- 1.0 For detailed technical information regarding wire ropes manufactured and their selection, application and handling reference should be made to:
- (a) A.P.I. Standard 9A and RP9B (Latest Edition) (b) B.S.S. 302/621 of 1957; IS: 2266-1970; B.S.S. 330 of 1957 and IS: 1856:1970. Wires used in manufacture of wire ropes listed in this section shall be made from acid or basic open-hearth steel. Basic oxygen steel. Electric furnace steel. Fibre cores shall be hard-twisted, best quality, manila, sisal, polypropylene or equivalent. The cores shall be of uniform diameter & Hardness, effectively supporting the strands. Manila & sisal cores shall

be thoroughly impregnated with a suitable lubricating compound free from acid. Jute cores should not be used.

2.0 The wire ropes should be properly reeled in steel or wooden (as indicated in above specification) frame of adequate strength to prevent damage of wire rope during transportation & handling. Wire ropes should be properly lubricated during manufacturing process as well as during reeling on to steel or wooden (as indicated in above specification) spool in order to withstand all types of climates.
