- 1. Payment against Tender Fee should be made only through online mode and no other instrument (Cash/DD/Cheques/Cashier Cheque, etc) will be acceptable.
- 2. Against Bid Security/EMD/Performance Bank Guarantee Only payments through online mode or Submission of Bank Guarantee/LC will be acceptable. No DD/Cheques/Cashier Cheque or any other mode will be acceptable.
- 3. Bid must be submitted electronically only through OIL's e-procurement portal. Bid submitted in any other form shall be rejected.
- 4. - 5. Bidders must ensure that their bid is uploaded in the system before the tender closing date and time. Also, they must ensure that above documents which are to be submitted in a sealed envelope are also submitted at the above mentioned address before the bid closing date and time, failing which the offer shall be rejected.
- 6. Bidders are requested to examine all instructions, forms, terms and specifications in the bid. Failure to furnish all information required as per the bid or submission of offers not substantially responsive to the bid in every respect will be at the bidders risk and may result in rejection of its offer without seeking any clarifications.
- 7. All the Bids must be Digitally Signed using "Class 3" digital certificate (ecommerce application) with organisation name as per Indian IT Act obtained from the licensed Certifying Authorities operating under the Root Certifying Authority of India (RCAI), Controller of Certifying Authorities (CCA) of India.
- 8. Please do refer the User Manual provided on the portal on the procedure How to create Response for submitting offer.
- 9. Bidder to sign and submit completely filled up Technical Evaluation Matrix for Bid evaluation criteria and Technical specification (Annexure IV) and Check lists(Annexure III), failing which offer shall be liable for rejection.

#### 10. Default in delivery/Liquidated Damages:

- i) Time will be of the essence of the contract.
- ii) In the event of the Seller's default in maintaining the agreed delivery schedule set out in the order, OIL shall have the right to cancel the order

at any time after expiry of scheduled delivery date without any reference to the Seller and make alternative arrangement at the discretion of OIL in which case extra expenditure involved, shall be recoverable from the Seller and OIL shall not be responsible towards such cancellation or any damage that may be incurred by the Seller. The decision of OIL shall be final and binding on the Seller.

- iii) As an alternative to Clause No. (ii) above, OIL reserve the right to accept the materials but, the Seller shall be liable to pay liquidated damages @ 0.5% per week or part thereof of the value of the goods in respect of which default in delivery takes place subject to a maximum of 7.5%. Should there be default on the part of the Seller for more than 15 Weeks from the scheduled date to complete the delivery or to complete the Installation / commissioning & Training (wherever applicable) successfully, OIL shall have the right, in addition to the provisions under Clause (ii) to invoke the Performance Security without causing any notice to the Seller to this effect.
- iv) Supplier's competent personnel must arrive at Duliajan within 15 days from the date of intimation by OIL and complete the installation & commissioning job thereafter within the time mentioned in the tender. OIL, on the other hand, shall inform the party immediately on receipt of the goods at Duliajan. Liquidated Damage will be levied for any failure on the part of the supplier in completing the installation and commissioning of the Units @ 0.5% per full week or part thereof to a maximum of 10% of the total installation/commissioning charges
- v) The amount of liquidated damage as stipulated above is a pre-estimated genuine loss as agreed by both the parties and shall be payable without any demur and shall not be open for any dispute whatsoever.
- vi) The liquidated damage as agreed by both the parties as a genuine preestimated loss shall be payable on Landed Cost of the materials at Duliajan inclusive of all cost to the extent of default (undelivered portion only in cases where part delivery is acceptable) and commissioning at site is not involved.
  - 11. The items covered by this enquiry shall be used by Oil India Limited in the PEL/ML areas which are issued/renewed after 01/04/99 and hence Nil Customs Duty on import will be applicable. Indigenous bidder shall be eligible for Deemed Export Benefit against this purchase. Details of Deemed Export are furnished vide Addendum to MM/GLOBAL/E-01/2005 attached. However, Indian bidders shall not be issued any Recommendatory Letter.

