipped with multi stub holder.

- 4.0 The tender is invited under SINGLE STAGE-TWO BID SYSTEM. The bidder has to submit both the "TECHNO-COMMERCIAL UNPRICED BID" and "PRICED BID" through electronic form in the OIL's e-Tender portal within the Bid Closing Date and Time stipulated in the e-Tender. The "Techno-commercial Unpriced Bid" shall contain all technical and commercial details except the prices which shall be kept blank. Details of prices as per Bid format / Commercial bid to be uploaded as attachment in the Attachment Tab "Notes and Attachments".

Any offer not complying with above submission procedure will be rejected as per Bid Rejection Criteria mentioned in the tender.

5.0 In Technical Bid opening, only Technical Rfx will be opened. (B) General Notes for Bidders:

- 1. The whole equipment has to be provided by a single supplier.
- 2. The original equipment manufacturer (OEM) should confirm in writing that the spares for the quoted model will be available for a period of ten years after installation of the instrument.
- 3. One set of operating manual and service manual (in English) should be provided with the instrument
- 4. In case the OEM is bidding through an Indian agent, the OEM should give a written undertaking that they will be responsible for providing the warranty and annual maintenance as per the clauses given in the tender, even if there is a change in the Indian agency of the manufacturer. The undertaking from OEM should also include that, if in future, OEM does not have any Indian agency, the service will be provided directly by the service engineer of the OEM without any extra charge. Printed documents in support of claimed specification should be provided.
- 5. System should be upgradeable at site for future applications.
- 6. The bidder has to provide the list of consumables and spares required for 2 (Two) years trouble free operation of the equipment and shall quote the same separately. However,

8.0 Installation & Commissioning

- a) The successful bidder will be required to install and commission the Instrument at, Oil India Limited, Duliajan, Assam, India by OEM trained and authorized service engineer with trial run of samples to the entire satisfaction of user at OIL, Duliajan premises for its satisfactory performance. The installation engineer should demonstrate all features of the system at the time of installation and impart operational training at site to the laboratory personnel for at least three full working days (excluding the day of arrival and departure).
- b) Installation and Commissioning charges, if any, must be quoted separately on lump sum basis which shall be considered for evaluation of the offer. Offers without indicating the Installation/Commissioning shall be treated as incomplete and non-responsive. Bidders shall confirm about the installation, commissioning while quoting. Any, pre-installation requirements are to be clearly indicated in the offer.

9. Training:

Two scientific staff of OIL should be trained in the operation of the software and the instrument and routine maintenance of the instrument at site after the installation is over. The bidder should quote for the training charges (if any) which shall be considered for bid evaluation. While quoting the training charges, bidder should take into account all charges including to and fro fares, boarding/lodging, and other daily expenses of their personnel. OIL may provide accommodation on chargeable basis subject to availability. Income, Service, Corporate Taxes etc., if any, towards Training will be to supplier's account and will be deducted at source.

10. Annual Maintenance Contract (AMC):

OIL may enter into a Non-Comprehensive AMC for O4(Four) years after the warranty period of the equipment is over. During AMC the supplier should make 2 preventive maintenance visits per year and as many breakdown visit as an when required. The bidder should quote for the AMC charges per year-wise for O4(four) years which shall be considered for bid evaluation. While quoting AMC charges, bidder should take into account all charges including to and fro fares, boarding/lodging, and other daily expenses of the commissioning personnel. OIL may provide accommodation on chargeable basis subject to availability. Income, Service, Corporate Taxes etc., if any, towards AMC will be to supplier's account and will be deducted at source.

- 11. Payment: Payment shall be released as follows
