INVITATION TO e-BID UNDER OPEN TWO BID SYSTEM

Dear Sirs.

OIL invites Bids for the supply of **PRE- GELATINIZED STARCH** through its e-Procurement site under **International Competitive Bidding - Single Stage TWO BID System**. The bidding documents and other terms and conditions are available at Booklet No.MM/GLOBAL/E-01/2005 – July 2012. The prescribed Bid Forms for submission of bids are available in the tender document folder.

The general details of tender can be viewed by opening the RFx [Tender no.] under RFx and Auctions page. The details of items tendered can be found under Item tab and details can be found under Technical RFX.

The tender is invited with firm price for the specified quantity. Further details of tender are given in Technical Rfx -> External Area - > Tender Documents as **ANNEXURE 1A**.

The tender will be governed by:

- a) "General Terms & Conditions" for e-Procurement as per Booklet No. MM/GLOBAL/E-01/2005 July 2012 for e-procurement (ICB Tenders). Special attention to the bidders is drawn to Section E of the document.
- b) Technical Specifications, Quantity and Notes for **PRE- GELATINIZED STARCH** as per **Annexure 1A.**
- c) The prescribed Bid Forms for submission of bids are available in the Technical Rfx -> External Area > Tender Documents. Technical Checklist and Commercial Checklist vide **Annexure IV** must be filled-up and submitted along with the technical bid.
- d) The items covered by this tender shall be used by Oil India Limited in the PEL/ML areas which are issued/renewed after 01/04/99 and hence Nil Custom Duty during import will be applicable. Indigenous bidder shall be eligible for Deemed Export Benefit against this purchase. Details of Deemed Export are furnished vide Addendum to MM/GLOBAL/01/2005 July 2012.

(IST) on the Bid Closing Date mentioned in the Tender.

- 2.0 Tender sample to be submitted before bid closing date and time.
- 3.0 Bidders are requested to examine all instructions, forms, terms and specifications in the bid. Failure to furnish all information required as per the bid or submission of offers not substantially responsive to the bid in every respect will be at the bidders risk and may result in the rejection of its offer without seeking any clarifications.
- 4.0 All the Bids must be Digitally Signed using "Class 3" digital certificate (e-commerce application) with organisation name as per Indian IT Act obtained from the licensed Certifying Authorities operating under the Root Certifying Authority of India (RCAI), Controller of Certifying Authorities (CCA) of India.

- (i) Prepare Base Mud using OIL Approved Bentonite having Apparent Viscosity 25 cP (Maximum) and API FiltrationLoss 20 ± 2 ml at 24 ± 2 °C, from pre-hydrated Bentonite suspension (prepared by stirring 10% (w/v) Bentonite in Distilled Water for 30 minutes using laboratory stirrer (5000 6000 rpm) and aged for 72 hours at 90 ± 2 °C) by diluting with Distilled Water and stirring in Hamilton Beach Mixer for 30 minutes at high speed. Measure Apparent Viscosity (cP) at 24 ± 2 °C by a Fann VG Meter or Equivalent and Filtration Loss (ml) by API Filtration Tester. Record Apparent Viscosity and API Filtration Loss of the fresh water base mud.
- (ii) Treat the Base Mud 7 (a) (i) with 1.0% Pregelatinized Starch (1.0 g of Sample for each 100 ml of Base Mud) while stirring in Hamilton Beach Mixer at high speed. Stir for 30 minutes and measure Apparent Viscosity and API Filtration Loss of Treated Mud at 24 ± 2 ° C :

Apparent Viscosity of the treated fresh water base mud should not be more than 55.0 cp.

API Filtration Loss of the treated fresh water base mud should not be more than 50% of the value obtained for fresh water base mud 7(a)(i).

- (b) In Salt Water Mud:
- (i) Prepare 10.0% (w/v) Bentonite Suspension in Distilled Water from OIL Approved Bentonite by stirring for 30 minutes in laboratory stirrer (5000 6000 rpm) and age it for 72 hours at 90 \pm 2 °C. Treat the Mud with 4.0% (w/v) NaCl (AR/GR grade) and 0.35% (w/v) Sodium Bicarbonate (AR/GR grade). Stir for 15 minutes at high speed in Hamilton Beach Mixer and age it for 24 hours at 24 \pm 2 °C. Further dilute the suspension as required with a solution of 4.0% NaCl (AR / GR Grade) in distilled water with stirring in Hamilton Beach Mixer at high speed for 30 minutes to achieve API Filtration Loss of 80 \pm 5 ml at 24 \pm 2 °C.

