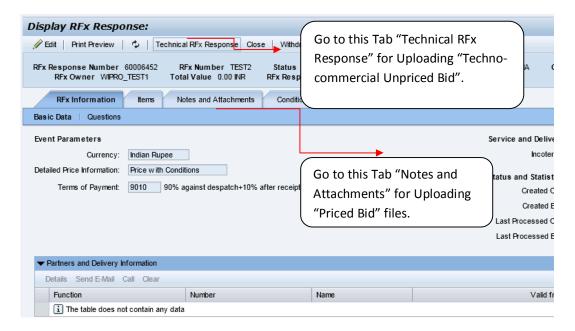

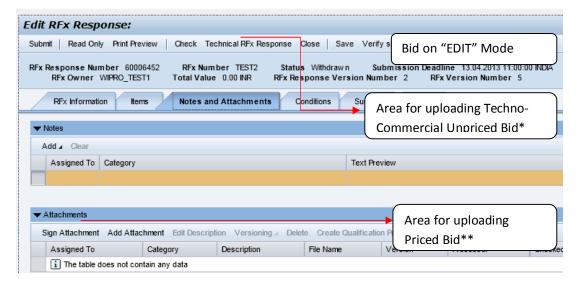

- 1.0 The bidder shall have an annual financial turnover of minimum INR 198.86 Lakh (US\$ 2,90,948) during any of the preceding 03(three) financial years/accounting year reckoned from the original bid closing date.
- 1.1 In case of Consortium, the leader of the consortium shall have an annual financial turnover as mentioned in para 1.0 above and the other members of the consortium should meet minimum turnover of INR 99.43 lakhs (US\$ 1,45,474) during any of the preceding 03(three) financial years reckoned from the original bid closing date.
- 2.0 "**Net Worth**" of the bidder should be positive for the preceding financial/accounting year.
