BID REJECTION / EVALUATION CRITERIA:

1.0 BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC):

The bid shall conform to the specifications and terms and conditions given in the Bidding Documents. Bids will be rejected in case material and services offered do not conform to the required parameters stipulated in the technical specifications. Notwithstanding the general conformity of the bid to the stipulated specifications, the following requirements will have **to be particularly met by the Bidders without which the same will be considered as non-responsive and rejected.** All the documents related to BRC shall be submitted along with the Techno-Commercial Bid.

1.1 TECHNICAL: Bidder's Eligibility Criteria:

1.1.1 The bidder must have experience of

- (a) Successfully completing supply erection and installation of movable and reusable Bunk House for Office setup including movable, reusable toilet set up as per industrial standard and with materials used of IS Standard.
- (b) Bidder should have experience of carrying out of Basic Electrical Fittings for lighting, fans and air conditioning system etc. in Bunk house mentioned in (a) above.

1.1.2 Bidder must have average annual financial as per Audited Annual Reports for the last three accounting years preceding scheduled bid opening date (i.e 2010-2013) should not be less than ` 12,30,000/-

For proof of Annual Turnover, any of the following documents / photocopy must be furnished:

- (i) A certificate issued by a practicing Chartered / Cost Account Firm with membership number certifying the Annual Turnover and nature of business.
- (ii) Audited Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss Account.

1.2 EXPERIENCE: Bidder must have:

1.2.1 Experience of having successfully completed similar work mentioned in 1.1.1 (a) & (b) during last 7 years ending last day of the Month (i.e. 28.02.2014) previous to the one in which applications are invited should be either of the following:

- i) 3 similar completed Work (referred in Clause 1.1.1) each of value not less than ` 16,40,000/- each
- OR
- (ii) 2 similar completed work (referred in Clause 1.1.1) each of value not less than ` 20,50,000/- each.
- OR
- (iii) 1 similar completed work (referred in Clause 1.1.1) of value not less than ` 32,80,000/- each.

1.3 The bidder must have:

- a) PF code number issued by the appropriate Govt. Authority or exemption certificate from the concerned authority or a declaration in stamped paper that provisions of the PF Act are not applicable to him / them and in case the PF is to be deposited later on, the same will be deposited by the bidder.
- b) PAN and VAT Registration number.
- c) Documentary evidence in support of sound financial standing as mentioned in 1.3.1.2 and Bank Account number from any Nationalized Bank.

Note: All documents relating to clause 1.1, 1.2 and 1.3 above required for establishing successfully completion of above contracts must be submitted along with techno-commercial bid. These documents should be in the form of copies of Contracts / work orders / completion certificates / payment certificates and commissioning certificates issued by the organization concerned. However, the originals of these documents shall have to be produced by the bidder as and when asked for.

1.4 COMMERCIAL:

- 1.4.1 Bidder shall submit the offer and upload under **Single Stage “Two Bid System”**.
- 1.4.2 Bidder shall furnish Bid Security along with the Bid. Bid security shall be furnished as a part of ‘Techno-Commercial Bid’. Any bid not accompanied by a proper bid security will be rejected. Bidder shall submit original document to the address as specified with BCD before Bid opening date and time, otherwise Bid will be rejected. A scanned copy of this document should also be uploaded along with the Un-priced bid.
- 1.4.3 The Techno-Commercial Bid should not have any price indication.
- 1.4.4 **Bidder shall furnish Bid Security as referred in Relevant Section of the Bid document so as to reach the Company (i.e. OIL) before due date of closing. Any bid for which bid security is not received before due Date of Bid Closing will be rejected.**
- 1.4.5 Validity of the bid shall be minimum 180 days. Bids with lesser validity will be rejected.
- 1.4.6 Any bid received in the form of Telex/Cable/Fax/E-mail/Telephone call will not be accepted.
- 1.4.7 Bidders must quote clearly and strictly in accordance with the price schedule outlined in relevant section of Bidding Document; otherwise the bid will be rejected.
- 1.4.8 Any bid containing false statement will be rejected.
- 1.4.9 The Bid Documents are not transferable. Bids made by parties who have not purchased the Bid Documents from the Company will be rejected.
- 1.4.10 Any Bid received by the Company after the deadline for submission of bids prescribed by the Company will be rejected.
- 1.4.11 Price quoted by the successful Bidder must be firm during the performance of the Contract and not subject to variation on any account. A bid submitted with an adjustable price will be treated as non-responsive and rejected.
- 1.4.12 The following Clauses with all its sub-clauses should be agreed in totality, failing which the bid will be rejected. To this effect Bidder shall submit an undertaking along with the Techno commercial Bid.
 - a) Performance Security Clause
 - b) Force Majeure Clause
 - c) Termination Clause
 - d) Settlement of disputes Clause

- e) Liquidated Damages Clause
- f) Acceptance of Jurisdiction and applicable law.
- g) Tax liabilities clause
- h) Insurance clause
- i) With holding clause
- j) Liability clause
- k) Set off clause

1.5 GENERAL:

- 1.5.1 In case Bidder takes exception to any clause of Tender Document not covered under BEC/BRC, then the Company has the discretion to load or reject the offer on account of such exception if the Bidder does not withdraw/modify the deviation when/as advised by the Company. The loading so done by the Company will be final and binding on the bidders. No deviation will however, be accepted in the clauses covered under BEC/BRC.
- 1.5.2 To ascertain the substantial responsiveness of the bid the Company reserves the right to ask the Bidder for clarification in respect of clauses covered under BEC/BRC also and such clarification fulfilling the BEC/BRC clauses must be received on or before the deadline given by the Company, failing which the offer will summarily be rejected.
- 1.5.3 In case, any of the clauses in the BRC contradict with other clauses of the Bid Document elsewhere, then the clauses in the BRC shall prevail.
- 1.5.4 Any additional information/terms/conditions furnished in 'Price Bid' will not be considered by Company for evaluation /award of contract.
- 1.5.5 Bidder shall furnish all the relevant clauses applicable in case of legacy system or e-Tender whichever is applicable.

2.0 BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC):

- 2.1 The bids conforming to the technical specification, terms and conditions in the bid documents and considered to be responsive after subjecting to the Bid Rejection Criteria will also be considered for further evaluation as per the Bid Evaluation Criteria.
- 2.2 To ascertain the inter-se-ranking, the comparison of the responsive bids will be made on the basis of total cost of various works envisaged under the contract.