Measure Apparent Viscosity (cP) and API Filtration Loss (ml) of the Salt Water Base Mud at 24 ± 2 ° C.:

Record Apparent Viscosity and API Filtration Loss of the salt water base mud.

(ii) Treat the Base Mud 7 (b) (i) with 1.0% Pregelatinized Starch (1.0 g Sample, for each 100 ml of Base Mud) stir in Hamilton Beach Mixer at high speed for 30 minutes. Then determine Apparent Viscosity and API Filtration Loss at 24 ± 2 °C.

Apparent Viscosity of the treated salt water base mud should not be less than the value obtained for the salt water base mud 7 (b)(i).

API Filtration Loss of the treated salt water base mud should not be more than 20% of the value obtained for the salt water base mud 7 (b) (i).

14) OIL shall be entering into an Integrity Pact with the bidders as per format enclosed vide Annexure XII of the tender document. This Integrity Pact proforma has been duly signed digitally by OIL's competent signatory. The proforma has to be returned by the bidder (along with the technical bid) duly signed (digitally) by the same signatory who signed the bid, i.e., who is duly authorized to sign the bid. Uploading the Integrity Pact with digital signature will be construed that all pages of the Integrity Pact has been signed by the bidder's authorized signatory who sign the Bid.

CC. BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC)

In addition to BRC criteria vide Section – D of General Terms & Conditions for Global tenders (MM/GLOBAL/E-01/2005 - JULY 2012), the following clauses will be applicable against the tender failing which offer will be rejected.

- 1. The party should be preferably a Manufacturer of the product. In case the bidder is not a manufacturer, he should be an authorised representative / dealer / supplier of the product of manufacturer. The authorised representative / dealer / supplier should produce authority letter in original from its manufacturer authorizing them to submit the bid along with the bid. Such authority letter should be valid for the entire period of execution of the order.
- 2. In case the bidder is not in a position to submit Authority letter from the manufacturer then bidder must submit Quality Assurance certificate mentioning that the offered product will be of same or higher quality / standard of the tender sample submitted along with the bid in the event of bulk supply against order.
- 3. The bidder should have at least 3 years of manufacturing / supply experiences of tendered item with supply record of minimum one order of 30% tender quantity of tendered material to various E&P / Mud Engineering companies. For this purpose the period reckoned shall be the period prior to the Bid Closing date of the tender. However, bidders whose materials have been successfully field tried extensively in OIL's operational area are exempted from meeting this criteria. Documentary evidences in support of above supply should be submitted along with the technical bid. OIL reserves the rights to verify the same.
 - NOTE: To develop any new source field trial followed by extensive field trial of the product are conducted. In case of field trial, order is placed for a quantity which is sufficient for 2/3 wells use. This gives the idea how this product performs in our field. Once this field trial is over, to asses the quality assurance and supplier's capability another order is placed with larger quantity for 5/6 wells use. Based on timely delivery as well as consistency in

quality of the product, the vendor is developed. The second trial for a good number of wells is termed extensive field trial.

- 4. The bidder should submit tender sample of the product in triplicate (i.e. 3 samples) along with the bid. The bid should also accompany test report in original of their latest manufactured product. Further, the bidder should confirm that bulk supply will be same as the tender sample supplied for along with the tender.

DD. SPECIAL NOTE:

- i) Bidders must submit 3 (three) tender samples of ½ kg each of the offered product in 3 (three) separate air tight sealed containers free of cost for technical evaluation.
- ii) The tender sample will be evaluated in OIL's laboratory as per OIL's tender specification for acceptance.
- iii) Bidder shall submit a copy of Material Safety Data Sheet of the quoted product along with the bid.
- iv) The material should be supplied in the original packing of the manufacturer with markings as specified in the tender.
- v) Bidder shall confirm shelf life as per NIT requirement, wherever asked for. Any supply without shelf life or shelf life less than the NIT requirement shall be rejected.

- vii) The supplied material against orders will be accepted after passing the specification test in the OIL's laboratory at Duliajan. The supplied product must meet the order specification and perform at par with the corresponding tender sample submitted by the bidder against this tender during the quality assessment test in the laboratory.
