TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION & SCOPE OF WORK

Oil India Limited (OIL) intends to purchase 02 (Two) sets of new Cement Bond Logging tools with Gamma Ray & Casing Collar Locator for cement bond evaluation in oil and gas wells. The tools must be capable of recording standard Cement Bond Log, Variable Density Log, Gamma Ray & Casing Collar Logs in a single run.

PART-A TECHNICAL DESCRIPTION & SCOPE OF WORK

1. CEMENT BOND LOGGING (CBL) TOOL - Quantity = 02 sets

Cement Bond Logging tools are required to record standard 3 ft. Cement Bond Amplitude Log, 5 ft. Variable Density Log (VDL) and Travel Time Log in combination with Gamma Ray and CCL logs. Tools offered must be compatible to run with mono-conductor logging cables of sizes 7/32" and 5/16" OD on Warrior Cased Hole Logging System (Warrior version 7 and 8).

- **1.1.** Technical specifications:
 - i. Tool O.D must be between 2.75" to 3.625"
 - ii. Minimum pressure rating= 20000psi for a minimum period of 1 hour
 - iii. Minimum temperature rating= 350°F for a minimum period of 1 hour
 - iv. Transmitter to Receiver spacing = 3 ft and 5ft
- **1.2.** The offered CBL tool must be able to log CBL/VDL log in oil and gas wells through the following casing sizes:
 - i. 5 inch (15 ppf)
 - ii. 5.5 inch (20ppf)
 - iii. 7 inch (29ppf)
 - iv. 9.625 inch (47ppf)
- **1.3.** The offered CBL tool must be capable of providing simultaneous measurements of Casing to cement bond amplitude, compressional Travel Time and Variable Density Log (VDL) using acoustic techniques.
- 1.4. The CBL tool must be able to record Casing Collar Locator (CCL) and Gamma Ray in a single run. For these purpose, if the CBL tool does not have integrated CCL subsection and Gamma Ray subsection, then separate CCL and Gamma Ray tools as per specifications mentioned below in Clause 2 and 3 must be offered. The separate CCL and Gamma Ray tools offered by the bidder must be combinable with the offered CBL tools.

2. GAMMA RAY TOOL - Quantity = 02 sets

Gamma Ray tool is required to record natural gamma ray log for depth correlation. Gamma Ray tool quoted must be combinable with offered CBL and CCL tools.

2.1. <u>Technical specifications:</u>

- i. Tool O.D must be between 2.75" to 3.625"
- ii. Minimum pressure rating= 20000psi for a minimum period of 1 hour
- iii. Minimum temperature rating= 350°F for a minimum period of 1 hour

3. CASING COLLAR LOCATOR - Quantity = 02 sets

Casing collar Locator (CCL) tool is to record casing collar log in Cased holes for determining collar positions. The CCL tool must be combinable with offered CBL and Gamma Ray tools.

- **3.1.** CCL tool must be able to log collars in the following casing sizes:
 - i. 5 inch (15 ppf)
 - ii. 5.5 inch (20ppf)
 - iii. 7 inch (29ppf)
 - iv. 9.625 inch (47ppf)
- **3.2.** Technical specifications:

- **4.3.** All centralizers quoted must be metallic centralizers. **Tools offered with** rubber- body centralizers will not be accepted.

- **5.3.** The Bidder must **submit a written commitment** that the operational accessories, spares and consumables will be supplied on chargeable basis to OIL for a period of 10 years from the date of completion of commissioning of the tools.
- **5.4.** Apart from the above mentioned spares, the bidder is requested to submit a **list of all recommended spares** (electronic, mechanical, etc.), accessories and consumables for the offered tools. The price list should contain description, part number and unit price of each item. The above is required for OIL's future reference/procurement only, and **will not be considered for bid evaluation**.
- **6.** All items will be procured from the same source.

7. MANUALS AND DOCUMENTS

7.1. The following technical manuals and documentations are to be supplied at no charge to OIL:

- **7.2.** All the documents should be in English language only.