### **SPECIAL NOTES:**

- 1.0 Pre-dispatch/Shipment Inspection & Testing charges, if any, must be quoted Separately on lump sum basis which shall be considered for evaluation of the offers. To and fro fares, boarding/ lodging and other enroute expenses of OIL's Inspection team for carrying our inspection shall be borne by OIL.
- 2.0 Installation & Commissioning:
- 2.1 The successful bidder will be required to install and commission the unit by their competent service engineer.
- 2.2 Installation/ Commissioning charges must be quoted separately on lumpsum basis along with furnishing scope of work which shall be considered for evaluation of the offers. Total Nos. of days required for commissioning shall also be clearly indicated by the bidders.
- 2.3 While quoting Installation/Commissioning above, bidder should take into account all charges including to and fro fares, boarding and/lodging, local transport at Duliajan, Assam and other expenses of supplier's personnel during their stay at Duliajan. OIL may provide accommodation on Chargeable basis subject to availability. Bidder should confirm about providing all these services in their Bid. However, OIL reserves the right to avail such services at its own discretion.

#### 3.0 Tax & Duties:

- (i) All taxes, stamp duties and other levies imposed outside India shall be the responsibility of the Bidder/Seller and charges thereof shall be included in the offered rates.
- (ii) All Taxes & levies imposed in India, for the services including installation & commissioning, shall be to the Bidder/Seller's account.
- (iii) Income Tax on the value of the Services rendered by the Bidder /Seller in connection with installation, commissioning, training etc. shall be deducted at source from the invoices at the appropriate rate under the I.T. Act & Rules from time to time.

## 4.0 **Payment**: Payment shall be released as follows:

- i) 80 % of the order value shall be paid against dispatch / shipment of the goods.
- ii) Balance 20 % of the order value along with the commissioning charges shall be paid after successful commissioning and acceptance of the item by OIL.

OIL may also consider 100 % payment against shipment / despatch document provided bidder agree to pay the interest for 20 % of order value and also submit Bank Guarantee equivalent to 20 % of the order value in addition to the Performance Security of 10 %.

Any offer not complying with the above shall be loaded at one percent above the prevailing Bank rate (CC rate) of State Bank of India for evaluation purpose.

## BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC)/BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC)

The bids shall conform generally to the specifications and terms as well as conditions laid out in the tender. Bids will be rejected in case the items offered do not conform to the required parameters stipulated in the technical specifications and to the respective international / national standards wherever stipulated. Notwithstanding the general conformity of the bids to the stipulated specifications and terms & conditions, the following requirements will have to be met particularly by the bidders, without which, the offer will be considered as non-responsive and stand rejected.

### **BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC)**

A. TECHNICAL:

## 1.0 Bidder's Eligibility:

- 1.1 Bidder shall be an Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) or an authorized dealer of OEM of all or any one the following three items
  - i) Engine
  - ii) Alternator and
  - iii) Generator Set Complete

OR

An OEM approved assembler of Generating Set or an authorized dealer of the OEM approved assembler.

- 1.2 In case the bidder is an OEM of Engine or its authorized dealer, Alternator shall be purchased from the OEM of Alternator or its authorized dealer and vice versa
- 1.3 In case the bidder is an OEM approved assembler of Generating set, the Engine and the Alternator shall be purchased from respective OEM or their authorized dealers
- 1.4 The bidder shall submit OEM Certificate / Assembler Certificate /Authorized Dealership Certificate from principal/ as the case may be along with the technical bid. Offer will be summarily rejected in case of failure to submit valid certificate
- 1.5 The bidder or its principal should have after-sales service center in India for the engine. The bidder is required to submit documentary evidence in support of the presence of after-sales service center in India along with the technical bid.

