Dear Sirs,

OIL invites Bids for the supply of TUBING TONG under SINGLE STAGE COMPOSITE BID SYSTEM through its e-Procurement site. The bidding documents and other terms and conditions are available at Booklet No.MM/GLOBAL/E-01/2005. The prescribed Bid Forms for submission of bids are available in the tender document folder.

The general details of tender can be viewed by opening the RFx [Tender no.] under RFx and Auctions page. The details of items tendered can be found under Item tab and details can be found under Technical RFX.

The tender is invited with firm price for the specified quantity. Further details of tender are given in Technical Rfx -> External Area -> Tender Documents as ANNEXURE IA.

The tender will be governed by:

- a) "General Terms & Conditions for global tender" for e-Procurement as per Booklet NO. MM/GLOBAL/E-01/2005 for E-procurement (ICB Tenders) including Amendment and Addendum.
- b) Technical specifications, Quantities and General Notes for TUBING TONG are as per **Annexure –I A** in the **Technical RFx**.
- c) The prescribed Bid Forms for submission of bids are available in the Technical Rfx -> External Area > Tender Documents. Technical Checklist and Commercial Checklist vide **Annexure IV** must be filled-up and submitted along with the technical bid.
- d) The items covered by this tender shall be used by Oil India Limited in the PEL/ML areas which are issued/ renewed after 01/04/99 and hence Nil Custom Duty during import will be applicable. Indigenous bidder shall be eligible for Deemed Export Benefit against this purchase. Details of Deemed Export are furnished vide Addendum to MM/GLOBAL/01/2005 enclosed.

Special Note:

- 1.0 Please note that all tender forms and supporting documents are to be submitted through OIL's e-Procurement site only except following documents which are to be submitted manually in sealed envelope super scribed with <u>Tender no.</u> and <u>Due date</u> to <u>The Head Materials</u>, <u>Materials Department</u>, Oil India Limited, Duliajan- 786602, Assam on or before 13:00 Hrs (IST) on the Bid Closing Date mentioned in the Tender.
 - a) Original Bid Security along with two duplicate copies.

 - c) Any other document required to be submitted in original as per tender requirement.

All documents submitted in physical form should be signed on all pages by the authorised signatory of the bidder and to be submitted in triplicate.

- 2.0 Bidders are requested to examine all instructions, forms, terms and specifications in the bid. Failure to furnish all information required as per the bid or submission of offers not substantially responsive to the bid in every respect will be at the bidders risk and may result in the rejection of its offer without seeking any clarifications.
- 3.0All the Bids must be Digitally Signed using "Class 3" digital certificate (*e-commerce application*) with organisation name as per Indian IT Act obtained from the licensed Certifying Authorities operating under the Root Certifying Authority of India (RCAI), Controller of Certifying Authorities (CCA) of India.

BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC) / BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC) (TECHNICAL)

In addition to BRC/BEC criteria vide SECTION – 'D' of General Terms and Conditions for Global Tender (MM/ GLOBAL/E-01/2005), the following clause will be applicable against this tender.

The bids shall conform to the specifications, terms and conditions given in the tender. Bids shall be rejected in case the item(s) offered do not conform to technical specifications and to the respective international / national standards wherever stipulated.

Notwithstanding the general conformity of the bids to the stipulated specifications, and terms & conditions, the following requirements shall have to be particularly met by the bidders, without which the offer will be considered as non-responsive and rejected. All the documents related to BRC must be submitted along with the technical bid.

A) TECHNICAL:

- 1.0 BRC /BEC (Technical) Qualification
 - 1.1 The bidder shall be an Original Equipment Manufacturer of the tender item(s), or shall be an authorised agent / dealer / distributor / supply house of an Original Equipment Manufacturer of the tender item(s) having valid authorization letter / dealership certificate with warranty/ guarantee back up from the principal (OEM).
 - 1.2 In case the bidder is an authorised agent / dealer / distributor / supply house of an Original Equipment Manufacturer of the tender item(s), copy of authorization letter / dealership certificate with warranty/ guarantee back up from the principal (OEM) shall be submitted along with the technical bid.
- 2.0 BRC/BEC (Technical) Experience
 - 2.1 In case the bidder is an Original Equipment Manufacturer of the tender item(s),
 - 2.1.1 The bidder shall have experience of successful execution of past supply for minimum 18 Nos. of each tender item of same or higher size, against purchase order / contract dated within last 5 years preceding the original bid closing

date of the tender, to any E&P company or service provider to an E&P company, either by themselves or through their agent / dealer / distributor / supply house.

- 2.2 In case the bidder is an authorized agent /dealer /distributor /supply house,
 - 2.2.1 The OEM (principal) shall fulfil the experience criteria mentioned in clause 2.1.1 mentioned above.
 - 2.2.2 Additionally, the bidder himself shall have experience of successful execution of past supply for minimum 18 Nos. of each tender item of same or higher size, against purchase order / contract dated within last 5 years preceding the original bid closing date of the tender, to any E&P company or service provider to an E&P company, provided either from the same OEM (principal) or from any other OEM.
- 2.3 The bidder shall submit documents in support of his previous supply experience and of the principal (OEM), as applicable under clause 2.1.1, 2.2.1 & 2.2.2, as follows:
 - (i) Copy(ies) of Purchase Order(s) / Contract Documents, **and**
 - (ii) Any one or combination of the following documents that confirms the successful execution of each of the purchase order(s) / contract(s) -
 - Completion report / performance certificate from the clients,
 - Bill of lading,
 - Delivery challan / invoice etc.
 - Any other documentary evidence that can substantiate the successful execution of each of the Purchase Order(s) / contract(s) cited above.