8. WARRANTY

- 8.1. Materials supplied as per the Purchase Order should be under warranty by the suppliers for a minimum period of 01 (one) year from the date of successful completion of commissioning of the entire equipment at site. Any item / sub item failing during the above mentioned warranty period is to be replaced / repaired within 03 (three) months from the date of notification of such failure. The warranty of the repaired / replaced items shall be correspondingly extended by a period equal to that from the date of failure to the date of commissioning of the replaced/repaired item. In order to keep the equipment fully operational, all spares and accessories required during the warranty period is to be arranged at site by the suppliers or their authorized representatives, within 03 (three) months, at their cost (including Customs Clearance etc.). Bidders must submit a written commitment in this regard.
- **8.2.** Oil India Limited (OIL) reserves the right to inspect, test and wherever necessary, reject the goods after arrival of the goods at site, only if the said rejection is attributed to be the responsibility of the Bidder. It shall, in no way be limited or waived by reason of the goods being previously inspected, tested and passed by OIL or its representatives prior to the goods shipment from the country of origin.

9. COMMISSIONING

9.1. Commissioning includes testing of all the downhole tools in the well and testing of all other goods supplied. The bidder will have to depute personnel with good communication capability in English and with minimum of five years' experience in operations and maintenance of wireline logging and downhole tools, to OIL, Duliajan for field commissioning of the entire equipment. The bidders must quote for lump sum commissioning charges with its offer. The bidder should note that to and fro air-fare, accommodation, local transport and food to the bidder's personnel during the commissioning period will be arranged by the bidder on the bidder's account only and OIL will not provide the same. The commissioning charges quoted will be considered for bid evaluation.

Immediately after receipt of all the materials by OIL at Duliajan, a written advice will be issued to the supplier asking them to commence commissioning, which must be promptly acknowledged by the supplier. Commissioning of the downhole tools and other accessories is to be completed within 03 (three) months from the date of receipt of such an advice from OIL (this three months period excludes the waiting time for well readiness). Supply of short-shipped and warranty replacement items is to be arranged, including Customs Clearance etc. by the suppliers or their authorized representatives at their cost within 03 (three) months from the date of completion of commissioning of the entire equipment. The bidder will be held responsible for any further delay in completion of commissioning of the goods at site and in case of defaulters the Liquidated Damage Clause (Clause 9.4 below) will be made applicable.

- **9.2.** In order to complete the field commissioning of the downhole tools and accessories within the stipulated time-frame, all the spares and accessories which will be required during commissioning (due to failure of some components and/or any other materials required) are to be arranged (including Customs Clearance etc.) by the suppliers or their authorized representatives at the earliest, at site at their cost.
- **9.3.** During commissioning, both sets of tools will be tested in OIL's oil/gas wells by carrying out actual logging operations. Each downhole tool must perform at least 02 nos. of successful logging jobs in two different wells. Each of these logging jobs will have to be carried out in a well-depth of 3500 meters (approx.) or more as required by OIL.
- **9.4.** Liquidated Damage will be levied for any failure on the part of the supplier in completion of commissioning @ 0.5% per full week or part thereof to a maximum of 7.5% of the value of the commissioning.

10. DELIVERY:

- 10.1. Delivery required against this tender is maximum 9 (nine) months from the date of opening of LC in case order is placed on the foreign supplier OR within 9 (nine) months from the date of receipt of order in case order is placed on indigenous supplier. Date of clean Bill of Lading (B/L in case of foreign supplier) or Consignment Note date (C/Note date in case of foreign supplier) shall be considered as delivery date.
- **10.2.** Bidder must comply with the above schedule and confirm in written in their Techno-Commercial bid. Bids not meeting time schedule as mentioned in the tender shall be summarily rejected.
- **10.3.** In the event of the Seller's default in maintaining the quoted delivery schedule, seller shall be liable to pay liquidated damages @ 0.5% per week or part thereof of the material value of the order subject to a maximum of 7.5%. Liquidated damages amount, if any, shall be adjusted/deducted while processing the balance payment which is payable after commissioning.