### 2.0 Bidder's Experience:

2.1 The bidder must have executed successfully minimum one order for supply, installation, testing and commissioning of gas engine driven generating set of capacity 125KVA or more during the last 5(five) years before the bid closing date

of this tender to organizations namely PSU (State/Central Government of India) or State/Central Govt. Department of India or any other public Limited company

2.2 The engine(make & type) in the offer should have been supplied before by the bidder and minimum 2(two) nos. of the engines must have logged more than 3000 running hours before the bid closing date of this tender in oil & gas fields of India with on-site field natural gas as fuel

The following documents shall be submitted along with the offer as supporting documentary evidence:

- 2.2.1 Copies of the Purchase Orders and Satisfactory Supply Completion Report/Installation Report in case of clause 2.1 above
- 2.2.2 Performance Certificate with logged running hours as proven track record of the supplied engines in case of clause 2.2 above
- 3.0 Gas Engine: The engine shall be 4-stroke, spark ignited, naturally aspirated/turbocharged after-cooled multi-cylinder in-line gas engine designed in accordance with standards ISO: 3046 / BS: 5514 / IS: 10000 and capable of developing suitable power in the range of 310 333 BHP at 1500RPM with compression ratio not exceeding 12:1. It should be water cooled with closed coupled radiator or Heat Exchanger and Cooling Tower and complete with all other accessories
- 4.0 Undertaking for Non-Obsoleteness of equipment
  The bidder shall submit undertaking and confirmation from OEM that the
  equipment to be supplied are not going to become obsolete for the next 10 years
  at the least and provisioning of spares will be continued.
- 5.0 Time frame for supply of equipments including installation and commissioning are specified below:
- 5.1 Delivery Period after placement of Purchase order: Delivery of all items under the scope of the order must be completed within 9(nine) months from date of firm placement of order. Bidder shall furnish, along with their technical bid, undertaking to complete delivery as specified in this clause, in the event of placement of order on it.
- 5.2 Installation and Commissioning: The installation and commissioning work of the order that are with the scope of the supplier must be completed within 3(three) months from date of delivery. Bidder shall furnish, along with their technical bid, undertaking to complete the installation and commissioning work as specified in this clause, in the event of placement of order on it

#### Financial Criteria:

1 **Annual Turnover**: The bidder shall have an annual financial turnover of minimum US\$ 2,24,000.00 or INR 1.52 Crore during any of the preceding 03 (three) financial years reckoned from the original bid closing date of the tender.

- 2 "Net Worth" of the bidder should be positive for the preceding financial/accounting year.
- 3 Considering the time required for preparation of Financial Statements, if the last date of preceding financial / accounting year falls within the preceding six months reckoned from the original bid closing date and the Financial Statements of the preceding financial / accounting year are not available with the bidder, then the financial turnover of the previous three financial / accounting years excluding the preceding financial / accounting year will be considered. In such cases, the Net worth of the previous financial / accounting year excluding the preceding financial / accounting year will be considered. However, the bidder has to submit an affidavit/undertaking certifying that 'the balance sheet/Financial Statements for the financial year....... (As the case may be) has actually not been audited so far'.

**Note:** For proof of Annual Turnover & Net worth any one of the following document must be submitted along with the bid:-

i) A certificate issued by a practicing Chartered/Cost Accountant (with Membership Number and Firm Registration Number), certifying the Annual turnover & Net worth as per format prescribed in ANNEXURE.

- ii) Audited Balance Sheet along with Profit & Loss account.
- In case the Audited Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss Account submitted along with the bid are in currencies other than INR or US\$, the bidder shall have to convert the figures in equivalent INR or US\$ considering the prevailing conversion rate on the date of Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss Account. A CA certificate is to be submitted by the bidder regarding converted figures in equivalent INR or US\$.

#### **B) COMMERCIAL**

Commercial Bid Rejection Criteria will be as per Section D of General Terms & Conditions of Global Tender (MM/GLOBAL/E-01/2005) with following Special Bid Rejection Criteria.

