BID REJECTION CRITERIA (BRC) / BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC)

1.0 **Financial capability: Bidders must have**

Average Annual financial turnover as per Audited Annual Reports for the last three accounting years (ending 31st March, 2013) should be at least ₹ 2,39,300.00

For Proof of Annual Turnover any of the following documents /photocopy must be furnished:

- A Certificate issued by a practicing Chartered / Cost Accountant Firm, with membership number certifying the Annual Turnover and nature of business.
- Audited Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss account.

2.0 **Experience: Bidders must have;**

2.1 The Bidder shall have the experience of “**Installation of Extension of Casing work pipeline of size 203.2 mm (8'') OD and above carrying Liquid Hydrocarbons**” in last 7 years reckoned from the date of bid closing date.

Or

2.2 The Bidder shall have the experience of “**Construction and Laying of pipeline of size 203.2 mm (8'') OD and above conforming to applicable / relevant codes for carrying Liquid Hydrocarbons**” in last 7 years reckoned from the date of bid closing date.

The job experience as detailed in para 2.1 and 2.2 above shall be in

i) Three completed works each costing not less than ` **3,19,100.00**

Or

ii) Two completed works each costing not less than ` **3,98,800.00**

Or

iii) One completed works each costing not less than ` **6,38,100.00**

Note: Documentary evidence in support of work experience and fulfilling the requirement as spelt out in clause 2.1 and 2.2 must be submitted along with bid. These documents by the Owner of a pipeline. However, the originals of these documents shall have to be produced by the bidder, as and when asked for .

3.0 **Commercial**

- a) Bidder shall furnish EMD as Bid Security along with Bid. Any bid not accompanied by a proper bid security will be rejected.
- b) Any bid received in the form of Telex / Cable /Fax /E-mail / Telephone call will not be accepted.
- c) Bid shall be typed or written in indelible ink and original bid shall be signed by the Bidder or their authorized representative on all pages failing which the bid will be rejected. Rates shall be quoted in figures as well as in words.
- d) Bid shall contain no inter-lineation, erasures or overwriting except as necessary to correct errors made by Bidder, in which case such corrections shall be initialed by the person(s) signing the bid. However, while fluid should not be used for making corrections. Any bid not meeting this requirement shall be rejected.
- e) Any bid containing false statement will be rejected.
- f) Bidders must quote clearly and strictly in accordance with the price schedule of Bidding Documents; otherwise the bid will be rejected.
- g) The Bid Documents are not transferable. Bids made by parties who have not purchased the Bid Documents from the Company will be rejected.
- h) Any Bid received by the Company after the deadline for submission of bids prescribed by the Company will be rejected.

- i) Price quoted by the successful Bidder must be firm during the performance of the Contract and not subject to variation on any account. A bid submitted with an adjustable price will be treated as non-responsive and rejected.
- k) The following Clauses with all its sub-clauses should be agreed into, failing which the bid will be rejected:
 - a) Performance Security Clause
 - b) Force Majeure Clause
 - c) Termination Clause
 - d) Settlement of disputes Clause
 - e) Liquidated Damages Clause.

EVALUATION OF BIDS:

The Bids will be evaluated as per the Bid Evaluation Criteria (BEC) as stated herein under:

BID EVALUATION CRITERIA (BEC)

1. Bids conforming to the terms and conditions stipulated in the bid document and considered responsive and subject to qualifying the Bid Rejection Criteria will be considered for further evaluation.
2. To ascertain the inter-se-ranking, the comparison of the responsive bids will be made on the basis of total amount quoted for the items of SOQ of the tender.
3. Any discount/rebates offered shall not be considered for evaluation of bids. However, if the lowest bidder happens to be the final acceptable bidder for award of contract and if they have offered any discount/rebate the contract shall be awarded after taking into consideration such discount/rebate after negotiation or otherwise.
4. Oil will not be responsible of delay, loss or non receipt applications (for bidding documents) sent by mail and will not entertain by correspondence in the regard.
5. In case more than one bidder emerges as lowest bidder due to equal rate quoted by the bidder, then the lowest bidder will be decided by draw of lots. Company's decision in this regard is final and binding to all bidders