3.0 FINANCIAL EVALUATION CRITERIA:

1. The bidder shall have an annual financial turnover of minimum Rs. 11, 73,716.425 (or Equivalent to any foreign currency) during any of the preceding 03 (Three) financial years reckoned from the original bid closing date.

- 2. "Net Worth" of the bidder should be positive for the preceding financial/accounting year.
- 3. Documentary evidence from the Audited Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss Account for the preceding 03 (three) financial/accounting years should be submitted along with the technical bid.
- 4. In case the Audited Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss Account submitted along with the bid are in currencies other than INR or US\$, the bidder shall have to convert the figures in equivalent INR or US\$ considering the prevailing conversion rate on the date on which the Audited Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss Account is signed. A CA certificate is to be submitted by the bidder regarding converted figures in equivalent INR or US\$.

4.0 DELIVERY:

The bidder should categorically confirm in the technical bid that the tendered items will be supplied within the delivery period if mentioned in the tender, without which the bid will be rejected.

(B) COMMERCIAL:

- 1.0 Bids are invited under **Single Stage Composite Bid System**. Bidders shall quote accordingly.
- 2.0 Validity of the bid shall be **minimum 90 days from the date of Bid closing** Date. Bids with lesser validity will be rejected.
- 3.0 The original bid security (Amount is mentioned above and also in RFX Information→RFX Parameters of the tender in OIL's e-portal) should reach us before bid closing date and time of the technical bid. Any bid not accompanied by a proper bid security in ORIGINAL will be rejected without any further consideration. The bidders who are exempted from submitting the Bid Bond should attach documentary evidence in Technical RFx as per clause 9.8 (Section A) of General Terms and conditions for Global Tender (MM/GLOBAL/E-01/2005). The bid security shall be valid up to 28.02.2017. Please submit bid bond as per revised format (with two duplicate copies).
- 4.0 Performance Security is applicable against this tender. **Bidder must confirm the same in their Technical Bid. Offers not complying with this clause will be rejected.** Please refer clause 10.0 of Section A of General Terms and conditions for Global Tender (MM/GLOBAL/E-01/2005).
- 5.0 A bid shall be rejected straightway if it does not conform to any one of the following clauses:

- (a) Validity of bid shorter than the validity indicated in the Tender.
- (b) Original Bid Security not received within the stipulated date & time mentioned in the Tender.
- (c) Bid Security with (i) validity shorter than the validity indicated in Tender and/or (ii) Bid Security amount lesser than the amount indicated in the Tender.
- (d) Average Annual Turnover of a bidder lower than the average Annual turnover mentioned in the Tender.

(II) BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC):

Bids conforming to the specifications, terms and conditions stipulated in the tender and considered to be responsive after subjecting to the Bid Rejection Criteria will be considered for further evaluation as per the Bid Evaluation Criteria mentioned in Section D of "General Terms & Conditions" for e-Procurement as per Booklet No. MM/GLOBAL/E-01/2005- July 2012.

STANDARD NOTE:

- 1.0 The tender is invited under SINGLE STAGE-COMPOSITE BID SYSTEM. The bidder has to submit both the "TECHNO-COMMERCIAL UNPRICED BID" and "PRICED BID" bid through electronic form in the OIL's e-Tender portal within the Bid Closing Date and Time stipulated in the e-Tender.
- 2.0 The bidder should ensure that "TECHNO-COMMERCIAL UNPRICED BID should contain details as mentioned in the technical specifications as well as BEC/ BRC and upload the same in the Technical RFx Response-> User > Technical Bid. Please go through the help document in details before uploading the documents.
- 3.0 General terms and conditions of Global tender (document MM/GLOBAL/E-01/2005- July 2012) is enclosed.
- 4.0 Bid must be submitted electronically only through OIL's e-procurement portal. Bid submitted in any other form will be rejected.
- 5.0 All the Bids must be Digitally Signed using "Class 3" digital certificate (e-commerce application) only as per Indian IT Act obtained from the licensed Certifying Authorities operating under the Root Certifying Authority of India (RCAI), Controller of Certifying Authorities (CCA) of India. The bid signed using other than "Class 3" digital certificate, will be liable for rejection.
- 6.0 To ascertain the substantial responsiveness of the bid OIL reserves the right to ask the bidder for clarification in respect of clauses covered under

BRC also and such clarifications fulfilling the BRC clauses in toto must be received on or before the deadline given by the company, failing which the offer will be summarily rejected.

7.0 Other terms and conditions of the tender shall be as per "General Terms & Conditions" for e- Procurement as per Booklet No. MM/GLOBAL/E-01/2005 for E-procurement (ICB Tenders). However, if any of the Clauses of the Bid Rejection Criteria (BRC) / Bid Evaluation Criteria (BEC) mentioned here contradict the Clauses in the "General Terms & Conditions" for e-Procurement as per Booklet No. MM/GLOBAL/E-01/2005 for E-procurement (ICB Tenders) of the tender and/or elsewhere, those mentioned in this BEC / BRC shall prevail.

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