- 1) Bids are invited under **Single Stage Two Bid System**. Bidders shall quote accordingly under Single Stage Two Bid System. **Please note that no price details should be furnished in the Technical (i.e. Unpriced) bid**. The "Unpriced Bid" shall contain all techno-commercial details except the prices/rates, which shall be kept blank. The "Price Bid" must contain the price schedule and the bidder's commercial terms and conditions. Bidder not complying with above submission procedure will be rejected.
- 2) Bid security of INR 6,10,000.00 or US\$ 9,000.00 shall be furnished as a part of the TECHNICAL BID. Any bid not accompanied by a proper bid security in ORIGINAL will be rejected without any further consideration. A bid shall be rejected straightway if Original Bid Security is not received within the stipulated date & time mentioned in the Tender and/or if the Bid Security validity is shorter than the validity indicated in Tender and/or if the Bid Security amount is lesser

than the amount indicated in the Tender.

- 2.1 For exemption for submission of Bid Security please refer Clause No. 9.8 (Section A) of "General Terms & Conditions" for e-Procurement as per Booklet No. MM/GLOBAL/E-01/2005 for E-procurement (ICB Tenders).
- 2.2 Bank Guarantee towards Bid Security shall remain valid for 210 days from the bid closing date i.e upto 05.09.2017.
- 3) Validity of the bid shall be minimum 120 days from the date of Bid Closing. Bids with lesser validity will be straightway rejected.
- 4) Bidders must confirm that Goods, materials or plant(s) to be supplied shall be new of recent make and of the best quality and workmanship and shall be guaranteed for a period of 12 months from the date of successful commissioning against any defects arising from faulty materials, workmanship or design. Defective goods/materials or parts rejected by OIL shall be replaced immediately by the supplier at the supplier's expenses at no extra cost to OIL.
- 5) Successful bidder will be required to furnish a Performance Bank Guarantee @10% of the order value. The Performance Bank Guarantee must be valid for a period of 12 months from the date of commissioning. Bidder must confirm the same in their Technical Bid. Offers not complying with this clause will be rejected.

The bids conforming to the specifications, terms and conditions stipulated in the enquiry and considered to be responsive after subjecting to the Bid Rejection Criteria will be considered for further evaluation as per General Terms and Conditions for Global Tender and the Bid Evaluation Criteria given below:

#### **COMMERCIAL**

- 1.0 The evaluation of bids will be done as per the Commercial Bid Format (SUMMARY) detailed vide Para 7) of BRC.
- 2.0If there is any discrepancy between the unit price and the total price, the unit price will prevail and the total price shall be corrected accordingly. Similarly, if there is any discrepancy between words and figure, the amounts in words shall prevail and will be adopted for evaluation.
- 3.0 For conversion of foreign currency into Indian currency, B.C. selling (Market) rate declared by State Bank of India, one day prior to the date of price bid opening shall be considered. However, if the time lag between the opening of the bids and final decision exceed 3(three) months, then B.C. Selling(Market) rate of exchange declared by SBI on the date prior to the date of final decision shall be adopted for conversion and evaluation.
- 4.0 Offers not complying with the payment terms indicated in the enquiry shall be loaded with one percent above the prevailing Bank rate (CC rate) of State Bank of India for duration of commissioning time indicated in the tender plus transit time (3 months) for evaluation purpose
- 5.0To ascertain the inter-se-ranking, the comparison of the responsive bids will be made as under, subject to corrections / adjustments given herein.
- 6.1 When only foreign bidders are involved:

6.3 When both foreign and domestic bidders are involved:

The Total Value of domestic bidder (inclusive of customs duty on imported raw material and components etc. and applicable terminal excise duty on the finished products and Sales Tax) excluding inland transportation to destination, Assam Entry Tax and Insurance charges worked out as per Para 6.2 above and Total Value of the foreign bidder worked out as per Para 6.1 above will be compared. No price preference will be allowed to indigenous bidders except that for capital goods, the domestic manufacturers would be accorded a price preference to offset CST to the extent of 4 % or actuals, whichever is less subject to 30 % local content norms as stipulated for World Bank Funded project to the satisfaction of OIL. When more than one domestic bidders fall within price preference range, inter-se-ranking will be done on Total Value basis.
